YESTERDAY: The Captains split a doubleheader with the West Michigan Whitecaps. Lake County lost the first game, 2-0, but won the second game, 4-3, on a walk-off double by Julian Escobedo in the seventh.

GAME ONE: Daniel Espino struck out 11 and held West Michigan to one run one hit, but the Whitecaps prevailed, 2-0. West Michigan registered just two hits in the game, but both resulted in runs. Rey Rivera homered off of Espino in the third and Parker Meadows drove in a run in the seventh with a single against Nathan Ocker. West Michigan starter Reese Olson (5 IP) and reliever Bryce Tassin (2 IP) combined to shut out Lake County on four hits.

GAME TWO: The Captains won a back-and-forth game when Julian Escobedo drilled a walk-off double to right-center that scored Quentin Holmes from first base for a 4-3 victory. After the Whitecaps grabbed a 2-0 lead in the first on a homer by Daniel Cabrera, Lake County answered to tie the game. Micah Pries knocked in a run with a double in the first and José Tena hit an RBI single in the third to even the score. Raynel Delgado gave the Captains a 3-2 lead with a solo homer in the fourth, but West Michigan tied it at 3-3 in the seventh on a sacrifice fly by Jose King. Escobedo's game-winning double clinched the Captains' first doubleheader split of the season. Lake County previously had gone 3-1-0 in twin-bills.

WALK-OFF WINNERS: The Captains have five walk-off wins, including two in their last three games. Lake County's first walk-off of the season came on a Will Brennan walk-off double to beat Dayton in game two of a doubleheader on June 3. On June 15, a dropped pop up with two outs in the ninth by Whitecaps second baseman Wenceel Perez scored two runs to give the Captains a 3-2 walk-off win. On July 3, South Bend reliever Samuel Reyes dropped a throw back to the mound and Bryan Lavastida scored from third to win game one of a doubleheader in eight innings. George Valera hit a walk-off homer to lead off the seventh inning on August 13, beating West Michigan in what was supposed to be the first game of a doubleheader before game two was postponed. Julian Escobedo hit a walk-off double in the seventh inning to beat West Michigan in game two of a doubleheader on August 14.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains enter today 1.5 games behind the Cedar Rapids Kernels for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). They are one game back in the loss column and two games back in the win column. Lake County, Cedar Rapids, the Dayton Dragons and the Great Lakes Loons are all separated by just 2.0 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits currently hold the top playoff spot and are 11.0 games ahead of second place. The top two teams in the HAC earn playoff bids (regardless of

BACK-TO-BACK: George Valera and José Tena homered on back-to-back pitches two days in a row on Thursday and Friday. Valera hit a two-run, go-ahead homer in the third inning on Thursday and Tena went deep on the next pitch. On Friday, Valera hit a two-run homer in the fifth to pull the Captains within a run and Tena homered on the next pitch following a mound conference to tie the game. Lake County has hit back-to-back homers three times in its last four games. Every time, the homers have come on backto-back pitches. Valera and Micah Pries hit back-to-back homers in the third inning on Sunday against Lansing, with Pries' solo shot

HOMER STREAK ENDS: George Valera's single in the third inning of game two yesterday snapped the outfielder's home runs streak. Prior to that single, Valera's last seven hits were all home runs. Valera did not have a non-homer hit from August 1 until game two of the doubleheader on August 14.

NO REST, NO PROBLEM: George Valera has played 19 consecutive games. Since his last game off (July 23), Valera is slashing .250/.456/.661 (1.116 OPS). Valera has seven homers and more walks (21) than strikeouts (16). José Tena has played 17 straight games, all of which have been at shortstop. Since his last game off (July 25), he is slashing .323/.380/.677 (1.057 OPS) with seven

STREAKING: José Tena is riding a nine-game hitting streak. During that span, he is hitting .429/.444/.829 (1.273 OPS) with four

