TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve play their final series of the regular season against their slated playoff opponent, the Erie SeaWolves.

The chilly chicken, Garrett Burhenn, takes the ball for Erie tonight. Burhenn leads the Eastern League with 13 wins and has a 4.29 ERA in 121.2 innings. Detroit's 9th round pick in 2021 out of THE Ohio State University, Burhenn hails from Indianapolis, IN where he attended Lawrence North HS which is about a 20 minute drive to Victory Field, the home of the Pirates Triple-A affiliate. Burhenn told OSU Sports Information that he'd like to begin a career in accounting or finance when his baseball career wraps up.

PLAY THE SONG: For the first time since 2018, the Altoona Curve will play postseason ball after they eliminated the Richmond Flying Squirrels with a 4-2 win on Sunday, September 7. Altoona will host Erie for Game One of the Southwest Division series on Tuesday, September 16 at PNG Field, just the second time in franchise history the teams will match up in the playoffs. The Curve swept the SeaWolves in 2004 on their way to a championship series defeat at New Hampshire.

TERMINATING: Infielder **Termarr Johnson** has gone 11-for-28 (.393) across his last 9 games, adding 6 walks for a .514 on-base percentage. Johnson turned in his most well-rounded month of the season in August, batting .318 with 4 2B, 1 3B, 1 HR and 10 RBI (.798 OPS) leads the club with 31 multi-hit games this season.

20 NICK'S: First baseman **Nick Cimillo** is the first Curve batter since 2022 (**Andres Alvarez, Aaron Shackelford**) to hit 20 homers in a season with Altoona. Cimillo, who is now tied for third among PIT MiLB in homers with **Konnor Griffin** behind teammates **Esmerlyn Valdez** (26) and **Javier Rivas** (21), returned from the All-Star break with a vengeance. **In his last 40 games, he's picked up 27 extra base hits (.285 BA, 1.048 OPS).** Cimillo led all Double-A players with 11 HR the most in a calendar month since **Brad Eldred** in August of 2005 hit 11.

Cimillo has a hit in each of his last 10 games (17-for-40), with 3 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 14 RBI, with an insane 1.464 OPS.

DUCE IS LOOSE: Infielder **Duce Gourson** has emerged as one of Altoona's most underrated players in the Second Half of the season. In his last 23 games, he is 29-for-80 (.349) with 4 2B, 3 HR, 10 RBI and 15 BB (since August 7). Gourson had a season-long 12-game hit streak end on Thursday, September 4, he has reached in 15 straight games overall.

THE 'MERYLN OF VALDEZ: Outfielder **Esmerlyn Valdez** homered four times across three games August 28-30, marking the first time in his career that he's homered in three straight games. Valdez leads all Pirates minor leaguers with 26 homers this season. In August, Valdez batted .311 with a 1 2B, 6 HR and 19 RBI, he ranked 3rd among Eastern League players in HR and 4th in RBI in the calendar month.

Valdez had a 9 game on-base streak end on Sunday during which he hit .444 (16-for-36) with 3 2B, 4 HR and 11 RBI totaling a 1.373 OPS.

No. 1: Baseball's top prospect, **Konnor Griffin**, has a hit in 14-of-16 games with the Curve, batting .322 (19-for-59) with a .991 OPS since joining the Curve on Monday, August 18. Griffin, at 19 years, 3 months and 26 days, is the youngest player in franchise history to suit up for The Curve. Griffin is the tenth player in franchise history, just the third infielder, to join Altoona while ranked as the No. 1 prospect in baseball, first since **Paul Skenes** in 2023. Griffin ranks among all minor league players in runs scored (1st, 112), stolen bases (9th, 65), hits (4th, 152), 6th in RBI (90), 7th in OPS (.944) and batting average. (5th, .330).

Griffin is the first Pirates minor leaguer to steal 60 bases since Manny Ravello stole 70 bases in 2001 with Single-A Lynchburg and Hickory.

RECORD WATCH: With one projected starts remaining in the 2025 season, righty **Wilber Dotel** will finish in the top-5 of strikeouts in a single-season in franchise history. His 130 strikeouts are 4th-most in a single season in franchise history. **Ian Snell** holds the franchise record with 142 strikeouts in 2004.

THE SAGINAW KID: Infielder **Mitch Jebb** has 33 stolen bases this season, 5th-most by an Eastern League player this year. He is the first Curve player to steal 30 bases in a season since **Jared Oliva** stole 36 bases in 2019. Only two players in franchise history (**Rajai Davis** and **Rich Thompson** in 2005) have stolen 40 bases in a season for the Curve.
