TEERING OFF

- **LET'S GET IT STARTED:** After a strong bounce back win last night, the GreenJackets try to win their first series of the year behind Zach Royse.
- **ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Augusta scored in every even inning, and Ethan Bagwell fired a career-high 7 innings in a 7-3 win for the Jackets.
- **LAST YEAR TONIGHT:** Augusta finished the 2025 campaign at 67-62, an 18-win improvement from their prior season and the highest win total in three years. A bevy of top prospects came through SRP Park including Cam Caminiti and John Gil, and eight former GreenJackets made their Major League debuts.
- **RANK 'EM:** Seven players from MLB Pipeline's Top 30 Braves Prospects are currently on Augusta's roster to start the year. The highest regarded is #4 prospect INF Tate Southisene, along with INF Alex Lodise (#5), OF Conor Essenburg (#13), OF Luis Guanipa (#21), LHP Landon Beidelschies (#23), RHP Ethan Bagwell (#24), and INF Jose Perdomo (#25).
- **GAME RECOGNIZE GAME:** Three former GreenJackets have found themselves on preseason lists of Top 100 Prospects, with Cam Caminiti and JR Ritchie being near unanimous, while Didier Fuentes has also received some national love.
- **AND YOU LOOKIN' KINDA UNFAMILIAR:** The GreenJackets and Shorebirds match up for the second year in a row after not playing in 2024. Augusta took 5 of 6 at Perdue Stadium last year. Delmarva makes their first trek to Augusta since 2023 in early June.
- **HE STOLL MY HEART:** Brad Stoll takes over as the manager of the Jackets, following a year as the team's first base coach. Stoll brings with him nearly two decades of managerial experience at the amateur level, having led the Lawrence HS Chesty Lions in Kansas for 19 seasons prior to joining the Braves organization in 2025.
- **EASY BEING GREEN:** The Jackets debuted their new green alternate jerseys last year, and found success in the color most synonymous with Augusta. The ballclub went 32-20 in green last year, their best mark in any jersey combo.
- **I WANT TO GO HOME!!:** Augusta begins the year with nine straight games on the road, the first of two nine-game roadtrips this year. The GreenJackets won't return to SRP Park until April 14th, when they will host the Fayetteville Woodpeckers to begin Azaleas Week.
- **NEXT TIME OUT:** The season's opening road trip finally comes to a conclusion tomorrow, as the Jackets play a Sunday matinee at Perdue Stadium. Kendy Richard will try to bounce back after a rocky debut last week, as he matches up against Christian Rodriguez, who Augusta saw on Tuesday in the series opener.

BRAD STOLL

MANAGER

Brad Stoll takes the reigns for his first managerial gig at the pro levels, following one season spent as the first base coach for the GreenJackets. Stoll joined the Braves' system following nearly 20 years coaching at Lawrence High School in Kansas. During his time with the Chesty Lions, Stoll won a 6A State Championship in 2009 and saw two former players go on to play in Major League Baseball: Garrett Cleavinger and Bryce Montes de Oca. Stoll's additional experience lies in the Cape Cod League, where he was an assistant with the Falmouth Commodores from 2009-15 and again in 2024.

ELVIN NINA

PITCHING COACH

A mainstay at SRP Park, Elvin Nina returns to the GreenJackets to guide the pitching staff for the third straight year. Nina was previously with the FCL Braves, and has been with the Atlanta organization since 2018. A native of San Cristobal, Nina played collegiately at both Northeastern Oklahoma A&M and Oklahoma State before being drafted in the 17th Rd of the 1997 Draft by the Oakland Athletics. Nina played 9 seasons in the minors across 5 organizations, while also seeing time in the Chinese Professional League, the Mexican League, and the Atlantic League. The righty began his coaching career with six years in the Milwaukee Brewers' system, and also coached with the Pirates' organization for three seasons.

ADAM WOOD

HITTING COACH

Adam Wood comes to Augusta for his first year working with the GreenJackets, and his fourth year overall with the Braves. Wood spent last year as the hitting coach for the FCL Braves, and began his time in the organization with two seasons with the DSL Braves. Prior to entering the pro ranks, Wood spent nearly a decade as an independent hitting coach in California.

JEFFERSON ROMERO

COACH

Jefferson Romero is in his first year with the GreenJackets, but is certainly no stranger to the Braves' organization as a whole. Romero joined the Braves as an International Area Scout in 2007 and has been with the team since. Romero added coaching duties in the DSL in 2011, and switched to coaching full-time in 2015, working with catchers and coaching third base. He was named manager of the DSL Braves in 2017, and spent three years in the role before coming stateside in 2020. Romero has worked as a catching coach and first base coach at various levels of late, including with the Mississippi Braves in 2023, Rome Emperors in 2024, and FCL Braves in 2025, adding Assistant Manager to his duties last summer.

ROB LEARY

COACH

An industry veteran in his first year with the Braves, Leary brings with him over three decades of coaching and player development experience at both the Major and Minor League levels. Leary has spent the last nine years as an Advance & Pro Scout with the Arizona Diamondbacks, and was previously the big league Bench Coach with the Miami Marlins from 2013-2015. He has also spent time in the Guardians and Red Sox organizations, primarily in Minor League Development and as a Catching Coordinator. Leary spent five seasons as a player in the Montreal Expos system, before jumping straight into coaching as the Manager of the Rockford Expos and West Palm Beach Expos, composing a record of 254-236 over four years.
