ABOUT BELOIT: The Beloit Sky Carp changed their name from Snappers after the 2021 season. This is Beloit's fifth season as an affiliate of the Miami Marlins. Beloit started as the Beloit Brewers in 1982 as the Midwest League affiliate of Milwaukee. They changed their name to the Beloit Snappers for the 1995 season. The Snappers affiliation with Milwaukee ended after the 2004 season. They were affiliated with the Minnesota Twins (2005-2012) and the Oakland Athletics (2013-2019). The Snappers played their final game at Pohlman Field on July 11, 2021 and moved into ABC Supply Stadium on August 3, 2021. Angel Espada is in his second season as the manager of the Sky Carp. Bill Hall, Prince Fielder, Rickie Weeks, Chris Bosio, Greg Vaughn, Joey Meyer, BJ Surhoff, Tim Lillard, Mitch Stetter, Matt Chapman, and Matt Olson played in Beloit.

ABOUT THE MARLINS: The Florida/Miami Marlins have lots of history in the Midwest League. The Marlins' first Low-A affiliate was the Kane County Cougars from 1993 through 2002. Josh Beckett, Adrian Gonzalez, Dontrelle Willis, Miguel Cabrera, and former Timber Rattlers manager Matt Erickson all played for the Cougars in that timespan. The Marlins returned to the Midwest League in 2019 to affiliate with the Clinton LumberKings. The Marlins landed in Beloit after MLB reset the affiliations for 2021.

WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER GAME ONE:

RHP BRYCE MECCAGE: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Meccage in the second round of the 2024 draft out of The Pennington School in New Jersey

FAMILY TIES: Meccage is the son of Jeremy Meccage, the former Pitching Coach at Princeton University and the nephew of Justin Meccage, current pitching coach of the San Francisco Giants.

GOING PRO: Meccage signed with Milwaukee over a college commitment to the University of Virginia.

PROSPECT WATCH: Meccage is rated as the #21 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. *Baseball America* has placed him at #26 in their rankings of Brewers prospects.

CAROLINA ON MY MIND: Meccage made his professional debut with the Carolina Mudcats in 2025. He was 1-4 with a 4.35 ERA in nineteen starts. Meccage walked 26 and struck out 69 over 70-1/3 innings.

LAST START: Meccage had a no decision at Fredericksburg on [September 3, 2025](#). He struck out three in one scoreless, hitless inning as he made a truncated start to end his season.

RHP ETHAN DORCHIES: The Milwaukee Brewers selected Dorchies in the tenth round of the 2024 draft out of Cary-Grove (IL) High School.

GOING PRO: Dorchies signed with the Brewers over a commitment to the University of Illinois-Chicago.

PROSPECT WATCH: Dorchies is rated as the #17 prospect in the Brewers system by *Baseball America*. MLB Pipeline has placed him at #20 in their rankings of Brewers prospects.

YEAR ONE: Gillis was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on August 11. He set a new professional single-game high for strikeouts with seven over 6-1/3 scoreless innings at Peoria on August 7.

LAST APPEARANCE: Dorchies came on in relief against Fredericksburg on [September 3, 2025](#). He pitched six shutout innings, allowed four hits, walked two, and struck out two.

LAST START: Dorchies lost to Delmarva at home on [August 28, 2025](#). He allowed six runs on six hits with three walks and eight strikeouts over five innings.

RHP LIOMAR MARTINEZ: The Miami Marlins signed Martinez as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on March 18, 2022.

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Martinez began his professional career with the Dominican Summer League Marlins in 2022. He was with the Florida Complex League Marlins in 2023 and split time between the FCL Marlins and Jupiter Hammerheads in 2024. Martinez spent all of 2025 with the Hammerheads in the Florida State League.

LAST SEASON: Martinez was 5-5 with a 3.30 ERA in 22 games – 20 starts – for the Hammerheads. He walked 41 and struck out 119 in 101 innings pitched.

LAST START: Martinez was the winning pitcher at Lakeland on [September 4, 2025](#). He allowed a run on five hits over 6-2/3 innings with no walks and four strikeouts.

VS. WISCONSIN: Martinez has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.

RHP AIDEN MAY: The Miami Marlins selected May out of Oregon State University in Competitive Balance Round B with the 70th overall pick of the 2024 draft.

BUSY BEAVER: May was 7-1 with a 3.05 ERA and 84 strikeouts over 73-2/3 innings in 14 starts for Oregon State in 2024 during his only season there. May started his college career at Arizona in 2023 with a 5-3 record and a 6.33 ERA in sixteen starts.

GETTING STARTED: May did not pitch professionally in 2024. He split time between the Florida Complex League and Jupiter of the Florida State League in 2025. He combined to go 1-1 with a 2.63 ERA in ten games – nine starts. May struck out 30 and walked 16 in 27-1/3 innings during his first pro season.

PROSPECT WATCH: May is rated as the #28 prospect in the Marlins system by MLB Pipeline.

LAST START: May had a no decision at Lakeland on [September 2, 2025](#). He walked two and struck out seven over 5-1/3 scoreless, hitless innings.

VS. WISCONSIN: May has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. This is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
