ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Vancouver Canadians dropped game four of their series with the Eugene Emeralds (Giants) Friday night, as the C's fell 10-5 at Ron Tonkin Field.

Vancouver jumped out to an early lead with runs in the first and second. Tanner Morris singled and went to second on an error before Spencer Horwitz brought him home with a base hit in the opening frame before Sebastian Espino led off the second with a solo home run that made it 2-0.

Right-hander Nick Frazee (L, 3-1) kept the Emeralds off the scoreboard until the fourth, when they played four runs on two hits. Only two of the four runs were earned, but when the dust settled it was 4-2 Eugene.

The Emeralds added two more in the fifth on a walk, a double, a sacrifice fly and a single before the Canadians made it a one-run game in the bottom of the sixth. In that frame, a missed catch error at first base started the rally before Ryan Gold was hit by a pitch. Up stepped Espino, who laced a two-RBI double to right-centerfield and went to third when the centerfielder bobbled the ball at the wall. He would score two batters later on a DJ Neal single to left field that brought the score to 6-5.

After a scoreless seventh and eighth, Eugene hung another four-spot in the ninth. They did so by sending all nine men to the plate and used three hits, three walks, an error and a passed ball to put the game away.

FEELING GREEN: The Eugene Emeralds, Advanced-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants, come to town this week for their first taste of the Canadians this season. This is the first of just two series between these two clubs in 2021; Vancouver will visit PK Park June 22-27 for the remaining six games of the 12-game season set. The C's went 3-4 against the Emeralds in 2019 when both clubs were their parent organization's Short-Season A affiliate.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

NIGHT-MARES: It's been a tale of two times of day for Vancouver this year. The C's are 4-0 in day games but 12-12 at night.

WHAT THE...: The Canadians have run themselves into five outs on two swings this series; the Emeralds turned a triple play on a fly out to centerfield on Wednesday before another can of corn to center turned into two outs last night.

RACK 'EM UP, RYAN: Sam Ryan established a new single-game high for strikeouts by a reliever this season when he K'd seven Emeralds across three innings.

ESPI KNOWS: Sebastian Espino was responsible for all five runs Vancouver scored last night. The Bonaio, DR native drove in three and scored twice.

CLARKE SPARK: After going hitless in eight consecutive games, Phil Clarke has notched a combined three knocks in his last two showings.

GO DJ: DJ Neal's RBI single last night raised his batting average with runners in scoring position to .357, a team high.

ON THE HILL: #9 Blue Jays prospect (MLB.com) Adam Kloffenstein returns to the mound tonight seeking a return to his early season form. "Kloff" began the year 1-0 with a 0.71 ERA, surrendered six hits and struck out 12 through his first 12.2 innings pitched, but he's been roughed up in each of his last two turns. In his previous outing on May 29, he failed to escape the second inning after allowing six runs on five hits with three walks and one strikeout against Everett. Before that, Hillsboro torched him for seven runs on six hits in three innings pitched. The right-hander is in the midst of his first season at Advanced-A; he made his pro debut with the Bluefield Blue Jays (RIP) in 2018 after Toronto took him in the third round (88th overall) of the 2018 draft out of Magnolia HS in his hometown of Magnolia, Texas. Kloffenstein, 20, starred for Vancouver in 2019 when he went 4-4 with a 2.24 ERA, 64 strikeouts and 23 walks in 64.1 innings across 13 starts. Northwest League batters hit .203 vs. him.

MLB.com's #5 Giants prospect Seth Corry gets the ball for Eugene. In his last outing on May 30 against Spokane, the southpaw gave up one unearned run on a single hit in 3.2 innings pitched. He walked five and struck out nine for the third consecutive start. Corry, 22, has racked up 38 Ks in 19 innings this year. Taken in the 3rd round (96th overall) of the 2017 draft out of Lone Peak HS in Highland, UT, Corry excelled in his first full pro season in 2019 when he went 9-3 with a 1.76 ERA, 172 strikeouts and 58 in 122.2 innings across 27 games (26 starts) for Low-A Augusta. He was a two-sport star (football, baseball) in high school and was Utah's best high school prospect in over a decade.
