LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn earned its second-straight win over Wilmington, 7-1, on Wednesday night...Blue Rocks scored first on a solo home run by CF **Andrew Pinckney** in the top of the 3rd...Cyclones tied the game in the bottom of the inning and took the lead for good on a 2B **D'Andre Smith** single in the 4th...RF **Stanley Consuegra** added a solo home run in the 5th...SS **Jett Williams** picked up a pair of knocks including scoring on a triple and an error in the 6th, adding an RBI single in the 8th...Smith and 3B **Jacob Reimer** also tallied multi-hit games...SS **Kevin Made** composed a multi-hit effort for Wilmington...RHP **Joshua Cornielli** (2.0 IP) and RHP **Joe Joe Rodríguez** (2.0) combined for 4.0 innings of 2-hit shutout relief to close out the Cyclones' win.

ON THE FINAL FEW CORKSCREWS: Brooklyn is looking to secure a second-straight playoff appearance...The Cyclones are 36-26 in the second half and are a game ahead of Jersey Shore (35-27) in the North Division of the SAL with 4 games left to play...The BlueClaws hold the tiebreaker over Brooklyn because of winning the season series (15-11).

KING STANLEY: OF **Stanley Consuegra** broke a tie with C **Francisco Álvarez** for the franchise record in career home runs by blasting his 23rd with Brooklyn in the top of the 5th on August 23 at Asheville...He added another blast on Wednesday and is 1 home run (21) behind Álvarez (22) for the single-season home run mark...He and Álvarez are the only two players in franchise history to record a 20-plus home run season...Entering Thursday, Consuegra is 4th in the SAL slugging percentage (.483), tied for 4th in home runs (21), tied for 7th in extra-base hits (40), and 8th in total bases (163)...Over his last 18 games since August 17, the 22-year-old is slashing .257/.325/.643 with a .968 OPS, adding 18 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 triples, 7 home runs, and 20 RBI...Since that date, Stanley has led the SAL in homers (7), RBI (20), total bases (45), and extra-base hits (11) in addition to being tied for the lead in triples (2).

JETT THE MET: INF **Jett Williams** has been stellar since he made his Cyclones debut on August 1 and all summer long...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .310/.470/.581 with a 1.051 OPS, 34 runs scored, 12 doubles, 3 triples, 8 home runs, 21 RBI, 45 walks, and 16 stolen bases in 45 games between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie...Since that date, no player in Minor League Baseball (min. 200 PA) has a higher on-base percentage (.470) and OPS (1.051)...On the season, Williams is tied for 3rd in Minor League Baseball in walks (99)...With one more walk, the Texas native will be the first teenager in MiLB to reach the century mark in free passes since the stat portal started in 2005...Since making his SAL debut, the Rockwall, Texas, native has led the circuit (min. 120 PA) in on-base percentage (.451), OPS (.996), and walks (30)...He is also tied for 2nd in extra-base hits (15), 3rd in slugging percentage (.545), tied for 3rd in stolen bases (10), 6th in batting average (.295), and tied for 4th in doubles (8) and hits (33) ...Among SAL players with at least 140 plate appearances in 2023, Williams is 2nd in the circuit in walk rate (20.8%) and OBP (.451) and 3rd in wRC+ (173), wOBA (.449), and OPS (.996).

DON'T TREAD ON US: Brooklyn's outfield has done a marvelous job neutralizing runners on the basepaths in 2023...Since MiLB's stat portal began in 2005, the Cyclones have set a franchise record for outfield assists in a single season with 40...The previous franchise high was 30 set back in the 2006 season...Entering Thursday, Brooklyn leads all High-A teams in outfield assists and has 7 more than the squad with the second-most (Asheville & Fort Wayne, 33)...Among all MiLB teams, the Cyclones' 40 outfield assists are tied for 6th...In addition, **Stanley Consuegra** and **Alex Ramírez** are tied for the team's single-season franchise record for individual assists with 11...That mark is tied for 2nd in the SAL this year behind Greensboro's **Sammy Siani** (12)...Before 2023, the previous single-season high for Brooklyn was 9 held by 6 different players.

