LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones could not secure a series victory in Sunday's 5-4 loss at Wilmington in 10 innings...Brooklyn held a 4-2 lead in the bottom of the 9th, but the Blue Rocks tied the game on C Caleb Farmer's 2-run home run...Wilmington walked it off in the bottom of the 10th on SS Marcus Brown's game-winning single...3B Jefrey De Los Santos tallied a pair of hits and scored a pair of runs for Brooklyn...SS Marco Vargas added 3 hits and an RBI...CF Carson Benge reached base twice and drove in a run with a ground-rule double...Dl Jacob Reimer was ejected by HP Justin Hilton for arguing balls and strikes in the top of the 6th...Only 4 of 9 runs in the game were earned thanks to 5 combined errors...The walk-off loss was Brooklyn's 2nd of the year...C Will Bush delivered a game-ending single for Asheville in a suspended game against the Cyclones from May 8.

THE NUMBER ONE SPOT: The Cyclones are mired in a 3-team race for the South Atlantic League First Half North Division crown...Entering play on Tuesday, Brooklyn holds a 1.5-game lead on Greensboro for 1st place in the division...The Cyclones are 4.5 games up on 3rd-place Hudson Valley with 9 games remaining in the first half...Brooklyn's magic number to clinch the first half division crown is 8...Any Cyclones wins or Grasshoppers losses will decrease the number...Brooklyn does not play Hudson Valley or Greensboro for the remainder of the half... Greensboro has played one series (April 15-20 vs. Jersey Shore) against a North Division foe and will not play another until the second half (July 1-6 vs./at Aberdeen).

THE MANAEALATOR: LHP Sean Manaea joins the Cyclones on Tuesday for his 2nd Major League rehab start...The 33-year-old suffered the loss in his first outing with Brooklyn last Friday in Wilmington...He allowed 4 runs (3 earned) on 4 hits in 1.2 innings, striking out 2... Manaea has been on the New York Mets' injured list since March 27 with a right oblique strain... He was transferred to the 60-day IL on April 29...Manaea re-signed with the Mets on a 3-year, \$75 million deal on December 27, 2024...In 2024, the Indiana State alum posted a 12-6 record with a 3.47 ERA (70 ER in 181.2 IP), 63 walks, and 184 strikeouts...Manaea set career highs in innings (181.2) and tied career bests in wins (12) and starts (32)...He is the 3rd Major Leaguer rehabber for Brooklyn in 2025, joining RHP Paul Blackburn (4/19-5/2) and RHP Frankie Montas (5/24-29).

CAN'T TUCC THIS: LHP Jonathan Santucci has found his form in 2025...The 2024 Mets' 2nd-round selection is a perfect 3-0 over his last 4 outings (3 starts), including a career-high-tying 5.1 scoreless inning performance in a no-decision last Wednesday at Wilmington...Since May 16 vs. Winston-Salem, the 22-year-old has an 0.44 ERA (1 ER in 20.2 IP) with 11 hits allowed, 6 walks, and 22 strikeouts...Santucci has also thrown 14.1 consecutive scoreless innings dating back to the 2nd inning in game one of a doubleheader on May 23 at Jersey Shore...Since May 16, Santucci leads the South Atlantic League in ERA (0.44), is tied for 2nd in wins (3), 3rd in batting average against (.153) and WHIP (0.82), and 9th in innings pitched (20.2).

HOME COOKING: Brooklyn continued their dominance at Maimonides Park on June 1 with a 4-3 walk-off victory vs. Aberdeen...Sunday's triumph was the Cyclones' 13th-consecutive home win...Brooklyn's franchise record for consecutive home wins is 19, set in the inaugural 2001 campaign...Entering play on Tuesday, Brooklyn holds the best home record in the South Atlantic League at 22-5 (.815)...Greenville is second best (21-13)...The 22 home wins are the most at the High-A level and tied for the 4th most in Minor League Baseball...Miami's Triple-A Jacksonville is 1st (24)...Brooklyn's .815 home winning percentage is the best in MiLB...San Francisco's Single-A San José (.750) is 2nd.

GARCÍA LATER: RHP Saúl García has been exquisite in relief for the Cyclones in 2025...Entering Tuesday, the 21-year-old is tied with Bowling Green's RHP Jack Snyder for the South Atlantic League lead in saves (6)...Among SAL relievers with 15.0 or more innings of work, García paces the circuit in strikeouts-per-9-innings (16.80)...That total is 2nd-best at High-A (Toronto's High-A Vancouver RHP Nate Garkow, 17.28)...It is also the 6th-best in Minor League Baseball... Los Angeles-NL's High-A Great Lakes RHP Alex Makarewich (18.34) is 1st...He is also leads the SAL in batting average against (.085) and hits-per-9-innings (2.40), and is 9th in ERA (1.20).

