History vs. Wisconsin

The Lugnuts are 91-64 all-time vs. the Timber Rattlers, 44-25 at home and 47-39 in the Fox Cities.

The Lugnuts went 5-1 at Neuroscience Group Field last year, 3-2 in 2023, and 4-2 in 2022, with zero meetings between the two clubs in 2024 and 2021. Wisconsin has not visited Lansing since 2019.

Tonight: It's the third of a six-game series between the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, and the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers, High-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. The two ballclubs have split the first two games, with Wisconsin triumphing Tuesday and Lansing striking back yesterday. These are the only meetings between the Nuts and T-Rats this season.

Last Night: Lugnuts 5, Timber Rattlers 3. Knuckleballer **Devin Kirby** blanked the T-Rats over five innings, **C.J. Pittaro** raced around the bases with an inside-the-park home run (for his first home run of the season!), and **Jake Reinisch** added a three-run homer (for his first roundtripper in affiliated ball) to help lift the Nuts to the Wednesday night win in front of 4,514 at Neuroscience Group Field at Fox Cities Stadium.

On the Air: **Chris Mehring** and **Jonathan Timm** deliver the call on Bally Live and MiLB TV, while **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** can be heard via milb.streamguys1.com/lansing.

On Deck: The Lugnuts play at the T-Rats through Sunday, next returning home for a six-game series from August 4-9 against Lake County.

Since We're in the Area: The Lugnuts toured Lambeau Field this morning.

Against the West: With yesterday's victory, the Nuts improved to 14-11 (and 5-9 on the road) against West Division teams this season: 4-1 vs. Cedar Rapids, 7-5 vs. Quad Cities, 2-4 at South Bend, and 1-1 at Wisconsin. Lansing's overall 41-54 record has been weighed down by a 4-13 record vs. West Michigan and 3-9 mark vs. Lake County.

Welcome Back, Jack: Appleton's own **Jack Mahoney** (Appleton West H.S.) is freshly back from the Injured List (July 1-25) right on time for a homecoming. Mahoney's most recent appearance came on June 30 vs. Dayton, allowing three unearned runs in 2/3 IP. The Wisconsin-Milwaukee product has a 4.50 ERA in 21 relief appearances this year, limiting lefties to a .200 average this year (2 walks, 11 strikeouts), while right-handers are batting .294 against him (12 walks, 10 strikeouts). Before Mahoney, the last Lugnuts player to hail from Appleton was 2015 catcher **Danny Jansen** (currently on the Rangers' 10-day Injured List).

July Trends: As the month draws to a close, the Lugnuts' offense in July tied for 11th in the league in batting average (.233), 12th in at-bats (694), 12th in runs scored (100), 12th in base hits (162), 12th in total bases (239), 12th in slugging percentage (.344) and 11th in OPS (.687). On the other hand, Nuts pitchers have posted a team ERA that ranks 2nd best in the league (4.72) while allowing the fewest runs (106 / 97 ER), to help Lansing post a 10-11 record.

Major League Opposition: With **DL Hall** pitching yesterday and **Kyle Harrison** starting today, the Lugnuts face their second and third MLB rehabbers of the year. The first was Reds third baseman **Ke'Bryan Hayes**, who went 1-for-6 in two games vs. Lansing pitching. Last season, **Brandon Woodruff** pitched against the Lugnuts on April 18, suffering the loss after allowing three runs on six hits and three walks in four innings, serving up doubles to **Rodney Green, Jr.** and **Tommy White**. Over a decade ago, the Nuts also faced a rehabbing Milwaukee Brewer; catcher **Jonathan Lucroy** went 1-for-6 with two RBIs, a walk and a steal in two games vs. Lansing on July 21-22, 2012.

Major League Lugnuts: Nine former Nuts have made their MLB debuts this season: **Daniel Susac** for the Giants, **Junior Perez** for the White Sox, **Eduardo Rivera** for the Red Sox, and **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**, **Kade Morris**, **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer**, **Tommy White** and **Yunior Tur** for the Athletics. Bolte, Jump and White join **Brady Basso**, **Hogan Harris**, **Luis Morales**, **Jack Perkins**, **Jacob Wilson**, **Lawrence Butler**, **Tyler Soderstrom** and **Colby Thomas** on the Athletics' current roster, meaning that former Lugnuts comprise 44% of the A's 25-man roster.

Induction Day: A member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** was inducted Sunday into Cooperstown alongside Jeff Kent and Andrew Jones. In his 11th game with the Lugnuts (batting .143, 6-for-42, with one walk and 11 strikeouts), Beltrán suffered a right knee in an outfield collision. He flew back to the Royals' complex in Florida and never returned to Lansing, making his MLB debut on September 14, 1998, against the Oakland Athletics. A year later, Carlos was voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, and was on his way to a 20-year MLB career with 2,725 hits, 565 doubles, 78 triples, 435 homers, 312 homers, nine All-Star appearances, three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and a 2017 World Series ring as a member of the Astros.

JULY 30 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2016: Carlos Belen hit a game-winning RBI triple in the bottom of the 15th, and the Fort Wayne TinCaps beat the Lugnuts in a Parkview Field marathon, 4-3. The game lasted four hours and 32 minutes. Before the game-winning blow, Lansing's bullpen had pitched nine scoreless innings in relief of Angel Perdomo, including five scoreless innings from Dan Lietz.

2017: The Lugnuts built a 7-0 lead, watched the Great Lakes Loons hit three straight solo homers (Saige Jenco, Jeren Kendall and Gavin Lux) in the fifth inning and then add a fourth solo home run (Nick Yarnall) in the eighth, before escaping with a 7-5 win at Cooley Law School Stadium on a wacky game-ending double play. With the tying runs at the corners in the ninth, Jared Carkuff struck out Cristian Santana on a pitch in the dirt – the second out immediately, since first base was occupied. But Santana took off for first base anyway, inadvertently kicking the ball away from catcher Javier Hernandez. Umpires Matt Cowan and Raul Moreno conferred and determined that Santana had committed interference, calling runner Cody Thomas out and giving Carkuff his third save of the year.
