#### SUMMARY

- ▶ Ranked as the No. 18 Diamondbacks prospect by MLB Pipeline ahead of the start of the 2026 season.
- ▶ Traded along with LHP Brandyn Garcia from the Seattle Mariners to the Arizona Diamondbacks on July 24, 2025 in return for Josh Naylor.
- ▶ Selected by the Seattle Mariners in the fourth round (126th ovr.) of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Oswego East High School...agreed to a \$1.10 million signing bonus.
- ▶ Was committed to play college baseball at Wichita State.

#### LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ His start was limited to just two innings after a rain delay eventually led to Saturday's game vs. Tulsa being suspended.
- ▶ Both earned runs came on a two-run home run surrendered to Jake Gelof in the top of the second inning...Izzi tossed a scoreless first inning and struck out two (both looking).

#### A QUALITY FIRST IMPRESSION

- ▶ Made his first Double-A start on April 5...blacked a hot Springfield Cardinals offense over five innings, allowing just four hits on an efficient 49 pitches...it was the lowest pitch count of his career for any starts of 5.0 innings or more.

#### 2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Started the season with the Everett AquaSox...made his first start on May 1, where he threw three scoreless innings against the Eugene Emeralds.
- ▶ Earned his first win of the campaign three starts later...he blanked the Hillsboro Hops over five full frames, allowing just three hits and striking out five.
- ▶ Finished the month of May with a 2.60 ERA (5 ER/17.1 IP).
- ▶ Matched the longest outing of his career on August 19...tossed 6.2 innings, allowing four runs (two earned).
- ▶ Set a career-high in strikeouts on September 2 by punching nine tickets and allowing just two baserunners over six full frames.
- ▶ Started all 18 games he appeared in, finishing with a 3-6 record and a 4.80 ERA.
- ▶ His control really took off down the stretch in the Northwest League...posted a 4.9 percent walk rate in his final eight starts.

#### BRINGING HOME HARDWARE

- ▶ Won the Northwest League Pitcher of the Week award for the week of September 7, 2025 after setting a career-high in strikeouts (9) five days prior.
- ▶ Took home the California League Pitcher of the Week award for the week of June 2, 2024...tossed 5.0 no-hit innings on June 2 as he earned the win for the Single-A Modesto Nuts in a 7-6 victory over the Stockton Ports.

#### BIG MEN ON CAMPUS

- ▶ Was teammates with Noah Schultz at Oswego East High School, who was also drafted in 2022 by the Chicago White Sox in the first round (26th ovr.)...Schultz made his big league debut with the South Siders on April 14.
