Tonight: The Lugnuts play the second game of a six-game series at the West Michigan Whitecaps, the second of 24 meetings between the intrastate archrivals this season. This is the 382nd all-time meeting between the Nuts and 'Caps, dating back to 1996 when West Michigan was affiliated with the Oakland A's and the Lugnuts were affiliated with the Kansas City Royals. Lansing won the series opener last night, with three pitchers combining on the ballclub's second shutout of the season.

Last Night: Lugnuts 2, Whitecaps 0. Lansing starter Rafael Kelly scattered four hits and a walk in five innings, Brady Basso blanked the Whitecaps from the sixth through the eighth innings (aided by a runs-saving, inning-ending catch by left fielder Shane Selman), and Jack Weisenburger (Rockford H.S. / University of Michigan) worked a perfect ninth to complete a six-hit shutout in the Nuts' series-opening triumph. The only runs of the game were scored on a run-scoring wild pitch in the seventh and a Jordan Díaz RBI double in the eighth.

What's New in 2021: Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, the Nuts moved up to the High-A Central, and they accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

# Lug. Notes: Headlines and Points of Interest

Meet the Boss: Scott Steinmann is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017). More info about the skipper can be found on the next page of these notes.

Roster News: Outfielder Jake Suddleson was promoted to Double-A Midland yesterday, with no corresponding move made, leaving the Nuts' roster at 29 players.

Opening Strong: With yesterday's victory, the Lugnuts have now prevailed in five of six series openers this season.

A Hail to Arms: The Lugnuts' pitching staff tops the High-A Central with a 3.09 earned run average, nearly a full run lower than second-place Great Lakes (4.04). The Nuts have walked the second-fewest batters (95), struck out the second-most hitters (328), allowed the third-fewest home runs (21) and recorded the best GO/AO ratio (1.31) in the league.

A Breath of Relief: The bullpen has been a strength for the Lugnuts, with a 2.66 ERA and 202 strikeouts (compared to 50 walks) in just 152 innings. Lugnuts relievers Aiden McIntyre (13) has appeared in more games than any other league relief pitcher.

Getting Hits and Getting Hit: The Nuts lead the league in doubles (70) and HBPs (31); and ranks second in at-bats (1035) and batting average (.240); tied for third fewest strikeouts (272); and are third in hits (248) and total bases (404).

Thou Shalt Not: Stealing bases has been a difficult proposition against the Nuts, who have nabbed a league-best 16 runners in 51 attempts.

An Eagle Flying High: Infielder Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S. / Eastern Michigan University) is first in the league in HBPs (9), tied for second in steals (20), tied for second in runs scored (28), tied for fourth in doubles (9) and fifth in OBP (.425). Schuemann's SB and HBP totals are both tied for third in all of MiLB.

Halted: Infielder Max Schuemann went 0-for-5 last night to end his team-high on-base streak at 24 games. The longest current on-base streak on the team now belongs to outfielder Michael Guldberg at 18 games, though Guldberg has not played since May 29th.

Highs and Lows: The Lugnuts have scored at least seven runs in a game 12 times this season, but have also scored two runs or fewer in a game 13 times. If the offense does get going, chances are it's going to happen late: Lansing's biggest inning this year is the 8th (30 runs).

Keys to Success: When Lansing scores more than two runs in a game, the club is 13-5. When it scores two runs or fewer, the record is 2-11, with the second win coming yesterday. Additionally, when the Nuts outhit the opposition, they are 12-1 this season, with the 12th win last night. When they get outhit, however, they are 1-14.

# **TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY**

2013: The Lugnuts played a doubleheader at West Michigan for the second straight day. Game 1 went to extra innings before Jared Reaves walked it off with an RBI single in a 4-3 Whitecaps win. Game 2 saw the Lugnuts' third shutout in four games, with Roberto Osuna pitching five innings, Wil Browning the final two and Kevin Patterson's two-run homer supplying the scoring in a 2-0 victory. The Nuts only had two hits in the game, and so did the Whitecaps. Time of game: 1:26.

