LAST TIME OUT...

WORCESTER, Mass. (June 29, 2021) – The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders matched a franchise record with seven stolen bases and used a five-run ninth inning to defeat the Worcester Red Sox 9-0 on Tuesday night at Polar Park.

Worcester took a 1-0 lead in the bottom of the first on a leadoff home run from Jarren Duran. Luis Gil settled in after that, retiring nine of the next 10 batters he faced. The right-hander allowed another solo home run in his outing, in the fourth to Jeter Downs, but was otherwise stellar. In 5.0 innings Gil (1-0) allowed just two runs on five hits, striking out six and not walking a batter.

The RailRiders broke through against Tanner Houck in the top of the fourth, when Estevan Florial singled, stole second and later came home to score on a throwing error. Four batters later, Kyle Holder was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded to plate another run and give the RailRiders a 2-1 lead. After the Downs homer tied the game, the RailRiders took the lead in the top of the fifth when Andrew Velazquez singled and stole second, third and home in succession. He became the documented player in baseball to swipe second, third and home in the same inning since Jon Berti of the Miami Marlins on August 24, 2020.

Velazquez's steal of home was part of a delayed double steal with Florial, who swiped second on the front end. The next batter, Ryan LaMarre, tripled to right to score Florial to extend the RailRiders lead to 4-2. The WooSox got closer in the bottom of the sixth with a run off Greg Weissert on an RBI double from Johan Mieses, but Nick Goody was able to escape the jam and keep the Red Sox off the board in 2.1 innings of work.

In the top of the ninth the RailRiders blew the game open and sent 10 batters to the plate. Rob Brantly cracked a two-run home run to extend the lead and spark a five-run inning. Velazquez doubled and scored on a Hoy Park single, and Socrates Brito brought in two more with a base hit to extend the lead to 9-3. Sal Romano allowed four unearned runs in the bottom of the ninth, but shut the door to secure the win.

THEY'RE THE BEST, AROUND: With a 33-13 (.717) start to the season, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre begins play Wednesday night with the best record in baseball. The club set the RailRiders era (2013 - Present) record for best start through 40 games (29-11), shattering the previous best of 23-17 in 2017 and has already set a new mark for best 50-game start to the season. The RailRiders are on pace for an 86-34 season, and roughly projects to a 100-40 season in a normal 140-game schedule. The RailRiders finished a franchise best 91-52 (.636) in 2016, when SWB captured its first and only Triple-A National Championship. SWB's .707 winning percentage is the best of any team in the majors or minors, with San Jose (34-15, .694) ranking second.

ONE FOR THE RECORD BOOKS: In Tuesday's 9-7 win over Worcester, the RailRiders tied a franchise record by stealing seven bases in the game. It tied a mark set by the SWB Yankees on June 6, 2008 against the Norfolk Tides. **Andrew Velazquez** accomplished the rare feat of stealing three bases in one inning, while **Estevan Florial** (2), **Hoy Park** and **Ryan LaMarre** (1 each) all stole bags against the Red Sox. In the 2008 contest against Norfolk, Bernie Castro, Brett Gardner and Cody Ransom all stole two bases, while Alberto Gonzalez swiped one.

WOO HOO: This week the RailRiders start their first series of the season against the Worcester Red Sox, kicking off a season series comprised of 24 games in a span of 54 days. SWB travels to Polar Park for 18 contests, with the WooSox heading to PNC Field only once. Worcester is tied with Syracuse for the second-most frequent opponent of the RailRiders this season after the club's 36 games with Lehigh Valley.

HERE'S THE DIETZ: When play began on June 6, SWB infielder **Derek Dietrich** was hitting only .119/.316/.237, and had endured an 0-for-27 skid to end the month of May. However, beginning with a 1-for-2 performance against Lehigh Valley that night, Dietrich has been on a tear at the plate in his last 16 games, batting .340/.539/.596 (16-for-47) with 11 R, 3 2B, 3 HR, and 16 RBIs. The run of success at the bat has improved his season batting line to .217/.415/.396, a 259-point leap in OPS. Dietrich ranks 4th among qualified Triple-A East hitters in OBP.

