LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn was toppled by Jersey Shore, 11-5, on Saturday night in Lakewood...The Cyclones had to play come-from-behind all night, as the BlueClaws hopped out to a 5-0 after one inning, which quickly turned into an 8-0 affair after two, and a 10-0 contest after three...Still, the Clones battled to the very end, scoring five runs over the final four frames of the contest, which proved to be too little, too late...LF **Chris Suero** drove in a pair, while DH **Jeffrey De Los Santos** notched a multi-hit performance on a two-for-four night with a double...RHP **Josh Hejka** gave Brooklyn 3.1 scoreless frames out of the bullpen...For Jersey Shore, 1B **Leandro Pineda** enjoyed a four-hit, four-RBI game.

DOWN THE STRETCH THEY COME: Including Sunday, 16 games remain in the First Half of the South Atlantic League season...The Cyclones are currently in sole possession of third in the North Division...Brooklyn is three games back of first-place Greensboro...The Grasshoppers hold the lead in the division even though they will not play an in-division opponent until the BlueClaws travel to North Carolina next week...So far, Greensboro has played just six games against teams with a record of .500 or better, holding a 2-4 mark.

MARVELOUS MORABITO: OF **Nick Morabito** has been as good as any offensive player in Minor League Baseball in 2024...The 21-year-old tied a career-high with four hits and matched a season-best with three runs batted in during Tuesday's series opener at Jersey Shore, and followed it up with a home run to lead off the ballgame on Wednesday...Morabito is the first Cyclone to accrue a four-hit night since 3B **Jacob Reimer** went 4-for-5 on August 17, 2023, vs. Hudson Valley...The feat occurred six times for the Cyclones in 2023, including 2B **Chase Estep's** 4-for-6 day on June 4 at Jersey Shore...Morabito is the first Cyclone to register 4+ hits, 3+ RBI and at least one home run in a single game 3B **William Lugo** was 4-for-6 with four runs scored, four RBI, and a three-run homer on August 28, 2022, at Jersey Shore...The last three Brooklyn players to achieve that line in one game have accomplished it at ShoreTown Ballpark...OF **Alex Ramirez** (4x5, 1 HR, 6 RBI) did it, as well, on July 22, 2022...Morabito is fifth in Minor League Baseball in on-base percentage (.469)...He is also tied for seventh in batting average (.350) and tied for 10th in stolen bases (24)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 7, the former second-round pick is tied for the league lead in steals (13)...Morabito is also tied for fourth in runs scored (18).

CROWN HIM!: In Wednesday's win over Jersey Shore, OF **Stanley Consuegra's** RBI double in the fourth inning made him the new Cyclones all-time hits leader (169), breaking a tie with OF **Alex Ramirez**...The 23-year-old is atop the Cyclones' ranks in numerous other offensive categories as well, including extra-base hits (75), home runs (33), and RBI (109)...He is also one double (37) from matching Ramirez's franchise mark (38)...On the final day of the 2023 regular season, he broke a tie with C **Francisco Alvarez** for Brooklyn's single-season home run record (23)...Consuegra also surpassed Alvarez (22) for the franchise record in career home runs on August 23 at Asheville...The Dominican native also broke the franchise's single-season record for extra-base hits (42) and tied the mark for RBI (63) set by **Ronny Mauricio** in 2021.

SUPER STANLEY: Not only did OF **Stanley Consuegra** set the franchise hit record on Wednesday afternoon, the 23-year-old is in the midst of his best offensive stretch of the season...The 23-year-old launched his fifth home run in his last 11 games in Friday's loss to Jersey Shore...Consuegra is on a five-game hitting streak, and has a hit in 12 of his last 13 games since May 17 at Bowling Green. During that time, he's hitting .317/.426/.756 with a 1.182 OPS during that time...The Dominican native has scored 11 runs and added five doubles, five home runs, and 10 RBI...Consuegra has raised his batting average by 42 points (.171 to .213) and his OPS by 200 points (.519 to .719) during the stretch.

BUZZIN' ON THE BOARDWALK: INF **Wilfredo Lara** and C **Chris Suero** are heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...In his last 12 games since May 19, Lara is hitting .293/.383/.439 with an .822 OPS, adding a double, a triple, a home run, and six RBI...Suero enters Sunday on a 10-game on-base streak since May 17...The 20-year-old has posted a .303/.439/.394 line with an .833 OPS, adding 10 runs scored, a home run, five RBI and seven walks.

