TODAY'S GAME: The Memphis Redbirds continue a six-game homestand against the Charlotte Knights at AutoZone Park. Left-handed pitcher Connor Thomas is slated to start for Memphis opposite right-handed pitcher Johan Dominguez. First pitch for game four of the series is scheduled for 7:05 p.m. CDT.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Memphis Redbirds continued a six-game homestand with a 5-2 victory over the Charlotte Knights on Thursday night at AutoZone Park in a game that was resumed in the bottom of the first inning. With two strikes and two runners on base in the bottom of the eighth inning, designated hitter Cesar Prieto smoked a ball to the wall in left center field. As the left-handed hitter slid into third, the ball struck Prieto, allowed him to score on the play and gave Memphis a 5-2 lead. Earlier in the game, center fielder Chase Pinder clubbed a two-run home run to left-center field. The blast was Pinder's fifth home run of the season. Sem Robberse dominated in his 6.0-inning relief appearance. The right-handed pitcher allowed one run on five hits, struck out eight batters and walked two. The 6.0 innings are the most Robberse has thrown at Triple-A this season. Thursday's originally scheduled game has been postponed and will not be rescheduled.

REDBIRD ROTATION: The original starting pitching rotation for Memphis has had immense success at the minor league level. The five include three St. Louis Cardinals Minor League Pitchers of the Year (Hudson 2018, Liberatore 2021 and Graceffo 2022), the 2022 Arizona Fall League Pitcher of the Year (Connor Thomas) and the 2022 Cardinals minor league/International League wins leader (Tommy Parsons, 12). The most recent addition to the crew is No. 4 Cardinals prospect Michael McGreevy. Memphis has since added three new arms, each acquired via trade at the MLB Trade Deadline.

HAPPY 25th, REDBIRDS!: To commemorate the 25th anniversary season, the Memphis Redbirds will have a select number of giveaways centered around the club's past players and events. On Saturday May 20, the first 1,500 fans had the chance to celebrate 25 seasons of history with the original Memphis Redbirds jersey as worn by many greats including Albert Pujols, Adam Wainwright and more! In a further nod to the history of baseball in Memphis, on August 4, the first 1,500 fans will receive The blue Memphis Chicks jersey featuring the blue and red Memphis wordmark. The Redbirds will also wear Memphis Chicks jerseys every Thursday home game for Throwback Thursday.

TOP PROSPECTS IN MEMPHIS: As evident with the young success at the Major League level for the St. Louis Cardinals, Memphis plays a key role in development for the big club. Currently, 10 of MLB Pipeline's Top-30 prospects in the St. Louis Cardinals organization are currently playing in Memphis: Masyn Winn (1), Gordon Graceffo (3), Michael McGreevy (5), Ivan Herrera (6), Moises Gomez (11), Connor Thomas (14), Jake Walsh (21), Ryan Loutos (23), Guillermo Zuniga (27) and Luken Baker (30). Masyn Wynn (36) earned a slot in the current top-100 overall prospect list for MLB Pipeline. RHP Tink Hence (currently with Peoria) is also in the top-100 (58).

MANAGER BEN JOHNSON

Ben Johnson enters his fifth season as manager of the Memphis Redbirds and his fifth year in the Cardinals organization.

COACHING CAREER

- 203 - 215 managerial record entering 2023 season
- Oversaw a franchise record 15-game winning streak in 2021 (7/9-7/25); tied for longest in MiLB that season
- Oversaw a franchise record 200 home runs in 2019; team won 29 of final 40 games and were in contention for division until 2nd to last day of the season
- Spent 2018 as third base coach for the Durham Bulls (Rays' Triple-A)
- Spent 2014-2017 as a scout in the Arizona Diamondbacks organization
- Coached at Millenium HS in Goodyear, AZ from 2011-2013
- Previously managed Arizona Centennials in the Independent League in 2012

PLAYING CAREER

- Drafted by the Cardinals in the 4th Rd. of 1999 Draft; traded to Padres in 2000
- Made MLB debut on June 26, 2005 with the Padres; played 98 games over next three seasons with the Padres and Mets
- Named Padres Minor League Player of the Year in 2005 when he hit a career-high .312 with 25 home runs and 83 RBIs as a member of the Portland Beavers
- Played 901 MiLB games over 10 seasons with Cardinals, Padres, Mets and Tigers; hit .262 with 115 career home runs and 473 RBIs

- Born in Memphis and played baseball at Germantown HS; named Memphis-area HS Player of the Year in 1999; lives with his dad during the season
- He and his wife, Elizabeth, have two children, Ethan and Ruby; reside in Phoenix, AZ

PITCHING COACH DARWIN MARRERO

- Marrero, 42, is beginning his 11th season in the Cardinals organization and first with Memphis.

