BULLS PULL AWAY FROM JUMBO SHRIMP

C.J. Hinojosa finished a home run shy of the cycle but Durham pulled away late on Wednesday to beat Jacksonville 14-8. After the Bulls plated a run in the first, the Jumbo Shrimp scored three in the bottom of the first to take the lead. Durham added four runs in the second, but in the bottom of the frame, Jacksonville tied the score with a pair of runs. The Jumbo Shrimp scored two in the fourth and one in the fifth to go up 8-5. However, a five-run Bulls seventh ceded the advantage back. Durham added three in the eighth and one in the ninth to win 14-8.

ACT ONE: SCENES 1, 2, 3 & 4

Jacksonville has played four thrilling games to begin the 2023 season. In Friday's series opener, Braden Shewmake launched a three-run walk-off home run for the Strippers to win 8-5. The Jumbo Shrimp responded Saturday with a last at-bat win of their own, this time taking the 11-inning affair 8-7. On Sunday, the pair of clubs dualed again, with Jacksonville outlasting Gwinnett in another 11-inning contest 13-12. Over the course of the season's first four games, the club's 80 half-innings thus far have ended with eight different lead changes and six ties.

JUST WIN, BABY

The Jumbo Shrimp have earned back-to-back winning marks for the first time since 2013-14. Thanks to a 75-55 (.577) mark in 2021 and an 80-69 (.537) record in 2022, Jacksonville's 155 wins over the last two seasons are the club's most in consecutive campaigns since the 163 victories piled up by the 2009-10 squads. In particular the last two years, Jacksonville has excelled on the road, with winning records in each campaign. Prior to 2021, the club's last winning record away from home was in 2014, finishing with a 42-28 road record.

RAGING BULLS

Durham, who won the 2022 Triple-A Championship, was the team who Jacksonville struggled the most with during the 2022 campaign. The Jumbo Shrimp were just 9-15 (.375) against the Bulls despite getting outscored by just one run, 117-116, during the season series. Of those 24 contests, 13 were decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville finished just 4-9 in those closely-decided affairs against their adversaries from the Bull City.

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

Despite owning a home record of 38-37 (.507) in 2022, the Jumbo Shrimp were world beaters on the road, posting a 42-32 (.568) record away from 121 Financial Ballpark. Of those 42 road wins, Jacksonville had 19 wins on the road against IL West opponents like Gwinnett. In 2022 contests away from 121 Financial Ballpark, the Jumbo Shrimp slashed .263/.337/.453. Jacksonville's .263 batting average on the road ranked third in the IL and their .790 OPS placed second in the circuit. In comparison, the club hit .250/.330/.398 at home. Of the 744 runs the Jumbo Shrimp scored in 2022, 409 came on the road (55.0 percent).

THE CHICKS DIG IT

Last season, the Jumbo Shrimp clubbed 183 home runs, which ranked sixth in the International League while also placing as the most in a season for a Jacksonville club since a franchise record of 200 in 1996. In fact, Jacksonville has eclipsed 100 long balls in a season just twice in the previous seven campaigns. Jacksonville particularly got hot at the back end of last season, as they smashed 47 home runs in their last 43 games. The Jumbo Shrimp hit most of their long balls on the road last year, launching 107 of their 183 home runs (58.5%) away from 121 Financial Ballpark, which was the highest home run total on the road in the IL.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

Jumbo Shrimp manager Daren Brown returns for his second year as Jacksonville's skipper. Brown holds a 1,342-1,327 (.503) record as a minor league manager. The Holdenville, Okla., native is in the midst of his third stint as a Triple-A skipper. The 55-year-old piloted Triple-A Tacoma in Seattle's organization from 2007-13 and again in 2019, tallying 494 victories, which marks the most wins of any manager in Rainiers franchise history. Brown led Tacoma to consecutive division titles in 2009 and 2010, and during that latter season, helped the Rainiers win the franchise's first outright Pacific Coast League Championship since 1969.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has cracked 7 home runs through four games, tied for the second-most in the International League... Despite a team OBP of .324 that ranks 14th, the club has scored the second-most runs in the circuit (34).

ABOUT LUIS

-Palacios was signed as a non-drafted free agent on July 2, 2016 by the Miami Marlins when he was 16 years old.

-He was first introduced to the states in 2019 to pitch for the GCL Marlins.

-In 2018, Palacios led the DSL with a 0.597 WHIP in 63.2 innings. He struck out 62 and walked four. They slashed just .155/.173/.183 off him.

-Palacios posted a 2.65 ERA in April in 17.0 innings. He struggled in the month of May (5.23 ERA in 31.0 innings), but pitched better in June (4.13 ERA in 24.0 innings).

Palacios earned a promotion from Low-A Jupiter to High-A Beloit on July 22. He was promoted again, this time to Double-A Pensacola, on September 9.

2021 SEASON

-Palacios pitched better at home with Low-A Jupiter in 2021. In six starts at home, he went 4-2 with a 2.83 ERA. However, in six road starts, he posted a 1-4 record and 5.10 ERA in 30.0 frames.

-Palacios held right-handed hitters to a .166 average and .549 OPS in 206 plate appearances. Left-handed batters batted .315 with a .969 OPS in 56 plate appearances.

-Opponents batted .167/.208/.313/.521 in 52 plate appearances with runners in scoring position.

2019 SEASON

-Palacios split the season as a starter and reliever. In four starts, he collected a 1.69 ERA (16.0 IP, 13 H, 2 BB, 17 K). In six relief appearances, he had a 0.74 ERA (24.1 IP, 12 H, 0 BB, 25 K).

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Palacios hails from Cagua in Venezuela. Cagua was established in 1620 as "Cagua La Vieja", a town of original Spaniards. Cagua was rebuilt in its current location in 1622 with the new name of "Nuestra Señora del Rosario de Cagua," which was changed to "San José de Cagua" during the 18th century. The city is now known simply as Cagua. The origin of the name comes from the indigenous Cumanagoto word "Cahigua," which means snail.
