### LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox dropped a 5-3 decision Tuesday afternoon in Akron. Bowie allowed four hits, but three home runs to Akron. After being shutout for four innings, **Frederick Bencosme** led off the fifth with a solo home run to get the Baysox on the board. RBI singles from **Silas Ardoin** and **Dylan Beavers** in the eighth made it a two-run game, but Bowie would get no closer. **Nick Richmond** and **Houston Roth** combined for three scoreless innings out of the Baysox bullpen.

### EASTERN LEAGUE HONOR ROLL

Baysox players have claimed back-to-back Eastern League Player of the Week awards. Former C/1B **Samuel Basallo** took home the award this past week after a successful homestand against the Erie SeaWolves. The prior week, OF **Dylan Beavers** was named Player of the Week following Bowie's road trip in Altoona. Beavers and Basallo are the third pair of Eastern League teammates to win Player of the Week in consecutive weeks this season.

### THE FIRST (AND SECOND) NOEL

On Sunday, August 10, IF **Noelberth Romero** walked off both games of a doubleheader with the Harrisburg Senators. Romero hit a walk-off, two-run home run in game one before notching a walk-off, two-run double in game two. Romero became the first player across MLB or MiLB to hit multiple walk-offs on the same day since former Orioles' farmhand Andrew Daschbach walked off both legs of a doubleheader for High-A Aberdeen on August 12, 2021.

### ARMS RACE

In the month of August, the Bowie starting rotation has the best ERA in the Eastern League and third-lowest in Double-A at 2.83. Overall, Baysox pitching has posted a 3.05 staff ERA in August - the best of any month this season and third-best in the Eastern League. Bowie arms are tied atop Double-A with 1,171 strikeouts this season.

### BRADFIELD TO BOWIE

OF **Enrique Bradfield Jr.** has hit safely in eight of his first 12 Double-A games, while reaching safely in 11 of 12 games at the level. Sunday, Bradfield notched a career-high four hits for the first time as a professional. Bradfield's 65 stolen bases this season rank as second-most in all of Minor League Baseball. Bradfield has 16 games with multiple stolen bases this season.

### SECOND HALF SILAS

C **Silas Ardoin** is hitting .300 since the return from the All-Star Break (July 19) with a .422 on-base percentage - third-best among qualified Eastern League hitters. Ardoin notched his first home run since June 13 (25 GP) on Sunday. Defensively, Ardoin has been one of the best catchers in MiLB - his 62.3 SB% against him is best among Double-A backstops with at least 50 games behind the plate this season.

### ATTACKING IN AUGUST

After hitting only .207 in the month of July (tied for league-worst), Bowie has turned things around in August with the third-best batting average in the league at .251. The Baysox have scored 112 runs - third-most in the circuit, thanks to a league-best on-base percentage of .345. The Baysox have also stolen the most bases this month (39).

### DUCKS ON THE POND

The Akron RubberDucks lead the Baysox by 9 games for the Eastern League South-west division second half postseason spot. Akron took four of six from Bowie at Canal Park last month, and have won eight of 13 in the season series. Akron's roster currently includes five of the Guardians' Top 30 prospects (MLB.com), including 1B/OF C.J. Kayfus (No. 7), C Cooper Ingle (No. 15), LHP Parker Messick (No. 20), OF Petey Halpin (No. 28), IF Kahlil Watson (No. 30).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Tommy Mace gets the ball on Wednesday night for Akron. Mace is making his fifth career appearance and fourth start against the Baysox. He owns a 3.93 ERA against Bowie in 18.1 career IP. Mace has tossed the fifth most innings in the Eastern League this season (124 IP). Mace is coming off a start where he went five innings with just one, unearned run allowed last Thursday against Harrisburg. Mace was a Competitive Balance-B Round selection by Cleveland in 2021 out of Florida.

**2024:** Has thrown 6th-most innings (94.1) and has struck out 10th-most batters (107) in O's system this season. Has gone 4.2 IP in back-to-back starts. Owns a 4.86 ERA in second half. Recorded a 4.08 ERA in the first half. Looking to pitch five innings for first time since 4/26 @ RIC and still looking for first win of season. Owns a 3.97 ERA in 11 road starts. Baysox are 8-15 when Bright starts but have won last three in a row. Finished month of May with a 3.68 ERA over 22 IP. Finished month of April with a 2.41 ERA (9th lowest in EL) over 18.2 innings pitched with 23 strikeouts. Went five innings each in three straight starts from 4/14 - 4/26. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

**2023:** Began first full season in minors in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 IP. Led IronBirds in strikeouts. Finished 4th in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 10 batters in just 3.1 innings in 2023 season debut against Wilmington. Posted a 5.04 ERA in the first half but pitched better in second half of season, posting a 3.55 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 38 innings. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Went at least four innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.

**2022:** Debuted professionally with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27. Struck out three over three shutout innings in Delmarva debut against Lynchburg. Finished first professional season with a 1.86 ERA in 9.2 innings.

**College:** Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were fourth most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

**Personal:** Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with third round pick Nolan McLean. Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.