COACHING CAREER

- Ten current members of the St. Louis Cardinals 40-man roster have come through Springfield since Marrero's tenure began in 2017. Marrero's career with St. Louis began as pitching coach for the Gulf Coast League Cardinals (Rookie) from 2013-14, followed by the same role with the State College Spikes (Class-A) from 2015-17.

PLAYING CAREER

- Marrero's playing career spanned seven seasons from 1998-2004 with the Montreal Expos organization, attaining his highest level at Double-A with the Harrisburg Senators in 2002 and 2004.

HITTING COACH HOWIE CLARK

- Clark is beginning his first season in the Cardinals organization and first with Memphis

COACHING CAREER

- In 2015, Clark was named the hitting coach of the Delmarva Shorebirds, the Class-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. In February 2017, Clark was named the assistant hitting coach for the Orioles. He was named hitting coach of the Charlotte Knights, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, for the 2020 season. [9] On December 1, 2020, Clark was named assistant hitting coach for the Chicago White Sox.

PLAYING CAREER

- Clark played parts of six seasons in MLB with the Baltimore Orioles, Minnesota Twins and Toronto Blue Jays from 2002 to 2008.
- Clark batted .262 with three home runs and 26 RBI in his career

TODAY'S START: Connor Thomas is slated to start game four of the series against the Charlotte Knights on Friday night at AutoZone Park. The outing will be the left-handed pitcher's seventh start off of the Injured List. Thomas was named the 2022 Arizona Fall League Pitcher of the Year.

LAST TIME OUT: Thomas allowed two runs on nine hits in his start last week at Norfolk. Both runs scored in his final inning of work.

BALL IN PLAY: Thomas embraces contact on the mound. Among qualified pitchers in the International League according to Fangraphs, the lefty ranked 4th with a 50.6% ground-ball rate in 2022 and has the highest BABIP against at .353 among qualified pitchers (MLB average was .291 in 2022).

AMONG THE LEADERS: Thomas ranked 7th lowest walks per 9 innings mark at 2.64 and is 6th fewest walks allowed (38) in 2022. His 2.05 ground ball to fly ball rate was third highest in the IL.

2021: Thomas had an outstanding campaign with the Redbirds last season, posting a 3.10 ERA that ranked second-best in Triple-A East among pitchers with 100 IPs. The left-hander made four starts in Double-A Springfield before he was promoted to Memphis in late May. In total, Thomas struck out 116 batters and walked just 33 in 122 innings pitched, which ranked second among Cardinals farm hands.

TO START OR TO RELIEVE?: Thomas started his professional career in a relief role, making 18 appearances out of the pen. After the pandemic year, Thomas started four games with Springfield and was promoted to Triple-A, where he initially bounced between the rotation and bullpen. The southpaw finally settled back into a starting role, where he posted a 3-3 record and a 2.75 ERA in 14 starts with Memphis. As a reliever in eight appearances, Thomas went 3-1 with a 4.10 ERA.

THEY SAID IT: On his style: "I'm absolutely a groundball pitcher. I think I was top-5 in the minors last year in groundball rate [60.5% GB rate ranked 2nd among 155 MiLBers w/ 100 IPs]. I really just go after them, throw it after them. My stuff moves enough..." On learning at each level: "... when I first got drafted, the M.O. from all of these guys was to throw strikes and be competitive with every pitch. I took that with me, and then AA, it was competing and making sure you weren't falling behind counts- trying to always be in plus counts, like 0-1, 0-2. And then AAA, it was OK, we're facing major league caliber hitters. How do we sequence, when do we throw each pitch, what not to throw in different counts. Really learning how to pitch and how to be a professional..." On what he is working on: "I would say two-seam command, in general. Last year I struggled when I would get tired, I would lose the feel for it..."

GET TO KNOW 'EM: Drafted by the Cardinals in the 5th round of the 2019 Draft out of Georgia Tech... Set school record with 1.55 BB/9 over his career and did not walk more than two batters in any of his 2019 starts... Made first college pitching appearance at Truist Park in Atlanta against Georgia.