TOP HEAVY: José Tena and George Valera have carried the Captains' offense in August. The duo boasts a .439 on-base percentage this month, while the rest of the team has a .281 OBP. Valera and Tena alone account for 23 of Lake County's 45 RBI in

LAST TIME OUT: Hickman took the loss against Lansing last Sunday at Classic Park. The right-hander surrendered five runs on five hits over five innings. The Lugnuts scored two runs in the first, one in the second and one in the third on a homer by Lester Madden, Jr. The Captains scored four quick runs in the third to tie the score, including back-to-back homers by **George Valera** and **Micah Pries**. The Lugnuts, however, scored another run in the fourth on a sacrifice fly by Cobie Vance to take a 5-4 lead. Hickman left the game with the Captains trailing by one and the Lugnuts scored seven runs against the Captains' bullpen to beat Lake County 12-4.

COLLEGE ACCOLADES: Hickman was named a Preseason All-American by *Collegiate Game*, and Second Team Preseason All-America by *Perfect Game* before the shortened 2020 season.

2020 DRAFT: Cleveland selected Hickman in the fifth round (154th overall) of the 2020 draft, which was shortened to five rounds. This was considered a bit of a steal by some outlets with both *Perfect Game* and *Baseball America* ranking Hickman as the 65th best draft prospect entering the draft.

COLLEGE WORLD SERIES CLINCHER: Hickman's shining moment at Vanderbilt came in 2019 as he helped lead the Commodores to their second National Championship in school history. In the series clinching win, Hickman started for Vanderbilt tossing six strong innings, allowing just one run while fanning 10 Wolverines in the 8-2 win. He also started in the CWS semifinals against Louisville throwing six scoreless frames and surrendering just two hits with three strikeouts. In four total NCAA Tournament starts he went 2-0 with a 1.57 ERA in 23 innings.

CAPTAINS AND VANDY: Hickman is just the second Captain ever to come out Vanderbilt. The first and only other Commodore to come to Lake County was catcher on the 2003 Captains and Lake County Manager in 2012, David Wallace.

STAFF LEADER: In 2019 Hickman found himself starting 2019 out of the bullpen despite being the teams Sunday starter as a freshman, appearing out of the bullpen three times in 2018. After coming out of the pen in his first six appearances of 2019 with a 2.50 ERA Hickman rejoined the rotation and thrived. He finished the year with a 2.05 ERA to lead the team and finish 4^{th} in the SEC.

COACHES WORDS: Hickman worked with Tim Corbin at Vanderbilt who has built a powerhouse in Nashville churning out top baseball talent. In recent years Walker Buehler, Sonny Gray and David Price among others have all starred in the big leagues after pitching for Vandy. Corbin says "Mason has turned into one of the most dependable and reliable starting pitchers that we have had in our program. He continues to develop and get better as his craft while taking on a leadership role on our pitching staff. He is a quality young man that excels in the classroom as well. Very competitive in everything that he does."

STRIKEOUT BUMP: After striking out just eight batters per nine innings as a freshman in Nashville, Hickman saw an increase in whiffs towards the end of his sophomore season. In his final six starts of the season he struck out nine or more batters five times. He finished 2019 with 129 strikeouts to finish 13th in the country and struck out 12 per nine innings.

PROFESSIONAL STAFF: The teammates Hickman worked with at Vanderbilt have been highly regarded around baseball. Pitchers that Hickman joined in the clubhouse that have recently been drafted include Tyler Brown (2020, HOU), Jake Eder (2020, MIA), Drake Fellows (2019, SD), Zach King (2019, MIA), Jackson Gillis (2019, MIL), Joe Gobillot (2019, TB), AJ Franklin (2019, KC), Patrick Raby (2019, CIN), Maddux Conger (2018, DET) and Justin Wilson (2018, NYY). In 2021, Commodores Kumar Rocker and Jack Leiter are both expected to be first round draft picks in 2021 and were teammates of Hickman's in 2019 and 2020. Vanderbilt has also had 12 position players since 2018.
