SHUTOUT SATURDAY: The Omaha Storm Chasers picked up a third straight win on Saturday with a 5-0 victory over the Iowa Cubs. **RHP Scott Blewett** tossed 6.0 shutout innings, striking out six while allowing two hits and walking none. Blewett faced one batter more than the minimum and retired the final 10 batters he faced. **RHP Grant Gavin**, **RHP Jake Newberry**, and **LHP Gabe Speier** completed the shutout, with Speier recording the final four outs to extend his season-opening scoreless streak to 14.2 innings in 13 appearances. Between the third and eighth innings, Chasers pitching combined to retire 15 consecutive Iowa hitters. **OF Kyle Isbel** hit a solo home run in the third inning and the Chasers' offense added three runs in the eighth.

DYNAMITE LINEUP: Including Friday's 16-hit, five-homer effort, the Storm Chasers offense has recorded 12 games with 10 or more hits this season and 11 games with multiple home runs through the first 28 games of the season. Omaha currently ranks second in Triple-A East and first in the Midwest Division in average (.267), hits (251), and home runs (47). The Chasers also rank third in the league and first in the division in stolen bases (36) and OPS (.818). The Chasers have at least one home run in 16 of the last 17 games and a league-best 36 home runs in that span.

HOME COOKING: The Chasers are 10-1 through the first 11 games of the current 12-game homestand, and 14-3 overall at Werner Park this season. The Chasers average 5.5 runs/game in 17 games at Werner Park this season, batting .281/.351/.489 with 25 doubles and 29 home runs. In 11 road games, Omaha averages 5.4 runs/game, batting .247/.333/.450 with 18 doubles and 18 home runs. On the mound, the Chasers have a 3.24 team ERA at home and a 5.46 team ERA on the road.

BEST OF THE BEST: At 20-8 (.714), the Omaha Storm Chasers are tied for the fourth-best record in all of Minor League Baseball and are one of seven teams with at least 20 wins. The Bowie Baysox, the Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, currently have the best record in Minor League Baseball at 21-6 (.778). As an organization, the Kansas City Royals minor league affiliates have the third-best record in baseball at 69-43 record (.616), which includes Triple-A Omaha (20-8, 1st, AAA-E Midwest), Double-A Northwest Arkansas (13-14, 3rd, AA-C North), High-A Quad Cities (18-10, 1st, A+C West), and Low-A Columbia (18-11, 1st, A-E South).

FOR OMAHA: **LHP Jake Kalish** makes the Sunday start at Werner Park after pitching in relief in each of his last four appearances. Kalish's last start game on May 14 at Columbus, when he allowed three runs on four hits in 5.0 innings with four strikeouts and two walks. The left-hander has a 7.88 ERA in two starts (8.0 IP) and an 11.88 ERA in six relief appearances (8.1 IP). In three relief appearances against Iowa, Kalish has allowed six runs on seven hits—including two home runs—across 2.1 innings. Of the 19 total hits he has allowed, seven have been home runs. Kalish split time between the starting rotation and the bullpen in 2019 with Triple-A Omaha, finishing with a 5.16 ERA (24 games, 10 starts) in 118.2 innings with 89 strikeouts, 25 walks, and a career-high 26 home runs allowed.

FOR IOWA: **RHP Adrian Sampson** makes his third start (fifth appearance) of the season for Iowa and his second of the series. He started the series opener on Tuesday for the I-Cubs, allowing three runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings while striking out five and walking two in an eventual 5-3, walk-off win for Omaha. Sampson pitched in relief against Omaha on May 21, giving up five runs on six hits—including four ninth-inning home runs—in 2.2 innings.

DOPPLER RADAR: The Kansas City Royals recalled **OF Edward Olivares** on Sunday and optioned **RHP Tyler Zuber** to Triple-A Omaha... Zuber made his Major League debut in 2020 after pitching for High-A Wilmington and Double-A Northwest Arkansas in 2019 and will be making his Triple-A debut upon his first appearance... **INF Emmanuel Rivera** is 13-for-28 (.464) with three doubles, one triple, and two home runs across a six-game hitting streak that began on Sunday... **INF/OF Ryan O'Hearn** has homered in three of the last five games and reached safely in all seven games with Omaha, posting a slash line of .296/.387/.741... The Chasers' 2.91 team ERA since May 25 (the start of the homestand) is the third-best in Triple-A East and best in the Midwest Division in that span.