LARRUPIN' LORUSSO: INF **Nick Lorusso** has quietly been one of the top hitters in the South Atlantic League in 2024...The 23-year-old launched his team leading seventh home run in Wednesday's victory over Jersey Shore...Amongst South Atlantic League batters, Lorusso tied for third in triples (3), seventh in slugging (.507), eighth in RBI (27), ninth in OPS (.865) and extra-base hits (19), and tied for ninth in total bases (77)...The Connecticut native saw his season high 11-game hitting streak come to an end in Friday's loss...During the streak the ninth-round selection slashed .318/.423/.659/1.082...In that time, Lorusso has added a double, a triple, four home runs, and eight RBI...The 11-game hit streak was the longest for a Cyclone in 2024 and the best since INF **Jett Williams** hit in 12-straight contests from August 12-25, 2023.

START ME UP: The Cyclones' starting rotation has been one of the best in Minor League Baseball in 2024...Brooklyn holds the best ERA for starting pitchers in the South Atlantic League at 2.95...The Cyclones have the only starting staff with a sub-3.00 ERA in the circuit and hold a mark 0.49 runs

vs. JERSEY SHORE: Brooklyn will play their first full six-game road series of 2024 against the Phillies' High-A affiliate...Jersey Shore possess five of Philadelphia's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: OF **Justin Crawford** (4), INF **William Bergolla** (11), OF **Emaarion Boyd** (16), OF **Hendry Mendez** (22), and LHP **Sam Aldegheri** (23)...Last season, the BlueClaws won the season series against the Cyclones, 15-11, including a 11-6 record at ShoreTown Ballpark...The two sides split the first series at Jersey Shore from April 16-21...Brooklyn leads the all-time series since 2021, 51-43 (.543).

better than the next team (Aberdeen; 3.44)...That ERA is also third at the High-A level and seventh among full-season MiLB squads...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro holds the best mark in the minors and the level (2.28).

HOME COOKING: The Cyclones enter play on Saturday with a 16-8 record at Maimonides Park, but a 10-16 record in opposing ballparks...So far in 2024, Brooklyn is a perfect 4-0 in home series...The Clones haven't lost a home series since Hudson Valley took four of six from August 15-20, 2023...Brooklyn holds the sixth-best home ERA (2.62) in Minor League Baseball...Arizona's High-A Hillsboro (2.27) has the lowest mark at the High-A level, while Texas' Single-A Down East leads MiLB (2.01)...In visiting parks, the Cyclones' ERA is 5.00.

FELIP-IN' AMAZIN': LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** put together his best start in a Cyclones uniform on Saturday night against Hudson Valley...The 23-year-old celebrates his birthday after having shut out the Renegades for 6.0 innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts - one shy of the single game Brooklyn franchise record of 14 set by LHP **Mike Cox** (8/25/01 vs. HV) and RHP **Brad Hoyt** (7/24/08 vs. VER)...De La Cruz was the first Cyclone to strike out 13+ hitters in a single contest since RHP **Rob Gsellman** accomplished the feat on August 24, 2013, at Vermont...De La Cruz is the sixth Cyclones pitcher ever to hit the 13 punchout threshold and the third to strikeout 13 or more in 6.0 or fewer innings...De La Cruz enters play with the sixth lowest ERA in the South Atlantic League amongst qualifiers (2.68).

CLEAN SWEEP: Brooklyn dominated the weekly South Atlantic League Awards, taking home a pair of accolades thanks to two individual performances against Hudson Valley...LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** grabbed SAL Pitcher of the Week, while INF **Nick Lorusso** was named the SAL Player of the Week for the Week of May 21-26...De La Cruz, who just celebrated his 23rd birthday on Sunday, logged a career-high 13 strikeouts over six shut-out innings...He walked only one batter while surrendering only two hits...He is the first Brooklyn pitcher to receive the honor since RHP **Luis Moreno** on July 26-31, 2022...On the other hand, Lorusso logged multi-hit games in three of four games played in the series...The 23-year-old slashed a stellar .500/.588/1.286 with a whopping 1.874 OPS...He clobbered a triple and three home runs, two of which came last Thursday...Lorusso is the first Cyclone to win Player of the Week since OF **Stanley Consuegra** from April 10-16, 2023...The sweep of weekly league awards is the first for the Cyclones since moving to the full-season level in 2021...LHP **Gunnar Kines** and OF **José Miguel Medina** were the last to accomplish the feat, winning New York-Penn League Pitcher and Player of the Week, respectively, for July 10-16, 2017.

