YESTERDAY: The Captains extended their winning streak to four games with a 6-3 win over the Beloit Snappers. Christian Cairo broke a 3-3 tie in the bottom of the sixth with a two-run homer and José Tena added a solo blast in the eighth for insurance. Raynel Delgado also homered for the second straight game. Andrew Misiaszek held Beloit scoreless over 2.1 relief innings and struck out six for the win. Cade Smith earned his first Captains save, striking out two in a scoreless ninth.

THAT'S A WINNING STREAK: The Captains' four-game winning streak matches a season-high. This is the third time the Captains have won four in a row and the first time since June 15-19.

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains hold the second playoff position entering today's game. The Captains are tied with the Cedar Rapids Kernels, but own the tiebreaker (best winning percentage over the final 20 games). Lake County is also one game ahead of the Great Lakes Loons. The Captains would not own the tiebreaker against Great Lakes (head-to-head record). All three teams are separated by 1.0 game. The Quad Cities River Bandits have clinched the top seed.

RUNNERS STRANDED: The Captains have struggled with runners in scoring position recently. Over the last nine games, Lake County has batted .155 (13-for-84) with men in scoring position and left 60 runners aboard (6.67 per game).

SLUMPING: The Captains' offense has the league's lowest team batting average (.205) in September. Six Captains hitters with 25+ plate appearances this month have batting averages under .200.

SCORING LATE: During their current four-game winning streak, the Captains have scored the go-ahead run in the sixth inning or later three times. A six-run seventh inning propelled the Captains to a come-from-behind win on Sunday. Raynel Delgado broke a 6-6 tie in the eighth with a pinch-hit two-run homer on Wednesday. Christian Cairo broke a 3-3 tie with a sixth-inning two-run homer on Thursday.

#### TRENDS & NOTABLES

Jhonkensy Noel: Among all minor league hitters with 250+ plate appearances, Noel is fourth in OPS (1.031), fifth in wRC+ (168), fifth in batting average (.348) and sixth in slugging percentage (.633).

Micah Pries: Is slashing .296/.367/.444 (.811) over the last seven games. This comes after a 10-game stretch when Pries slashed .172/.294/.414 (.708 OPS).

Christian Cairo: Has a 1.063) over his last seven games with two homers, three doubles and six walks.

Quentin Holmes: While Holmes is only hitting .190 in nine September games, he also has an .917 OPS in that span. Holmes is slashing .190/.393/.524 in that stretch with seven walks and five steals. Last Friday, Holmes hit his first home run since June 11.

José Tena: Tena is hitting 4-for-8 with a homer and two doubles over the last two games. This comes after an 11-game stretch when he went 7-for-40 (.175) with 16 strikeouts and two walks.

Joe Donovan: Donovan is 3-for-28 (.107) over his last 10 games. Two of his three hits are home runs.

Raynel Delgado: Delgados is 3-for-4 with two homers and a walk this series. This comes after an eight-game stretch when he was 3-for-29 (.103).

SUPERLATIVES: Baseball America recently released its annual list of the best tools among minor league prospects in each league, as voted on by minor league managers. Several Captains made the cut. Daniel Espino was tabbed for the best breaking ball in the High-A Central League. Joe Naranjo was named best defensive first baseman. José Tena was awarded both best defensive shortstop and best infield arm. Greg DiCenzo was named best manager prospect.

NEW BLOOD: 3B Jhonkensy Noel joined the Captains on August 17. The 20-year old led all of Low-A (minimum 160 PA) with a .393 batting average and a 190 wRC+, while hitting 11 homers. INF Christian Cairo and OF Jonathan Rodríguez joined the Captains on August 24. Cairo led Low-A Lynchburg with 37 walks and held a .364 on-base percentage, which led all Hillcats (minimum 200 PA). Rodríguez slashed .314/.363/.450 with the Hillcats, good for an .812 OPS

**LAST TIME OUT:** Gaddis took a hard-luck loss after striking out nine and holding the Dayton Dragons to one run over 5.2 innings last Friday. Gaddis retired the first 10 batters he faced and held Dayton scoreless through the first five frames. The right-hander allowed a two-out double to Matt McLain in the sixth, followed by an RBI single by Ivan Johnson. The Captains lost, 4-1.

INNINGS EATER: Gaddis is second behind Mason Hickman for the Captains lead in innings pitched, throwing 92.1 innings to Hickman's 92.2. Gaddis has gone five or more innings in 10 consecutive starts. Over that span (which includes one four-inning relief appearance), Gaddis has a 2.79 ERA (19 ER, 61.1 IP) with 78 strikeouts and 13 walks.

**STRIKEOUT STUFF:** Gaddis has struck out eight batters or more in each of his last three outings. He has struck out 27 and walked just three in those 15.1 innings for a 9.0 K/BB rate and a 15.8 K/9 rate.

**HOMER PRONE:** Gaddis leads the Captains and is second in the High-A Central League with 17 home runs allowed. 45.6% of Gaddis' runs allowed this year have come on homers (57 R, 26 via HR). Since the start of July, 63.3% of Gaddis' runs allowed have been on home runs (30 R, 19 via HR).

**NO MORE LOONS, PLEASE:** Gaddis has allowed 41.1% of his home runs and 34.1% his earned runs against the Great Lakes Loons. Gaddis has a 8.04 ERA against Great Lakes (4 G, 3 GS, 15.2 IP, 14 ER, 7 HR) and a 2.84 ERA against all other teams in the High-A Central League (15 G, 15 GS, 85.2 IP, 27 ER, 10 HR).

**PROSPECTING**: Gaddis ranks as Cleveland's #28 prospect, according to FanGraphs. He is unranked on Cleveland's top prospect lists published by MLB.com and Baseball America. 2019: Across 13 appearances and 11 starts in 2019, Gaddis posted a 2.73 ERA across two levels – the Rookie Level Arizona League Indians Blue and Short Season Mahoning Valley.

NO-HITTER: On August 23, 2019, Gaddis threw three perfect innings after a 93-minute rain delay to begin what turned into a combined no-hitter against the Williamsport Crosscutters. It was the first no-hitter for Mahoning Valley since 2013. After Gaddis left the game, RHP Matt Waldron and RHP Luis Sanchez finished the game for the Scrappers. Gaddis set his career high with six strikeouts, throwing 35 pitches in the outing. Also in the starting lineup for Mahoning Valley that day were current Captains INF Brayan Rocchio, C Bryan Lavastida and OF Will Brennan

**GEORGIA STATE STAR**: Gaddis is in the history books as an all-time great at Georgia State finishing his career with a program best 3.81 ERA. He also is second all-time in program history with 266 strikeouts, fourth in innings pitched (266.2) and sixth in games started (40). His junior season he finished with 112 strikeouts to lead the Sun Belt and finish 14th in the country. He wrapped up 2019 with his second consecutive second-team allSun-Belt selection.

**PANTHER PRO'S**: David Buchanan is currently the only Georgia State Panther to ever make the big leagues. Gaddis is trying to become the second, after being drafted in the 5th round at 160 overall he is also the highest ever draft pick from Georgia State. Buchanan was a starting pitcher from 2014-15 for the Philadelphia Phillies and was drafted in the seventh round of the 2010 draft.

**TEAM USA**: In 2017 Gaddis became the first ever player from Georgia State to be chosen by Team USA when he joined the USA Collegiate National Team.