CLIFF NOTES: OF **Ryan Clifford** has been an on-base machine since joining the Cyclones on August 3...The 20-year-old has reached base safely in 14 straight games dating back to the start of Brooklyn's two-week road trip...Since making his debut with the 'Clones, Clifford is tied for 6th in the South Atlantic League in home runs (6) and tied for 7th in walks (18)...The North Carolina native already has nearly as many walks (21) as he did in 30 fewer games (29 to 58) and 122 fewer plate appearances (128 to 250) than he had with Asheville before the trade...The 2022 11th-round pick enters Thursday leading the SAL in slugging percentage (.494), 3rd in home runs (22), 5th in OPS (.835), and 6th in RBI (65)...Clifford also leads in isolated power (.250) by a percentage point over teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** (.249), and 8th in wOBA (.371) and wRC+ (124).

LUGO LAND: INF **William Lugo** has been red hot over the last several weeks for Brooklyn...Lugo has reached safely in 12 consecutive games and is 14-for-42 at the plate (.333) with 6 runs scored, 3 doubles, 7 RBI, and 8 walks...Since August 15, Lugo is slashing .328/.410/.433 with a .843 OPS...Lugo has also scored 8 runs, picked up 5 doubles, a triple, 13 RBI, and 9 walks in 19 games...The Dominican native is tied for 5th in the league lead in hits (22) and tied for 7th in RBI (13) in that span.

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn returns home for the final regular season series in 2023 against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks possess 7 of Washington's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: 3B **Yohandy Morales** (8), LHP **Jake Bennett** (10), OF **Jeremy De La Rosa** (13), OF **Daylen Lile** (14), OF **T.J. White** (16), RHP **Andry Lara** (19)...De La Rosa is currently on the 7-day IL and White is on the Development List...Through the first 24 meetings of the season, Brooklyn is 14-12 against Wilmington, including 7-7 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones are 7-5 this year against the Blue Rocks at Frawley Stadium...The 'Clones are 40-36 all-time against the 'Rocks.

THE AMAZING ALEX: OF **Alex Ramírez** is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Thursday, the Dominican native is tied for the franchise record in hits (162) with INF **José Peroza** (162)...He surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (37), is 2nd in walks (69), tied for 2nd in RBI (87) with OF **Stanley Consuegra**, 3rd in total bases (239), runs scored (85), and RBI (86).

BEST IN SHOW: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been one of the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Thursday, Brooklyn has posted a 3.43 ERA (318 ER in 835.1 IP) over their last 96 games, holding a 53-43 record, which is the 2nd lowest in the minors...Tampa Bay's Single-A Charleston (3.36) holds the lowest mark...The Cyclones have hurled 10 shutouts in that span, tied for 3rd most in MiLB...For the entire season, Brooklyn holds the 5th-lowest ERA (3.74)...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 3rd lowest opposing OPS (.648), and 4th in hits-per-9 innings (7.33) and batting average against (.220).

THE DONUT SHOPPE: Brooklyn collected its 11th shutout win of the season with a 6-0 blanking at Greenville on Saturday...RHP **Robert Colina** (6.0 IP) and RHP **Joe Joe Rodríguez** (3.0) combined on the blanking...With Saturday's performance, the Cyclones have set a new franchise record for single-season shutouts...Before 2023, Brooklyn had accrued 10 shutouts in a season that happened on 4 separate occasions...It previously happened over 76 games in the New York-Penn League in 2014...The 11 shutouts are tied for the 5th-most in all of Minor League Baseball.

GRAB A SEAT: RHP **Robert Colina** became the 6th different Cyclone pitcher to strike out 10 or more batters in a game in 2023 when he whiffed 10 Drive batters on Saturday night...He joins RHP **Joander Suárez** who whiffed 11 vs. Aberdeen on August 11...RHP **Jordany Ventura** punched out 10 vs. Aberdeen on August 9, RHP **Cameron Foster** K'd 12 vs. Wilmington on July 29, RHP **Tyler Stuart** struck out 11 vs. Hudson Valley on June 22, and RHP **Blade Tidwell** accomplished the feat on 4 separate occasions...Only Greenville has as many pitchers (6) strike out 10-plus hitters in a game this year...Since 2005, only one other Brooklyn squad had 5 different arms punch out 10 or more in a single game during a season...In 2013, LHP **Dario Álvarez** (12; 7/24 @ LOW), RHP **Miller Díaz** (11; 8/23 @ VER), RHP **Robert Gsellman** (13; 8/24 @ VER), RHP **Dawrin Frías** (11; 8/27 vs. TRI), and RHP **John Gant** (7/26 @ ABD).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** entered as a pinch-runner and caught Hudson Valley napping to steal second base on July 21, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 36 swipes breaks INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 106 stolen bases in that span, which is 8th most in MiLB...De Los Santos has also snagged 57 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 49.


AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects...11 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF **Ryan Clifford** (No. 3), SS **Jett Williams** (4), C **Kevin Parada** (7), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (9), RHP **Christian Scott** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (12), 3B **Jacob Reimer** (14), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (22), RHP **Raimon Gómez** (24), RHP **Layonel Ovalles** (28), and RHP **Jordany Ventura** (29)...Williams (No. 98) and Clifford (99) also appear on the publication's list of Top 100 prospects...Former Cyclones listed include INF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 6), RHP **Mike Vasil** (8), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (19), OF **Matt Rudick** (20), and RHP **Junior Santos** (27)...In all, 16-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island...MLB Pipeline released their updated list, as well...8 members of the 2023 team are recognized...SS **Jett Williams** (No. 3), C **Kevin Parada** (5), OF **Ryan Clifford** (6), RHP **Blade Tidwell** (10), OF **Alex Ramírez** (11), RHP **Christian Scott** (12), IF **Jacob Reimer** (13), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (17), and RHP **Raimon Gómez** (25)...Former Brooklyn stars featured are: IF **Ronny Mauricio** (No. 4), RHP **Mike Vasil** (9), RHP **Dominic Hamel** (16), and OF **Matt Rudick** (27)...Williams (No. 84), Mauricio (93), and Parada (96) are recognized in the Top 100.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a second-straight no-decision in Game 2 of last Thursday's doubleheader at Greenville...Allowed just 1 run on 3 hits in 0.2 innings...Walked 1 and struck out 1...Tossed 32 pitches and 17 strikes (53.1%)...Relieved by RHP **Joshua Cornielly** with the bases loaded and 2 out in the bottom of the 1st and Brooklyn trailing, 1-0...All 3 bequeathed runners were stranded on a fielder's choice...Cyclones scored 1 in the 2nd to tie and 5 in the 5th to take the lead for good, defeating the Drive, 7-4...Greenville took the lid-lifter, 1-0.

JAWILME'S BIG BITE: Ramírez was outstanding in his High-A and Cyclones debut on August 3...The 21-year-old became the first Brooklyn pitcher in 2023 to work into the 9th inning, ultimately tossing a career-high 8.0 innings of 3-run ball...Ramírez allowed 6 hits, did not walk a batter, and struck out 4...The Dominican native was the first Brooklyn pitcher to complete 8-full innings and work into the 9th since RHP **Conner Grey** carried a no-hit bid into the 9th inning vs. Jersey Shore on July 16, 2021...Grey ultimately tossed 8.1 innings that day...No Cyclone pitcher has tossed a 9-inning complete game since RHP **John Gant** posted a 1-hit shutout on August 28, 2013, at Maimonides Park vs. Tri-City.

2023: Ramírez joined Brooklyn from Single-A St. Lucie on July 31...In 18 appearances (6 starts) in the Florida State League, the 21-year-old registered a 4-8 record with a 4.91 ERA (42 ER in 77.0 IP)...Issued 23 walks and struck out 61...Has thrived in a starting role, tallying a 2-2 record with a 2.89 ERA (9 ER in 28.0 IP) with 6 walks and 11 strikeouts in 6 starts...In 12 appearances out of the bullpen, Ramírez composed a 2-6 record with a 6.06 ERA (33 ER in 49.0 IP), 17 walks, and 50 strikeouts.

2022: Started the campaign with the Florida Complex League Mets...Named FCL Pitcher of the Year and a FCL Post-Season All-Star...Composed a 1-0 record with a 0.84 ERA (4 ER in 43.0 IP), 1 save, 6 walks (3.8 BB%), and 40 strikeouts (25.3 K%) in 11 appearances (6 starts)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 1...Made 2 relief appearances and accrued a 1-0 record...Did not allow a run on 2 hits over 3.1 innings, striking out 3 and walking 4.
