**BIG WOO BUMP DAY:** RHP Brandon Woodruff will make his sixth rehab start with the Sounds to start the series against the Stripers. His last outing was his longest of the season, working seven innings without an earned run allowed last Wednesday against Peoria while with High-A Wisconsin. It was a rain-shortened game, giving Woodruff the complete game on 74 pitches (52 strikes). He allowed five hits and matched his season-high with six strikeouts. He also had six in his May 6th start with Nashville against Norfolk. In eight total rehab starts in 2025, Woodruff has posted a 3-1 record with a 1.96 ERA, allowing eight earned runs (10 total) on 32 hits with 33 strikeouts and just nine walks over 36.2 IP. After allowing five earned through his first two starts, he has allowed five total over his last six as he continues to prepare to rejoin the Brewers rotation after missing all of 2024 while recovering from shoulder surgery.

**MAY RECAP:** The Sounds posted the fourth-most wins in the International League during the month of May with a 16-11 record. As a pitching staff, the Sounds owned the second-best team ERA in the IL at 3.60...Indianapolis took over the top spot with their 3.48 ERA in part by holding the Sounds to nine runs during the three-game slide to end the month. Nashville had the second-most triples hit as a team with 13 (Toledo, 18) and were third as a team with 51 stolen bases behind Jacksonville (55) and Lehigh Valley (53). The Sounds .257 AVG was 11th in the IL and the 18 home runs were tied for the 18th. **Anthony Seigler** led the International League in AVG (.386), OBP (.506), OPS (1.177), and was T-1st in triples (3). He also finished the month second in SLG (.671) and T-4th in SB (9) along with **Adam Hall**. **Oliver Dunn** ended the month T-2nd in the league for the most doubles (8)...**Jesus Liranzo** had three saves to finish tied for the third most in the IL behind Gwinnett's Wander Suero (5) and Charlotte's Dan Altavilla (4).

**GETTING WESTERN:** Wes Clarke produced his first multi-home run game since hitting a pair on May 10, 2024, while playing with Double-A Biloxi. Clarke is the fourth different Nashville player to have a multi-HR game in 2025, joining Jorge Alfaro, Daz Cameron, and Andruw Monasterio. Since the start of the 2023 season, Clarke has 53 home runs to lead the Brewers farm system and has 19 more than the next closest player in the organization. He ended a 16-game drought between home runs since hitting his last on May 2nd while on the road in Gwinnett. His six home runs this season are tied for the second most on the team.

**SEVEN EDDIE:** Eddie Rosario put together another multi-hit game against the Indians after finishing 2-for-5 with a double and two runs scored on Sunday. For the week, Rosario hit .440 (11-for-25) with three doubles, a home run, four RBI, five runs scored, and carried a .680 SLG with a 1.142 OPS. He played in all six games of the series and had four multi-hit games and his 11 total hits led the IL last week. Rosario enters the series against the Stripers with the longest active hitting streak on the team, having hit safely in each of his last seven games. Since May 24th, the former Atlanta Brave is hitting .429 (12-for-28) with four doubles, a home run, five RBI, and has seven runs scored.

**COVERING OUR EXTRA BASES:** The Sounds had 20 extra base hits in the six games played against Indianapolis. Bobby Dalbec led the way for Nashville with five of them including a double in the series finale on Sunday. Dalbec's five XBH were tied for the most in the IL last week and he was T-1st in the league with his four doubles. Dalbec ended the series hitting .333 (8-for-24) with six runs scored and five RBI with a hit in four of the six games he played.

**HIMMY HERRON:** Jimmy Herron turned in his first three-hit game of the season on Sunday afternoon out of the leadoff spot for the Sounds. Herron finished the game 3-for-5 with a walk and two runs scored. It was his ninth time batting leadoff for the Sounds who are now 5-4 when he starts the game at the top of the order. It was his first 3-hit game since September 13, 2024, while playing with Triple-A Albuquerque against Las Vegas.

**ANOTHER JORGE HOMER:** Jorge Alfaro joined Jared Oliva as the only other player to homer in consecutive games multiple times for the Sounds this season with his home run on Saturday night. Alfaro also had back-to-back games with a home run on April 19-20 on the road in Charlotte. Alfaro is now in a three-way tie for the third-most home runs in the International League with 11. Lehigh Valley's Otto Kemp leads the league with 13 home runs this year while Durham's Bob Seymour has 12.