DOU NOT ENTER: Even after working just 2.2 innings in Friday's loss, RHP **Douglas Orellana** still finds himself towards the top of the South Atlantic League leaderboard in numerous pitching categories...Among arms with 36.0+ innings of work, Orellana is third in the SAL in ERA (1.49)...Orellana's 1.49 ERA (6 ER in 36.1 IP) is the eighth-lowest in Minor League Baseball among pitchers with 36.0+ innings of work.

A THOUSAND VICTORIES: Brooklyn's 2-1 victory at Rome on May 11 marked the 1,000th in Cyclones' franchise history...Brooklyn has recorded a mark of 1,008-852 (.542) in 1,860 games since 2001...May 7's 6-2 victory in Rome marked the franchise's 200th since joining the South Atlantic League in 2021...The Cyclones are 210-221 (.487) in 431 games...Brooklyn captured its 900th franchise victory with a 6-5 triumph over Wilmington on August 14, 2022...Brooklyn's first win came in a 3-2 victory on June 19, 2001, at Jamestown.

ATOP THE HEJ-ES: RHP **Josh Hejka** earned his first save of the season on May 5 vs. Aberdeen, making his Cyclones' franchise-record-setting 48th pitching appearance in the process...The 27-year-old broke a tie with **Hunter Parsons** (47) for the most pitching appearances in Cyclones franchise history...In his 56 career outings for Brooklyn since 2019, Hejka has accumulated a 5-1 record with a 2.46 ERA (25 ER in 91.1 IP) and 5 saves, walking just 22 and striking out 79.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The Clones have three of the Top 30 per BA: **Kade Morris** (21), **Jonah Tong** (22) and **Calvin Ziegler** (29)...Ziegler is currently on the full-season injured list...Plus four of the Top 30 per MiLB: Tong (20), Ziegler (23), **Wilfredo Lara** (24), and OF **Nick Morabito** (26).

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision on Tuesday night at Jersey Shore...Yielded two runs (one earned) on three hits over 5.0 innings...Walked three and struck out two...Tossed a career-high 94 pitches and 61 strikes (64.89%)...Relieved by RHP **Victor Castañeda** to start the bottom of the sixth inning with the Cyclones trailing, 2-1...Brooklyn tied the game at three in the seventh, but the BlueClaws ultimately won with a final score of 5-4.

PROSPECT RADAR: Morris is considered the New York Mets' No. 21 prospect in 2024 according to *Baseball America*...He is the highest-rated prospect on the Cyclones' roster per the publication.

2024: Joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on May 20...Made seven appearances (six starts) in the Florida State League...Posted an 0-3 record with a 3.63 ERA (14 ER in 34.2 IP), 11 walks, and 38 strikeouts...Struck out a career-high nine over five innings in a loss at Bradenton on May 9...Tallied a career-best 7.0-shut-out innings of work in his final start on May 15 at Palm Beach...Punched out 27 (28.13 K%) and walked five (5.21 BB%) in his final 22.0 innings in the circuit.

KADE YOU DIG IT: At the time of his departure, Morris ranked among the Florida State League leaders in several categories...The 21-year-old ranked sixth in the circuit in innings pitched (34.2) and ninth in ERA (3.63)...Morris also was seventh in strikeouts-per-nine innings (9.87) and ninth in walk rate (7.4%).

2023: Signed with the Mets as a third-round selection on July 15 for \$666,500...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 17...Made one start on August 17 at the FCL Marlins...Allowed one unearned run on one hit in 1.0 inning...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on September 6...Made one start on September 7 vs. Daytona...Permitted one run on one hit over 2.1 innings...Walked two and struck out three...Returned to the FCL on September 8.
