TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field! The Quakes continue this series with game three of a six-game home stand tonight against the San Jose Giants (SFG). Tonight is Thirsty Thursday, with drink specials throughout the night including \$3 Pepsi products and 16-ounce domestic drafts for just \$5, all thanks to Tam's Burgers. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE GIANTS: Today's game is the ninth of 18 games against the Giants and the ninth of 12 here at home. Last night's loss drops the Quakes to 4-4 against the Giants in 2025, after winning four of six in a mid-April series here at home. Rancho was 7-5 against the Giants in 2024, 4-2 here at LoanMart Field.

LAST GAME: A five-run ninth broke a tie and gave the San Jose Giants the lead for good on Wednesday night at LoanMart Field, as the Quakes dropped an 8-3 decision. A two-out bases-loaded walk by Ryan Brown (1-1) triggered the five-run outburst in the ninth, as the Giants followed with back-to-back, two-RBI hits off Cody Morse. Samuel Munoz had three hits, including a two-run double that tied the game in the sixth, while Elijah Hainline had an RBI hit in the seventh that gave the Quakes a temporary lead against eventual winner Charlie McDaniel (5-2). Rancho reliever Shawn Oduber was brilliant out of the pen, going a season-high 3.1 scoreless. The loss matches Rancho's longest losing streak of 2025, as they've now lost three in a row on two different occasions.

CLEAN SWEEP OF MONTHLY AWARDS: The Quakes have continued their dominance of California League awards in 2025, as earlier today, a pair of Quakes were honored. OF Eduardo Quintero was named the Player of the Month, while RHP Christian Zazueta was named Pitcher of the Month. Quintero's May was outstanding, as he batted .391 and led all of minor league baseball in hits (43). He led the league in doubles (10), triples (4), RBIs (28), stolen bases (15), slugging (.718) and OPS (1.195). Zazueta went 3-0 with a 1.80 ERA in six starts. His 31 strikeouts over 30 innings led the league. Sean Paul Linan was named April's Cal League Pitcher of the Month, before heading to High-A. **HOW TO WRAP IT UP:** Last night's loss, a third straight for Rancho, means there are only 13 left to play in the first half, with the Quakes having a seven-game lead over Lake Elsinore and eight over Visalia. In theory, the Quakes could clinch as soon as Sunday afternoon, but that would require four straight losses for Lake Elsinore, three losses in four games for Visalia and four straight Rancho wins over San Jose. After this series, the Quakes will head to last-place Inland Empire for six, before finishing the half at home with three against second-place Lake Elsinore. This week, the Storm are in Modesto, while the Rawhide are home against Inland Empire. Next week, the Visalia Rawhide travel to Lake Elsinore for six. Meanwhile, there's real drama up north, as San Jose now has a one-game lead on Modesto.

LOGAN TABELING: 23-year-old right-hander Logan Tabeling makes his 12th overall appearance this year and third start, his third outing and first start against San Jose. In two games against the Giants, he's worked four scoreless, hitless innings, striking out six. In his last outing overall, he allowed two runs on two hits over 4.1 innings of relief in a win at Modesto on May 29th. The undrafted free agent out of Illinois signed with the Dodgers in July of 2024.

JACOB BRESNAHAN: 19-year-old lefty Jacob Bresnahan makes his tenth start of the year and his second against the Quakes. In his lone start against Rancho, he allowed three runs on five hits over three innings in a loss on April 19th. In his last start overall, he allowed two runs on three hits over four innings in a no-decision against Inland Empire on May 29th. Bresnahan was originally drafted by Cleveland in the 13th round of the 2023 draft out of Sumner High School, in Sumner, WA. He was traded to San Francisco in July of 2024 for pitcher Alex Cobb.