**2017:** Bo Bichette went 0-for-3 with two walks, ending his league-leading 17-game hitting streak, in a 5-4 loss at Fort Wayne. TinCaps starter Ronald Bolaños struck out nine in five innings for the TinCaps...

Major League Lugnuts: Two former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, pitcher Ty Tice '18 and outfielder Josh Palacios '16-'17, with the duo making their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: Carlos Febles and Carlos Beltrán for the Kansas City Royals.

Familiar Settings: 14 of the 30 Lugnuts active players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members Scott Steinmann, Don Schulze and Anthony Phillips all have experience in the league.

A Lineup of Starters: The Lugnuts have used nine starting pitchers this year, namely Brady Basso, Reid Birlingmair, Jeff Criswell, Stevie Emanuels, Richard Guasch, Rafael Kelly, Colin Peluse, Seth Shuman and Shohei Tomioka.

A Pleasant Peninsula Surrounds You: Max Schuemann (Portage Northern H.S.) is the first Lugnut from Eastern Michigan University and Jack Weisenburger (Rockford H.S.) is the fourth and fifth Michigan Wolverines to play in Lansing (following Troy Miller, Jake Fox, Rich Hill and Jeff Criswell).

Finally: Pitchers Stevie Emanuels and Shohei Tomioka, catchers Jared McDonald, Drew Millas and William Simoneit, first baseman Patrick McColl, and outfielder Michael Guldberg are all making their pro debut this season.

Front Office Connections: Lugnuts pitching coach Don Schulze was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations Billy Beane was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman Patrick McColl set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

Clubhouse of Higher Learning: The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman Patrick McColl played for Harvard, reliever Michael Danielak was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher William Simoneit spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

Power Five Baseball: The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (Michael Guldberg, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (Brady Basso, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (Jeff Criswell and Jack Weisenburger, Michigan; Dalton Sawyer, Minnesota); and the SEC (Cobie Vance, Alabama, and Ryan Gridley, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (Stevie Emanuels, Washington).

International Appeal: In addition to 16 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, Nevada, North Carolina, Ohio, Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

Representing His Country: 1B/3B Jordan Díaz played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

**Teammates Then, Teammates Now:** Several of the Nuts are familiar with one another. **Reid Birlingmair** and **Charlie Cerny** pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago, and **Jeff Criswell** and **Jack Weisenburger** pitched together in Ann Arbor. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons, but **William Simoneit** played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing **Colin Peluse** by a year.





Cubs added two runs in 7th, one in 8th against Michael Danielak, beating Lugnuts, 4-1... catcher: Drew Millas.


# 2021 in Lansing:

- Started on Opening Day, May 4 vs. Lake County, and dominated the Captains: 4 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 7 K, needing only 50 pitches (37 strikes)... both hits allowed were Bryan Lavastida singles... departed with Lugnuts leading, 7-0... Nuts went on to win, 8-1... catcher: Drew Millas.
- Did not pitch again until starting May 15 at Dayton, tossing two perfect innings on 29 pitches (21 strikes) with 2 K's... catcher: William Simoneit.
- Appeared in relief May 20 at Fort Wayne, as part of four-pitcher, 18 strikeout gem; followed Richard Guasch, who threw five scoreless innings with seven strikeouts; handled the 6th and 7th innings with 5 K's, allowing solo HR to Dwanya Williams-Sutton; Lugnuts won, 12-1... catcher: William Simoneit.
- Started vs. Great Lakes, May 27... tossed 2 2/3 innings, allowing three hits, two walks, one HBP, one run and striking out four in Lugnuts 10-1 loss to the Loons... Loons broke the game open with nine unearned runs in the sixth inning against Richard Guasch and Charles Hall, handing Lugnuts a 10-1 defeat... catcher: William Simoneit.

