TIME TO RECAP

Round Rock earned an 8-6 victory over Las Vegas on Saturday night, 3B Andy Ibáñez brought home the first run of the night in the first frame on a RBI single. In the home-half, Las Vegas tied the score at one. DH Dermis Garcia hit a sacrifice fly after LF Luis Barrera walked and CF Christian Pache doubled. In the third, after a leadoff double for CF Ezequiel Duran, LF Josh Sale drilled a two-run bomb and Round Rock led 3-1. Thompson hit a solo shot in the fourth for the Express, but 3B Matt Davidson responded with a solo home run in the home-half and the Aviators cut the lead to 4-2. 1B Elier Hernandez smoked a solo dinger in the fifth inning and the Round Rock lead increased to 5-2. Las Vegas responded with two runs on two hits in the home-half. Pache doubled to score one run. He then scored on a Garcia single. C Shea Langeliers tied the score at five in the seventh inning on a solo blast. In the eighth, 2B Nash Knight and Thompson singled before Duran reached on a fielding error that allowed both runners to score. With the Express leading 7-5 heading to the ninth, Hernandez scored from third base on a wild pitch and Round Rock led 8-5. Barrera hit a solo homer in the ninth, but the E-Train held on for an 8-6 win.

RAGANS ON THE RUBBER

Express LHP Cole Ragans will make his fourth start on Sunday. The lefty has made three starts for the E-Train and holds a 1.59 ERA (3.0 ER/17.0 IP). He has struck out 19 and walked only three. Ragans was promoted to Round Rock on June 14.

BUBBA PROVIDES THE POWER

RF Bubba Thompson hit his second home run in as many games on Saturday and finished 3-for-4 with three runs scored, a RBI and a walk. Thompson has hit four of his nine home runs this year in his last 11 games. Despite hitting only .211 in June (19-90), the righty is riding a five-game hitting streak and is 6-for-8 in his last two games.

HERE COMES HERNANDEZ

1B Elier Hernandez posted his third consecutive multi-hit game on Saturday and his 16th multihit contest of the year following his 2-for-4 night which included a home run, two runs scored and one RBI. Hernandez is 7-for-12 in his last three games with three doubles and a home run

HEARN MAKES IT THROUGH FIVE

LHP Taylor Hearn allowed four earned runs on Saturday but made it through 5.0 innings. E-Train starters have tossed at least 5.0 innings in each of the last four games and have an ERA of 2.66 (7 ER/23.2 IP). RHP Cole Winn started the stretch with 6.2 innings on Wednesday, followed by 7.0 innings from RHP Spencer Howard on Thursday. LHP Kolby Allard went 5.0 frames on Friday.

YERRY BRINGS THE HEAT

RHP Yerry Rodriguez became the first Round Rock pitcher to record a pitch over 100.0 mph (100.1). It was fouled off by Aviators SS Kevin Smith in the eighth inning. Rodriguez did not allow a run in his 1.1-inning performance from the bullpen. The righthander has not allowed an earned run since June 11 at Tacoma. He brought his scoreless inning streak to 9.0 innings on Saturday. Rodriguez has collected 18 strikeouts in his last 9.1 innings on the hill. He had an ERA of 1.54 (2 ER/11.2 IP) in the month of June.

LET'S GO STREAKING

Round Rock won their fourth consecutive game on Saturday. During this stretch, the Express have averaged 6.5 runs per game and the pitchers have an ERA of 2.25 (9 ER/36.0 IP). Yesterday's win also marked the sixth series win for the E-Train this season and their first since they took two of three games against El Paso from May 20-22.

RHP Daniel Robert, INF Josh Smith and OF Bubba Thompson all made their Triple-A debuts on Opening Day - April 5, 2022 while RHP Hever Bueno made his on April 6.

STATING THE FACTS

EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.



Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
