### Jumbo Shrimp fall to IronPigs in series opener

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp fell to the Lehigh Valley IronPigs 6-2 in Tuesday's series opener from 121 Financial Ballpark. The Lehigh Valley IronPigs (10-11) struck first with a four-spot in the top of the third against Jacksonville (10-10) starter Jake Walters (0-1). **Jim Haley** and **Esteban Quiroz** knocked consecutive one-out base hits and Weston Wilson walked to load the bases. Jordan Qsar followed with an RBI single, plating Haley from third. Then, a walk, sacrifice fly and a double steal brought in three more runs extending the IronPigs lead to four.

### GO C.J., GO C.J., GO C.J., GO

On Jacksonville's slugging offense, perhaps no one has shined more than **C.J. Hinojosa**. Through 16 games thus far in 2023, Hinojosa is 22-for-65, slashing a robust .343/.373/.614/.987 with two doubles, one triple, five home runs, 17 RBIs and 10 runs scored. The Houston native ranks tied for 16th in the International League in RBIs, 10th in batting average, 15th in slugging, 20th in OPS and tied for 9th in hits. The Houston, Texas native has hits in eight of his last 11 games entering play on Tuesday.

### THE \*START\* OF SOMETHING?

Jacksonville starting pitchers have ceded three runs or fewer in 10 of their last 12 games. During that span, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have yielded 25 runs, 23 earned, on 55 hits in 61.2 innings for a 3.36 ERA. This stretch has not seen Jacksonville starters strike out many opponents, with the club's rotation registered just 41 punchouts (6.0 K/9). However, they have only issued 14 walks during this run, a rate of 2.0 per nine innings.

### WALKING ON SUNSHINE

Over the season's first eight games, Jacksonville mustered only 25 walks, the second-fewest such total in the International League. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have shown a significant amount of patience of late; Jacksonville has registered 60 free passes over the last 12 games since April 11, a figure that ranks seventh in the league. During this stretch, 12.7 percent of their plate appearances. The MLB average is roughly 8.6 percent. The Shrimp walked in just 7.6 percent of plate appearances in their first eight games.

### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Jacksonville bested Nashville at home last week, winning three-of-five in the series, with all three coming by exactly one run. Thus, of the team's first 10 victories in 2023, six have come by one run with an additional triumph by two tallies. Consequently, the Jacksonville's six wins in such games tops the league. The Jumbo Shrimp are 6-1 (.857) in one-run affairs after posting a 19-19 (.500) such record in those closely-decided games during the 2022 season.

### BYE-BYE BURDICK

Coming into 2023, **Peyton Burdick** hadn't recorded a multi-homer game since bashing two in Biloxi on August 4, 2021 while playing for Double-A Pensacola. The Cincinnati native has already registered two multi-homer games this season, and his eight on the season are tied for second in the International League. Burdick is tied for fourth in the IL in extra-base hits (12), tied for sixth in hits (25), tied for ninth in RBIs (18), tied for sixth in runs scored (19), ninth in slugging (.654) and 13th in OPS (1.039). Without recording a hit last Friday, Burdick's team-leading 15-game hitting streak came to a close.

### LEADERS, NOT FOLLOWERS

The Jumbo Shrimp weren't able to get a first inning tally on April 14, which ended their streak of five consecutive games with a first inning run. Still though, over their 19 games played, the Jumbo Shrimp have struck for at least one tally in their first at-bats 10 times. Jacksonville has scored first over their opponent in 10 of their 19 games thus far in 2023, going 7-3 (.700) when doing so. Conversely, the club has struggled when falling behind, going just 3-6 (.333). The Jumbo Shrimp scored the game's first run 83 times during the 2022 season (55.7 percent) and had a 62-21 (.747) record when doing so.

### SHRIMP BITES

By taking three out of five games from Nashville in a rain-shortened series last week, the Jumbo Shrimp recorded their first home series win in 2023. They are 2-1-1 in their sets thus far... Tuesday's meeting with the IronPigs will mark the first-ever game between Jacksonville and Lehigh Valley. The IronPigs joined the International League in 2008, with Jacksonville rejoining the IL in 2021.

### ABOUT RONALD

-Before coming to the United States, Bolaños played for Mayabeque of the Cuban National Series. He signed with the San Diego Padres as an International free agent on August 11, 2016.

-The Padres selected Bolaños' contract and promoted him to the major leagues for the first time on September 2, 2019. He made his major leagues debut on September 3rd vs. the Arizona Diamondbacks, allowing two runs over six innings pitched.

-On July 16, 2020, Bolaños and outfielder Francy Cordero were traded to the Kansas City Royals in exchange for LHP Tim Hill.

-On April 16, 2023, Bolaños signed a minor league deal with the Miami Marlins.

-Entering the 2023 season, Bolaños has pitched in 18 major league games, including five starts with Kansas City and San Diego. In those games, he is 0-4 with a 5.25 ERA. Over 48.0 innings, he has yielded 49 hits and struck out 43 against 29 walks.

-When he was signed by San Diego, the then-19-year-old was ranked by MLB.com as the No. 20 international prospect in the 2016 class and ranked by Baseball America as the fourth-best Cuban pitcher available.

-In 2014, he played in the COPABE 18U Pan American Championship in Mexico.

-The Cuban-native came up as an outfielder before converting to a pitcher.

### 2023 SEASON

### 2022 SEASON

-With Triple-A Omaha, went 0-1 with a 3.52 ERA in four starts. Over 15.1 innings, yielding 17 hits and struck out 16 against four walks. However, over 24 relief appearances with the Storm Chasers, he posted an 0-3 record with a 7.63 ERA. In those relief appearances, he allowed 42 hits in 26.2 innings and struck out 18 against 14 walks.

### 2021 SEASON

-Bolaños began the year with Triple-A Omaha and made four starts before joining the Royals on June 4th. He closed the season with the Storm Chasers.

### 2020 SEASON

-Made a pair of starts, July 26 at Cleveland and Aug. 1 vs. the White Sox... Took the loss in his first start, allowing two unearned runs on three hits and a walk over 2.0 innings.

-Became the third Cuban-born pitcher to start a game for the Royals, joining Onelki García (2017) and Zip Sánchez (1988).
