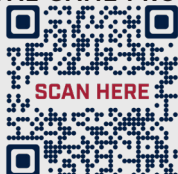

ABOUT LAST NIGHT

Round Rock claimed a 6-1 victory over Albuquerque on Thursday night. Express 1B Matt Carpenter opened the scoring in the second inning when he hit a triple to score DH Yohel Pozo for a 1-0 lead. RF Elmer Hernandez then drove in Carpenter with a single and extended the lead to 2-0. Carpenter continued his big night in the sixth inning. With Pozo on first base, Carpenter hit a home run to give Round Rock a 4-0 advantage. The Express offense continued to cook in the seventh when back-to-back doubles from C Meibrys Viloria and SS Ryan Dorow put runners on second and third base. A single from 3B Josh Smith scored Viloria before the third baseman was caught stealing. CF Leody Taveras then tripled to send Dorow home and increase the Express lead to 6-0. Albuquerque loaded the bases in the eighth inning facing Round Rock RHP Yerry Rodriguez. RHP Hever Bueno took over with nobody out and went on to allow just one runner to score, making it a 6-1 contest.

LET'S GO LATZ

Express LHP Jake Latz is scheduled to make Friday's start for his fourth of the season. The lefty has earned a decision in every outing so far, claiming a 2-1 record to go with a 2.40 ERA (4 ER/15.0 IP). Latz ties for the team high with 14 strikeouts this year.

CARPENTER HEATING UP

Round Rock 1B Matt Carpenter finished Thursday night's contest 2-for-4 with three RBI. His triple in the second inning was his first three-bagger since July 5, 2021 against the San Francisco Giants. He then went on to blast a two-run home run into right field during the sixth inning, marking his second dinger for the Express this season. The Major League veteran is currently hitting .306 (11-36) over nine games during 2022 and has tallied two doubles, one triple and two home runs.

A LEAGUE OF THEIR OWN

After last night's 6-1 victory over Albuquerque, Round Rock has officially taken over as the sole leader in the East Division of the Pacific Coast League standings. The team's 11-4 record also tops the PCL West Division clubs. The current Express average of .278 (144-518) is the second highest in all of Triple-A behind just Oklahoma City.

KEEPING IT UP ON THE BUMP

The Express continued their hot start on the mound as Round Rock RHP Tyson Miller got the baseball to open Thursday and went three scoreless frames. He surrendered only one hit while walking two and striking out three. RHP Nick Tropeano took over in the fourth and went three scoreless innings with two strikeouts and allowed only one hit. RHP Hever Bueno closed things out with 2.0 frames, extending his scoreless streak to 5.2 innings.

KEEP ON STREAKING

Round Rock extended its overall active winning streak to seven games and the team's home winning streak to six on Thursday. The longest overall streak during the 2021 season was seven, which the E-Train looks to top tonight.

TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS

RHP Glenn Otto has been recalled by the Texas Rangers and is scheduled to make the start tonight in Oakland. The righty has made two starts this season for the Express, tossing to a perfect 0.00 ERA over 7.0 innings. He allowed just two hits and one walk during his outings for Round Rock while striking out nine.

RHP Daniel Robert, INF Josh Smith and OF Bubba Thompson all made their Triple-A debuts on Opening Day - April 5, 2022 while RHP Hever Bueno made his on April 6.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players hail from 12 different states, including Alabama, Arizona, California, Colorado, Florida, Illinois, Louisiana, Michigan, New York, North Carolina, Pennsylvania and Texas. The team's lone Texan, RHP Justin Anderson hailed from Houston before a collegiate career at the University of Texas at San Antonio.

EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.

Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
