Heath Fillmyer dominated on the mound (6.0IP, 4H, 1R, 1ER, 1BB, 8K), turning in the team's first quality start since 7/7 (also Fillmyer). Kyle Dowdy worked a perfect 7th for his first save since 2018 (third of career).

### Today's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Brad Peacock** to the mound today, looking to salvage a series split after losing the first three games (3-0-2 in last five home series). Toledo will counter with RHP **Mark Leiter Jr.** The Clippers are 33-38 (.465) against right handers this year. Leiter has pitched against the Clippers three times in his career, going 1-0 with a 4.50ERA (10.0IP, 5H, 5R, 5ER, 3BB, 14K).

### vs. the Mud Hens

Columbus is 9-14 opposing the Mud Hens this season, 6-5 in Huntington Park. Individually, **Oscar Gonzalez** has hit .353 (6x17) against Toledo this year (5G) and **Nolan Jones** was at .338 (22x65) with 3HR and 11RBI in 19G, but is 0x11 in his last 4G opposing Toledo. **Renato Nunez** and **Aderlin Rodriguez** (19RBI in 21G) have 6HR against the Clippers this year, **Yariel Gonzalez** has 5HR.

### Oddity

Last night's quality start from **Heath Fillmyer** snapped a streak of 31 consecutive games without a quality start for Columbus (starters maxed out at 5.0IP in all 31G). Despite only 9QS on the season (10%), the Clippers have seen back to back quality outings twice this season (5/21-5/22 and 6/1-6/2). Clipper starters own only 13G with at least 6.0IP and no pitcher has more than 7.0IP or 100 pitches.

### If Only

The Clippers lead the IL with a .926 winning percentage when they hold opponents to fewer than four runs (25-2, won 17 straight). Unfortunately, they rank 13th in the IL in such games (Charlotte has only 23G). Toledo enters today with the league's 2nd best win percentage (.861, 31-5), but they have allowed the Clippers to score exactly four runs in each of the last 6G (Clippers won twice).

### Clean Slate

When beginning a new inning, only Toledo's .270 average tops that of Columbus (.268) in the IL (Clippers score in 58% of innings that start with a hit). Among players that have led off at least 50 innings, Toledo's **Aderlin Rodriguez** has the best average (.414, 24x58), followed by **Alex Call** (2nd, .364, 16x44), **Trenton Brooks** (5th, .339, 20x59) and **Yariel Gonzalez** (6th, .333, 21x63).

### Brooks is Back

Starting with a hitless game in which he drew 3BB, **Trenton Brooks** has put together a 14G on base streak since 7/30 in Nashville (.500OBP). He has a hit in 12 of the 14 (.378, 17x45) and has 6XBH (.556SLG), including Tuesday's homer (first since 7/22 vs. Iowa). Following a 2HR game at Iowa on 6/10, his last 5HR have come in Huntington Park (last 9HR from **Nolan Jones** have been at home).

### Rarified Air-ias

**Gabriel Arias** enters tonight riding a 24G on base streak that has seen a few close calls recently (.388OBP since 7/18; singled in 10th on 8/6, in 9th on 8/5, in 8th on 8/13, in 6th of game one last night). His streak is a career best and started with him tying his career best with a 9G hit streak from 7/18-7/28. Since 6/12, Arias is hitting .320 (64x200) and has reached base safely in 47 of 52G (.372OBP).

### Picking Up the Slack

Over the last 4G, **Daniel Johnson** (0x12) and **Nolan Jones** (0x11) have combined to go 0x23, but the rest of the team has collectively hit .337 (21x92), led by **Trenton Brooks** (5x10), **Ryan Lavanway** (3x6) and **Oscar Gonzalez** (5x13). Gonzalez is hitting .304 (14x46) in the month of August, but has drawn just one walk (only player of 20 in IL with at least 48PA that has fewer than 2BB).

### Month On, Month Off

Beginning on 8/4, **Nolan Jones** has four multi-hit games in his last 10, batting .294 (10x34) with 2HR and 6RBI (.385OBP, .500SLG). In the month prior, 7/4-8/3, Jones hit .172/.287/.368 with 5HR and 11RBI over 25G. For the month from 6/4-7/3, he hit .292/.411/.573 with 3HR and 17RBI in 27G (also had 14 doubles) and from opening day to 6/3, he struggled to .173/.313/.272 with a HR and 7RBI in 24G.

### Bullpen Bashers

The Clipper bullpen (**Logan Allen**) recorded 5.0IP with 0ER last Sunday, marking the 12th time this year the relievers have had at least 5.0IP and 0ER (no other IL team has more than eight such games). However, only one of those games has come against Toledo (5/18, first matchup), as the Mud Hens have pounded the Clipper bullpen to a 6.42ERA in the last 21G (88.1IP, 63ER)

# Columbus Clippers Game Information

## This Date in Clipper History

8/15/1992

Columbus beat Rochester by a score of 6-4, thanks in large part to a 2HR, 4RBI performance by **Torey Lovullo**. The win gave Columbus 80 on the season, as they would go on to win a franchise record 95 games. Including the playoffs, the '92 squad was victorious 101 times on the way to winning the franchise's 6th Governors' Cup. Lovullo would be named to the IL All-Star team, joining seven of his Columbus teammates.

## Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 years since the move downtown, Huntington Park has ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game, totaling 2.25 per contest (1,763HR, 783 games). In 2019, HP averaged over three per game for the first time ever (seventh time averaging over a pair), as the Clippers surrendered a record 127HR and just missed out on triple digits themselves (97HR was second highest team total). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,005 to 956).

## Homers, Homers and More Homers

The franchise record for homers was destroyed in 2019 (213, +31 from '83), as was the record for homers allowed (198, +42 from '98). This season's Clippers are homering at a rate of 1.26 per game, putting them five off of the pace of the pre-2019 record (adjusted for 140G). On the mound they are allowing 1.54 per game, enough to beat the pre-2019 record by 41, even with the shortened season.

## Ain't Over 'Til It's Over

From 2014-19, no team had more come from behind victories than the 210 posted by Columbus and no team produced a better winning percentage when trailing than the .353 of the Clippers (Scranton/WB was 2nd in percentage, .338, and wins, 192). This year has seen the Clippers go 16-48 (.250) in games in which they trail, ranking 11th.

## Not Close

The Clippers have suffered the most losses by at least a grand slam in the IL (27; six in 10G from 7/8-7/19) and rank tied for last in wins by at least that many (12, Norfolk). That poor ratio has led to a -90 run differential (had a -50 differential over 10G from 7/8-7/19), a figure that places them 13th in the IL (Charlotte, -93).

## Get What You Pay For

Columbus was the last team in the IL to play free baseball this season, playing 85 straight games, including the postseason, between extra-inning rumbles on 7/31/19 vs. Louisville and 6/26/21 vs. St. Paul. The Clippers were also the last team to win an extra-inning game, toppling Omaha on 8/6 (snapped 5G losing streak in extras). The 85G regulation-inning streak was the longest for Columbus dating to the 1984 season (as far back as the day by day records go), as was 45 straight to start a season.

## Trending Downward

The current staff ERA of 5.49 is on pace to be the worst in franchise history (5.08, 1983) and anything over 4.71 will mark the fifth straight season in which the ERA has gotten worse. From 2011-16, the Clipper staff turned in a sub-4.00ERA five times in six seasons (zero such seasons from 1993-2010), including the best two ERAs of the past 32 years (3.33 in 2015 and 3.65 in 2016). The 5.76ERA at Huntington Park is the worst ever (5.29 in 2019, only time ERA has ever been over 5.00 at HP).

## Under Control

After three straight seasons leading the IL in strikeouts, the Clipper lineup is not threatening for a fourth, as they are currently 82K off the lead. To begin the season, they were averaging as many as 10 per game through the first 38G, but that has cooled considerably in recent weeks (8.32K per game since 7/6). The 2019 squad obliterated the franchise record, as they struck out 95 more times than the previous high (1,392; each of last three seasons rank among franchise's three worst, totalling 3,979K in 422G).

## Defense Doesn't Win Anything

When playing errorless baseball, the Clippers have a winning percentage that is marginally higher (.468, 22-25) than when they make a mistake in the field (.425, 17-23). After an exceptional defensive run from 2015-2019, in which the fielding percentage was never below .983 and the team never committed more than 88E, the 2021 team is on pace to botch 87 plays (adjusted for 140G season, have not had triple digits in errors since six straight seasons from 2009-14) with a fielding percentage of .982.

## One On, No Out Success

When the leadoff batter of an inning reached base in 2019, the Clippers plated him nearly 60% of the time (over 51% only once in the last six seasons, 55% in 2016). Getting more than one base was a specialty of Clipper hitters, as they led the IL with 136XBH to lead off the inning, including 54HR (led the IL, had 28 leadoff homers in 2018). So far in 2021, the Clippers are scoring the leadoff batter 53% of the time he reaches, with the leadoff batter scoring himself 27 times (on pace for 40HR).

## Good Baseball

**Trenton Brooks** advanced a pair of runners with a sac bunt on 8/14 vs. Toledo and both of them came around to score in the win (5-1 when advanced runner scores). During 2019, the Clippers struggled in the bunt department, but when the advanced runners scored, they were 7-1. During 2018, Columbus was 23-2 in games in which a run was scored after a good bunt attempt.

## No Difference

Through the first half of the season, in which the IL played with 18-inch bases (shortening the distance between bases by a whopping 4.5 inches), the Clippers saw a combined average of 1.71 stolen base attempts in their games (averaged 1.73 attempts per game over five seasons from 2015-19). However, since going back to normal bases, steal attempts are at 1.76 per game.

## Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** makes his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's second year as a manager (first with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 69-94 (.423), 39-48 with Columbus (.448).

### Mulligan, Please:

On 7/13 at St. Paul, Peacock was slated to pitch in relief of **Jean Carlos Mejia**, as opposed to starting the game. However, he found himself entering the game in the 3rd inning after Mejia had been pounded for 7ER. After getting out of Mejia's jam, Peacock did not survive the 4th, allowing nine of 10 batters to reach (5H, 2BB, 2HB; all nine scored, as he tied his career worst, 9ER in 4.0IP with Hagerstown at Lake County on 4/19/08).

### Comeback Trail:

Peacock began the season on the free agent market, recovering from arthroscopic surgery on his right shoulder last October. He threw for a number of teams during a showcase in Florida in mid-June, with Cleveland signing him to a minor league deal on 6/25. He was assigned to Columbus on 6/29.
