WINNING STREAK ENDS WITH 3-2 DEFEAT

Joe Mack hit a home run but the Jumbo Shrimp's seven-game winning streak came to an end with a 3-2 loss in Tuesday's series opener at the Bulls. The game was scoreless until the bottom of the fourth, when Eloy Jiménez and Coco Montes notched RBI singles. Montes went yard in the sixth to make it 3-0. Jacksonville was kept off the scoreboard until Mack's two-run shot in the ninth, but the next three hitters struck out to end the game. Thus, the Jumbo Shrimp had their seven-game winning streak - their second-longest thus far in 2025 - halted.

APRIL COME SHE WILL

With a 21-7 (.750) record, the Jumbo Shrimp already possess the most wins of any team in Minor League Baseball. With just one game left to play in April, the 21 wins Jacksonville has accumulated through March and April are the most in recorded club history (2005-present) over the months of March and April. In the month of April alone, Jacksonville has already recorded 19 victories, their most in any month since a 20-win August during the 2017 season.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

Tuesday's 3-2 Jacksonville loss at Durham was the 17th time in the last 19 games that the Jumbo Shrimp played a contest decided by three runs or fewer. Jacksonville is a remarkable 13-4 (.765) in these closely-decided affairs during this stretch. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp are 15-5 (.750) in games decided by no more than three runs, including a 10-2 (.833) mark in one-run games. Those 10 one-run victories are by far the most in the minors; only one (Oklahoma City) of the other 119 MiLB teams has even eight wins by exactly one run.

MEN OF STEAL

After failing to steal a base in the 2025 season opener, Jacksonville has recorded multiple stolen bases in 17 of their last 27 games. In fact, the Jumbo Shrimp have five games with at least five stolen bases, including a club record (2005-present) seven steals in game two of a doubleheader on April 12 vs. Charlotte; Jacksonville notched five stolen bases in a game just twice over the 2022-24 seasons combined. The Jumbo Shrimp currently rank tied for second in the minor leagues and first Triple-A with 73 stolen bases.

'PEN PALS

Jacksonville starting pitchers have gone at least 5.0 innings just 13 times in 28 games thus far this season. The club's bullpen, however, has responded to the added responsibility in a huge way. Jumbo Shrimp relief pitching has combined for a 2.50 ERA (second-place Memphis at 3.30 is closer to 11th place than to Jacksonville) and .187 BAA, the best marks in Triple-A. The club's bullpen also ranks tied for fourth in the level in fewest hits allowed (90) and tied for fifth in strikeouts (144). Jumbo Shrimp relievers have combined to toss 133.1 innings through 28 games (4.8 per game), fifth-most in Triple-A.

BE STILL, MY BEATING START

Jacksonville starting pitchers have tossed just 112.1 innings thus far through the season's first 28 games, a rate of just 4.0 per contest. Those innings, however, have been extraordinarily effective; Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have posted the best ERA in Triple-A at 2.80 and issued just 27 walks, the fewest in the level. The club's starters also rank fifth in both fewest hits allowed (92) and BAA (.226). Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded three runs or fewer in 12 consecutive games and in 26 of their 28 contests this season.

HOME IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp are an extraordinary 16-2 at home this season, outscoring their opponents by a nearly 2:1 margin at 83-46 at VyStar Ballpark. Of the other 119 teams in Minor League Baseball, only seven have double-digit wins at home, with none above 11 home triumphs. The road, however, for Jacksonville has been a different story. The Jumbo Shrimp are 5-5 on the road, outscoring their opponents by a narrow 44-43 margin. Jacksonville has a team OPS of .767 and at home compared to .673 on the road. Their team ERA is 2.05 at home and 3.70 on the road.

SHRIMP BITES

Jakob Marsee leads the International League with 20 stolen bases. Second-place Jared Oliva of Nashville has 13 steals, meaning he is as close to Marsee in first place as he is to the eight players tied for 22nd place with six swipes... Marsee also ranks tied for third in walks (20). Maximo Acosta's 19 walks are sixth in the IL.

ABOUT FREDDY

-A two-way player at Riverview High School (Fla.), Tarnok went 7-0 with a 0.66 ERA while also batting .393. He was selected by the Braves in the third round, signing with Atlanta to bypass a commitment to the University of Tampa.

-Tarnok made his major league debut for the Braves on August 17, 2022, pitching 0.2 scoreless innings in a 9-7 loss to the New York Mets in Atlanta. His first big league strikeout came at the expense of Tyler Naquin.

-On December 12, 2022, the Oakland Athletics acquired Tarnok from the Braves in a three-team trade in which the Atlanta Braves received Sean Murphy, the Milwaukee Brewers acquired William Contreras, Joel Payamps, and Justin Yeager, and the Athletics also acquired Manny Piña, Kyle Muller, Esteury Ruiz, and Royber Salinas.

-The Philadelphia Phillies claimed Tarnok off waivers on June 1, 2024. Following the 2024 season, he signed a minor league contract with the Miami Marlins.

-In seven starts, Tarnok was 0-2 with a 3.65 ERA (12.1 IP, 13 H, 3 BB, 15 K, .283 BAA). However, over 16 relief appearances, he posted an 0-3 record and 9.78 ERA (19.1 IP, 21 H, 17 BB, 21 K, .280 BAA).

2023 SEASON

-Tarnok held left-handed batters to a .192/.276/.269/.545 line in 58 plate appearances compared to a .184/.333/.447/.780 line for right-handed hitters over 93 plate appearances.