ALL ABOARD THE TREY TRAIN: RailRiders outfielder **Trey Amburgey** made RailRiders history Thursday night, reaching base safely three times to extend his on-base streak to 33 games. In doing so, he passed **Brandon Drury**, who had a 32-game on-base streak in the 2018 season for the longest such streak in the RailRiders era (2013 - Present). Here is a look inside the numbers during Trey's incredible run:

- The streak began on August 26, 2019, when Amburgey went 1-for-3 with a HBP at the Pawtucket Red Sox.
- He has hit .353/.429/.632 during the now 36-game streak, with 29 R, 14 2B, 1 3B, 7 HR, 39 RBI, 15 BB, 37 K and 5 HBP.
- The streak has included 10 multi-hit games and 12 multi-RBI games.
- During the streak, Amburgey has only gone hitless three times (8/31/19 vs BUF, 6/15/21 vs SYR, 6/29 @ WOR). In those games he has reached base on a walk and was hit by three pitches. He also has two RBIs in those hitless contests.
- Amburgey had a 20-game hitting streak from 9/11/19 to 6/13/21 as part of the longer on-base streak, snapped on 6/15 vs Syracuse. He then hit in eight straight games, and has a hit in 28 of his last 30 games played.

OTHER STREAKS OF NOTE: In addition to Trey Amburgey's impressive stretch, the RailRiders offense features two other players with double-digit on-base streaks. Outfielder **Greg Allen** is riding a season-long 21-game on-base streak into play on Saturday night, and infielder **Hoy Park** has reached base safely in 24 consecutive games. Park sports a .508 OBP during his streak, which has propelled him to the Triple-A East lead in OBP (.493) and OPS (1.105), second in the league in AVG (.353), and third in SLG (.612). The infielder also ranks second in Triple-A East in walks (30) behind Worcester's Marcus Wilson (31).

OH WHAT A RELIEF IT IS! Since **Kyle Barraclough** relieved **Albert Abreu** in the sixth inning of the RailRiders game at Buffalo on Friday, June 11, the SWB bullpen has performed at an amazing clip. In the last 19 days, the bullpen has combined for a 1.67 ERA (16 ER/80.2 IP), while allowing just 53 hits, 24 walks and recording 95 strikeouts. The current stretch has lowered SWB's bullpen ERA to 2.85 on the season, the fourth-best in all of minor league baseball, and best in Triple-A. RailRiders closer **Luis Garcia** is tied for the minor league lead with 11 saves on the season, and is one of only four pitchers with double-digit saves this year.

WHILE THE GITTENS GOOD: INF **Chris Gittens** put up an historic performance for the RailRiders in Sunday's 19-1 win over the Lehigh Valley IronPigs. Gittens finished the game 4-for-7 with four runs scored, a double, two home runs and eight RBIs. He hit two homers in the third inning, including the first grand slam of the season for SWB. He became just the fourth Scranton/Wilkes-Barre Player to ever have an eight RBI game, and the first-ever in the Yankees affiliation (2007 - Present).

LAST TIME OUT: Nelson continued what has been a strong run since being moved to the starting rotation in his last outing, allowing two runs on three hits in 5.0 innings and picking up the win at Lehigh Valley on Friday, June 25. The 5.0 innings made that start the right-hander's longest appearance since 8/31/2019, when he lasted 5.0 innings against Buffalo. He struck out only three in the outing, and while his strikeout rate as a starter (6.92 K/9) is down compared to as a reliever (14.11 K/9), Nelson has been just as effective.

- Full name is Nicholas B. Nelson.
- Played two seasons (2015-16) at Gulf Coast State College (Fla.), where he went 13-5 with a 4.16 ERA (114.2 IP, 108 H, 64R/53ER, 49 BB, 121 K) in 22 games (21 starts).
- Had committed to play at the University of Florida to be a two-way player (1B and RHP) before signing with the Yankees, would have joined a staff that included RHP Alex Faedo (18th overall, 2017 DET) and RHP Brady Singer (18th overall, 2018 KC).
- Graduated from Rutherford H.S. (Fla.) in 2014.
- Was selected by the Giants in the 31st round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign.
- Is the oldest of four, two brothers and one sister, and the father of a baby girl with his girlfriend, who he met while playing for Tampa Tarpons in 2018, in late-August.
