#### Saturday Showdown

The Fightin Phils finish a six-game series at home against the Somerset Patriots tonight. The series began with three games in Somerset, and now shifts to Reading. It's the 12th-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and ninth-of-nine in Reading. After this week, Reading returns to Somerset from Aug. 27-Sept. 1. The Fightin Phils won their first matchup of the season 4-2 over Somerset from Apr. 23-28. Somerset leads the season-series 6-5.

#### **Dropping Both**

The Fightin Phils ultimately fell 8-2 in the resumption of Thursday's suspended game on Friday night. Robinson Pina took just his third loss of the season. The bright spot in the first game was an inside-the-park home run from Otto Kemp, his fifth homer of the season. In game two, the Fightin Phils jumped out to a 3-1 lead, thanks to two in the fourth, and one in the sixth inning. Caleb Ricketts had a two-run home run that initially put Reading on top 2-1, then Carson Taylor had a sac fly that made it 3-1. But, Tristan Garnett loaded the bases and surrendered a grand slam to Elijah Dunham in the top of the seventh to make it 5-3, Somersrt. Reading didn't go down without a fight, as they loaded the bases and scored a run, but Kevin Stevens was able to hold on for the save.

#### A Man Called Otto (Races Around the Bases)

In game one on Friday, Otto Kemp his an inside-the-park home run for his fifth home run in 20 games so far since being called up from High-A Jersey Shore. It was the first inside-the-park homer hit by a Fightin Phil since Arquimedes Gamboa his one against Portland on July 15, 2021. The last inside-the-park home run hit at First Energy Stadium was on July 1, 2023, by Richmond's Wade Mecker. The Kemp inside-the-park home run was the first to hit off the Redner's Event Center, as Meckler's was due to a collision in the outfield by Carlos De La Cruz and Matt Kroon.

#### What's Up Breaux

Josh Breaux hit a three-run home run on Wednesday night in just his second start with the Fightin Phils. He was released by the Yankees on June 29 and signed with the Phillies and was assigned to Reading on July 2. Ironically, his first games with the R-Phils come against his old organization and the team he played the most games for in his professional career. Breaux appeared in 104 games for the Patriots between the 2021-23 seasons.

#### Carlos De La Cruzing

Carlos De La Cruz finished off the month of June slashing .300/.386/.560 (.946 OPS) for the month. He added 21 runs, six doubles, one triple, six home runs and 16 RBI for the month. It's a month that was completely turned his season around, as De La Cruz entered June hitting just .213, and another hit on Friday night, he is now up to .258 on the season. De La Cruz is currently riding a season-best eight-game hit streak.

#### Phillips is a Phillie

Tyler Phillips, who pitched for Reading in 2021 and '23, earned his first Major League call-up on Friday. Phillips is the third former R-Phil to receive a bigleague promotion in 2024, joining former teammate Oliver Dunn (2023) with the Brewers, and Erik Miller (2022) with the Giants. Phillies is one-of-right Reading alums on the Phillies active roster currently. He is the third member of the 2023 team to be on the Phillies roster, joining Johan Rojas and Orion Kerkering. Phillies grew up in South Jersey, a huge Phillies fan, and attended Bishop Eustace High School, the same as Zac Gallen. The Rangers drafted him in 2015 and was DFA'd and claimed by the Phillies in 2021. He missed all of 2022 recovering from Tommy John Surgery, and has been strong since returning last year.

#### This Day in Baseballtown History

July 6, 2005: At Reading, Cole Hamels makes his long-anticipated Baseballtown debut against Akron. Hamels struggles in the 1st inning (WP, R, E, HB, BB), but settles down to finish with five hits, three runs (two earned) and six strikeouts in 6.0 innings.

#### The Patriots are Coming

Somerset enters tonight after finishing in fourth place in the Eastern League's Northeast Divison for the first half with a 32-37 record. They are first in the Northeast Division with a 9-2 record in the second half of the season. Somerset most recently took five-of-six on the road at the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Following this week, Somerset remains on the road for a six-game series at Erie. Somerset's roster features seven players ranked amongst the New York Yankees' top-30 prospects: Spencer Jones (2), Brock Selvidge (10), Zach Messinger (21), Trystan Vrieling (22), Tyler Hardman (25), Danny Watson (27) and Benmjamin Cowles (29).

#### Selvidge the Southpaw for Somerset

Lefty, and Yankees' No. 10 Prospect, Brock Selvidge makes the start tonight for Somerset. This season, Selvidge is 7-5, with a 3.95 ERA over 15 starts (79.2 IP, 69 H, 39 BB, 80 SO). He picked up a no-decision on Monay against Reading, allowing four-earned runs on five hits over 5.1 innings, with three walks and eight strikeouts. He earned the win on Apr. 27 at Reading, going seven-shutout innings, while allowing two hits and striking out a season-high 11 hitters. Selvidge split 2023 between between Single-A Tampa and High-A Hudson Valley and combined to go 8-5, with 3.45 ERA over 24 appearances and 23 starts. The Yankees selected the 21-year old out of Hamilton High School in Chandler, Arizona, in the third round of the 2021 draft.
