NOTES AND NUGGETS

GETTING TRANSACTIONAL

A handful of roster moves have been made in the last 48 hours, ahead of this week's series in Indianapolis.

Most notably, catcher **Carter Jensen** earned a promotion to Omaha and makes his Triple-A debut tonight ... the Royals' No. 3 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 82 overall prospect, Jensen was the Texas League leader in hits (80) and total bases (115), while ranking 6th with a .292 average (80-for-274) ... catcher **Brian O'Keefe** was released, having played 115 game for the Chasers over the last two years.

Additionally, **Kyle Wright's** rehab assignment concluded and he was optioned to Triple-A, while second baseman **Michael Massey** was sent to Omaha for a rehab, having been on Kansas City's Injured List since June 8 with a *left ankle sprain*, his 4th rehab assignment with Omaha since July 2023.

LET IT GO, LET IT GO ... CAN'T HOLD IT BACK ANYMORE

Today marks the beginning of the 2nd half in the 2025 International League season, with records for all teams re-setting at 0-0 ... the winner of the IL's 2nd half will play a best-of-3 league championship series against the Jumbo Shrimp.

Omaha finished 31-43 in the 1st half ... 12 games under .500 matches the furthest below .500 the Storm Chasers got in the 1st half, while the club peaked at 2 games over .500 twice.

33 of Omaha's 74 games (45%) were against teams with a winning record, and the Storm Chasers went 12-21 (.363) in such contests ... 42 of 74 games (54%) were at home, and Omaha went 17-25 (.404) at Werner Park.

36 of Omaha's 75 games in the 2nd half are against teams with winning records in the 1st half ... in the 2nd half, Omaha plays 33 of 75 games (44%) at Werner Park ... the Chasers make 2 trips to Indianapolis and Columbus, 12 games in each city, while playing 9 games in Des Moines, plus a 9-game trip to Buffalo and Syracuse.

SWEPT UP IN PAPIILLION

After sweeping the Toledo Mud Hens at Fifth Third Field, the Omaha Storm Chasers returned home and were swept by the Durham Bulls last week at Werner Park.

Since 2021, Omaha has been swept 6 times, including twice this season ... the Storm Chasers were swept in Toledo by the Mud Hens, April 22-27, then swept at home by the Durham Bulls, June 17-22.

Last week was the first time Omaha was swept in a 6-game series at home ... however, the Iowa Cubs took all 5 games the two teams played at Werner Park, August 8-13, 2023, the back half of an 11-game losing streak.

ALL QUIET ON THE OMAHA FRONT

After leading for 42 of 50 innings in Toledo (84%), the Storm Chasers led for 1 inning and trailed for 48 of 54 innings this week against Durham (89%).

In the first 3 games of this series, the Bulls scored in the first inning and led the rest of the game ... Omaha trailed for the final 7 innings of Friday's game, played from behind for 8 of 9 innings Saturday night, and trailed for the first 3 and last 3 innings Sunday evening ... Omaha's only lead in the entire series with the Bulls lasted approximately 8 minutes, as the Storm Chasers took a lead in the bottom of the 4th, then Durham tied the game up in the top of the 5th.

Prior to last week, Omaha trailed for 46 innings across the previous 20 games ... that represented just 27% of the team's 169 innings, dating back to May 25.

Omaha was outscored by Durham last week 49-23, a -26 run differential ... prior to the series with the Bulls, the Chasers' biggest negative run differential in a series was -14, when Norfolk outscored Omaha 44-30 April 15 to 20 ... when the Storm Chasers swept the Mud Hens, Omaha had a +26 run differential.

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits at the top of the Triple-A level in strikeouts, with 707 strikeouts this season ... that is the MOST of any Triple-A club and ranks 6th in Minor League Baseball (1st: Rancho Cucamonga Quakes, 751).

Over 639.2 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 9.95 K/9, which ranks 3rd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.

With 707 strikeouts through 74 games, an average of 9.55 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,423 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

Omaha has successfully stolen 109 bases this year, and only been caught 18 times ... 109 steals rank 4th in the International League and 5th in Triple-A.

109-for-127 in steal attempts is a 85.8% success rate, the 2nd-highest stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 5th-best among the 120 full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 88.9%, 57-for-63).

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
