FRES-NOTES

PEREZ'S POWER PUNISHES THE PORTS: The Fresno Grizzlies (6-2) powered past the Stockton Ports (2-6) 9-2 Tuesday morning from Banner Island Ballpark. Fresno moved to 4-0 on the road (all wearing gray jerseys), 3-0 in the first game of a series and 2-0 in day contests. In the top of the second inning, the Grizzlies offense brought 11 botters to the plate, scoring seven runs, never looking back. Andy Perez had the big hit in the frame, a grand slam to right. Last year, the Grizzlies had one grand slam (Cole Carrigg on August 31 at Visalia, 10th inning). Perez finished the contest with a career-high five RBI. Fresno starter Jace Kaminska took a no-decision despite another outstanding start. The righty tossed three and two-thirds scoreless frames, allowing two hits and no walks while fanning four. Kaminska has not permitted a run over two starts, reaching eight and two-thirds total innings. Braden Carmichael did not throw a pitch, picking off Nathan Nankil at first to end the fourth. Lefty Isaiah Coupet (1-0) relished the win after three innings of relief. His only blemish was giving up a solo homer to Montero in the fifth. Jake Madden followed Coupet, walking four batters and awarding Nankil with one RBI. Brady Hill wrapped up the triumph facing a quartet of batters, punching out all four of them.

STOCK-PILING SOME STATS: The Fresno Grizzlies and Stockton Ports (Oakland Athletics Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game series tonight at Banner Island Ballpark. This is the first of five series between the clubs in 2024 and the first set in Stockton. The Grizzlies are 62-23 all-time (18-12 last year, fourth most wins all-time in a single-season vs. one team) against the Ports with a 31-6 all-time record (8-4 last year) at Banner Island Ballpark. In 2022, Fresno went 26-4 against Stockton with a +123 run differential (239-116). Those 26 wins broke the team record for the most victories against an opponent in a single season.

PEREZ PITCHES: Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to RHP Bryan Perez. Perez signed with the Rockies as an International Free Agent on January 15, 2021 out of the Dominican Republic at 16 years old. He was considered the Top Pitching Prospect Signee by the Rockies in that signing period. Perez is the nephew of former MLB All-Star, World Series champion and No-Hitter recipient Edinson Volquez.

PACHECO ALSO PITCHES: After Perez, the Grizzlies give the rock to LHP Albert Pacheco. Last year, Pacheco was assigned to Fresno from the ACL Rockies on June 7 and spent his entire season with the Grizzlies. Pacheco made 14 starts, going 7-4 with a 5.45 ERA. Over 72.2 innings, he struck out 69 batters. The 21-year-old signed as an international free agent by the Rockies in 2019.

GETTING INTO THE EARLY NUMBERS: The Grizzlies' pitching staff has struck out double-digit batters in seven of their first eight games this season (10, 5x, 11 and 13). Overall, Fresno arms have fanned 79 total batters in 2024. Yesterday, Fresno's lineup collected 13 walks, tied for the most free passes by the club in a single game this season. Seven of the nine batters drew a walk with five of them grabbing multi-walk affairs. The Grizzlies offense has walked 49 times over their last six contests, giving them 62 base-on-balls this year (1st in the California League, 3rd in Single-A).

AN ACE IN JACE: Grizzlies RHP Jace Kaminska has started his 2024 campaign in the best way possible. Over two starts (April 7-16), Kaminksa has not allowed a run spanning eight and two-thirds innings. He has permitted six hits and one walk while fanning 10 batters (0.81 WHIP, .194 batting average against him).

KING OF THE (BRADY) HILL: Grizzlies RHP Brady Hill has struck out five batters in a row spanning two games (April 11-16). Hill's four punchouts on April 16 at Stockton was a career-high.

JAKE IS DEFINITELY NOT ON THE "SNIDE"R: Outfielder Jake Snider has had an impressive start to the season, going 6-for-21 (.286 AVG/.571 OBP/.619 SLG/.1190 OPS) with one homer, one triple, two doubles, five RBI, 12 runs, 13 walks and one stolen base. Snider's triple on April 7th (Sunday) in San Jose was his 11th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him two triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ: Grizzlies INF Andy Perez has hit safely in all eight games to start this season, one shy of his longest hit streak while in a Fresno uniform. Perez is 11-for-35 (.314 AVG/.368 OBP/.629 SLG/.997 OPS) with two homers (one grand slam), one triple, three doubles, 12 RBI, six runs and three walks.

EJ AND THE SB: Dating back to last season, Grizzlies' outfielder EJ Andrews Jr. has stolen 12 bases, one in 12 different games. Fresno is 12-0 when Andrews Jr. swipes a base, with all 12 games ending within five runs.

RAIN IN FRESNO?!: The Fresno Grizzlies and Inland Empire 66ers weekend was washed away as two games (Saturday and Sunday) were rained out due to inclement weather and field conditions. The clubs will most likely make up the pair of games when the teams meet at San Manuel Stadium April 30-May 5. Those soon-to-be scheduled doubleheaders would be the first for the Grizzlies since April 24, 2022 vs. Lake Elsinore (rained out April 21). Fresno was swept in that doubleheader 6-1 in Game 1 and 6-2 in 8 innings in Game 2 (technically, extras).
