RHP Patrick Copen (1-2, 5.17 ERA) vs. LHP Caden Grice (1-1, 4.11 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: Your Rancho Cucamonga Quakes continue a 12-game road trip with game two of a six-game series against the Visalia Rawhide (AZ) at Valley Strong Ballpark. At the completion of this six-game set, the Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, May 14, hosting the Inland Empire 66ers.

VS THE RAWHIDE: Today's game is the second of 30 meetings between the two clubs in 2024 and the second of 15 at Valley Strong Ballpark. Last season, the Quakes went 17-13 against the Rawhide, 10-8 here at Valley Strong Ballpark. LAST GAME: The Quakes fell a run short on Tuesday afternoon in Visalia, dropping a 5-4 decision to the Rawhide. Jordan Thompson had three hits and slugged two home runs (4, 5), but the rest of the Rancho offense was stymied, leaving eight men on base. Visalia reliever Hayden Durke (1-0) was credited with the win, while Yodin Chalas notched his third save of the year. Rancho starter Payton Martin (0-1) allowed two runs on six hits over just 2.2 innings, suffering the loss, the sixth in seven games on this road trip for the Quakes. The loss for the Quakes is their second straight overall and trims their lead over second-place Lake Elsinore down to three games.

**BAD TIMING:** The Quakes are in the midst of their worst stretch of baseball in 2024, as they've dropped six of their last seven, all on this current road trip. Injuries to key players have played a huge role, as Joe Vetrano, Josue De Paula and Zyhir Hope have all missed time on the current trip. De Paula was activated during the Modesto series and Vetrano makes his return to the lineup today. Hope is still on the Injured List with a shoulder injury. Logan Wagner has not played in a game since May 1, but is also not on the Injured List, after suffering several "hit-by-pitches" to the same area of his right leg.

"AIR" JORDAN: Jordan Thompson was a bright spot in Tuesday's loss to the Rawhide, finishing with three hits, including a pair of home runs. Thompson became the second Quake this year to record a multi-homer game, joining Jeral Perez who slugged a pair on April 20 at Inland Empire. Thompson has three homers in his last two games and has taken over the team lead with five round-trippers on the year and is now the "active" team leader with 15 RBIs. Jake Gelof, who was promoted to Great Lakes on Tuesday, leads the club overall with 26 RBIs, second in the league.

**ROSTER MOVES:** The Quakes made a pair of moves earlier today, as 1B Joe Vetrano was activated from the Injured List. RHP Carlos Duran was placed on the Development List in order to make room for Vetrano, who's been out since April 25 with a right shoulder injury. On Tuesday, 3B Jake Gelof was promoted to High-A Great Lakes of the Midwest League. Gelof was spectacular to start the year, leading the team in several offensive categories. Taking his spot on the roster will be infielder Oswaldo Ozorio, who opened the year on the Rancho roster, but was sent to Arizona just a few days into the season.

PATRICK COPEN: Right-hander Patrick Copen makes his fifth start and sixth appearance of the year, his first against the Rawhide. In his last outing overall, he allowed four runs on five hits over 3.2 innings in a loss at Modesto on May 2. In 2023, Copen made two starts for Rancho and also made two appearances in the playoffs. He was drafted by the Dodgers in the seventh round of the 2023 draft out of Marshall.

**CADEN GRICE**: Left-hander Caden Grice will make his fifth start and sixth appearance of the year, his first against the Quakes. In his last outing overall, he allowed one run on three hits over four innings in a loss at Stockton on May 1. Grice was drafted by Arizona as a competitive balance pick (#64 overall) out of Clemson in the 2023 draft.