**Professional Career Entering 2021:** Drafted 194th overall in the 6th round from Georgia Southern in 2019, signed for \$235,000 (one round in front of Lugnuts teammate Drew Millas)... one of 10 2019 draftees on the Lugnuts roster... made pro debut with Short-Season A NYPL Vermont Lake Monsters on June 29, 2019... of 14 runs allowed in 11 games in 2019, nine came in two poor outings; dominated otherwise, finishing with back-to-back five-inning scoreless performances.

Family Ties: Seth's father, Bart, was the starting shortstop on the 1979 NCAA Division-II National Champion Valdosta State Blazers, hitting .277 and striking out just eight times in 61 games... sister, Sloan, was a two-time national champion cheerleader at Valdosta State... brother, Scott, nine years older (first name: Rutherford), was drafted in the 19th round in 2009 by Tampa Bay from Auburn University and pitched in the Midwest League with the 2010 Bowling Green Hot Rods (3.01, 14 saves, 46 G, 71 2/3 IP, 38 BB, 111 K), rose as high as Double-A, and spent the 2019 season as a relief ace for independent Lancaster.

**Glory Days on the Diamond:** Coached by his father, Bart, at Valdosta High School... named Region 1-6A Pitcher of the Year as a senior after posting 1.53 ERA, with 80 strikeouts and 15 walks in 59 innings... tossed a no-hitter vs. Tift HS... 1st-team All-Region infielder, hitting .313 with 20 BB / 13 K.



Saying No to the O's: Shuman was drafted in the 39th round from Valdosta HS in 2016 by the Baltimore Orioles, 11 picks ahead of the Toronto Blue Jays' selection of 2018 Lugnuts outfielder Chavez Young... Orioles drafted his high school teammate, DL Hall, 21st overall in 2017, signing him for \$3 million... Baltimore drafted a third Valdosta HS baseball player, outfielder Colby Thomas, in the 37th round in 2019, but Thomas turned down the Orioles to attend college (in his case, Mercer University).

Speaking of Valdosta: The only Valdosta Wildcat to make the Major Leagues to date is Buck Coats, who played for the Chicago Cubs (2006), Cincinnati Reds (2007) and Toronto Blue Jays (2008). Coats, coincidentally, played two full seasons with the Lugnuts, 2002 and 2003, totaling 265 games and 989 at-bats.

Transitioning from Football to Baseball in Statesboro: Wore No. 10 and played in four games as a freshman QB on Georgia Southern football team, taking 114 snaps, in 2016-2017, passing for 357 yards and a touchdown and rushing for 39 yards... considered a walk-on with Georgia Southern baseball due to football scholarship, and split his time between baseball and spring football... quickly impressed as an impact pitcher as a freshman, going 8-0, 3.34, 46 2/3 IP, 49 K, and received the honor of the start in Sun Belt Tournament Championship game vs. South Alabama (received no-decision)... left football team after freshman year to gain full baseball scholarship... named Preseason All-Sun Belt Conference in 2019 (3.83, 16 GS, 91 2/3 IP, 27 BB, 114 K)... earned nickname "The Franchise" at Georgia Southern because of his importance to the program during his three years.

Fly Eagles Fly: Georgia Southern University baseball has produced 17 Major Leaguers, led by Joey Hamilton, John Tudor, Scott Fletcher, Todd Greene, Sam Howard, longtime MiLB manager Marty Pevey, and longtime MiLB manager John Tamargo Sr., father of the former Lugnuts hitting coach and manager John Tamargo, Jr.

A Fun Georgia Southern Note: The Eagles' most notable game in team history might have been on March 15, 2008, when they hit 14 home runs in a 26-8 victory over Columbia. In the eighth inning alone, the Eagle crushed five homers, including three consecutive shots by pinch-hitters. "I thought we took some good swings, and certainly conditions with the wind were right for it today, as well," coach Rodney Hennon said afterward.