**KEEP THE 'COASTER MOVING:** The Cyclones remained perfect in series through the first 57 games of the 2025 season with Saturday's win at Wilmington, ultimately earning a series split... Through Brooklyn's first 10 series of the year, the Cyclones hold a 7-0-3 record...In home series, Brooklyn is 4-0-1, splitting their first full 6-game set with Hudson Valley from April 8-13... The Cyclones have not lost a series since they dropped 5-of-6 at home vs. Jersey Shore from August 20-25, 2024...Since then, Brooklyn is 9-0-3 in a series of any length... Additionally, the Cyclones' 39-18 record is the franchise's best record through 57 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital Era (2005-present)...Brooklyn's 38-19 record in 2010 is the 2nd best.

REIMER SHINE: INF Jacob Reimer remains scorching hot to start the 2025 season...Entering play on Tuesday, Reimer is tied for 10th in Minor League Baseball in runs scored (47)...The former 4th-round pick also leads the South Atlantic League in runs scored (47), slugging percentage (.506), OPS (.968), and doubles (16)...Reimer also ranks 2nd in batting average (.308), tota bases (103), and hits (57), tied for 2nd in extra-base hits (27), tied for 4th in RBI (36), and 6th ir on-base percentage (.411)...Reimer was limited to just 35 games in 2024 with a hamstring injury

ALL BÁEZ ON ME: After recovering from knee surgery, INF Jesús Báez has slowly returned to form...Since the start of May, Báez leads the South Atlantic League in RBI (27), is 2nd in on-base percentage (.429), 3rd in batting average (.320), 4th in OPS (.924), tied for 5th in hits (33), tied for 7th in walks (19), and tied for 10th in runs scored (21)...The 20-year-old reached base safely in 17-of-23 plate appearances in the May 20-25 series against Jersey Shore and went 6-for-8 at the plate in May 23's doubleheader with 3 runs scored, a double, 2 home runs, and 7 RBI, en route to winning South Atlantic League Player of the Week honors...During the week, Báez hit .647 (11-17) with 6 runs scored, 2 home runs, and 10 RBI...The infielder led the circuit in batting average (.647), on-base percentage (.739), slugging percentage (1.059) OPS (1.798), and was tied for the league lead in RBI (10)...After OF A.J. Ewing won Player of the Week for May 13-18, it marked the first time Brooklyn hitters had won a league's Player of the Week award in consecutive weeks in franchise history...Báez also was recognized on Mil.B.com's "Prospect Team of the Week" for his efforts...On May 20, the infielder tied a Cyclones' single-game franchise record, working 4 walks at Jersey Shore...The feat has been accomplished 11 times, most recently by LF Ryan Clifford on April 21, 2024, at Jersey Shore.

BENGE IT LIKE CARSON: OF Carson Benge has been heating up at the plate over the last few weeks...The 2024 first-round pick enters Tuesday tied for the South Atlantic League lead in

vs. ASHEVILLE: After splitting a 6-game series in Wilmington, Brooklyn returns home for their final homestand of the season's first half...Asheville enters the series after splitting 6 games in at home against Winston-Salem... The Tourists are 13-15 on the road this season...Brooklyn and Asheville split a 6-game series at McCormick Field from May 6-11...The Tourists boast 8 of the Astros' Top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: C Walker Janek (3), RHP Anderson Brito (5), OF Joseph Sullivan (11), INF Chase Jaworsky (12), OF Kenni Gómez (16), RHP Juan Bello (21), RHP Bryce Mayer (26), and INF Alejandro Núñez (28)...In 23 meetings since 2021, the Cyclones lead the all-time series, 13-10 (.565)...Brooklyn is 4-2 (.475) against the Tourists in 6 games at Maimonides Park.

triples (4)...He is also 2nd in runs scored (43), tied for 2nd in doubles (14), 4th in extra-base hits (22), 5th in on-base percentage (.416) and OPS (.902), tied for 5th in walks (34) and hits (54), 6th in total bases (88), 7th in batting average (.298), and 9th in slugging percentage (.486)...The Yukon, Okla. native was recognized on Mil.B.com's "Prospect Team of the Weel" from May 20-25 after hitting .412 (7-17) with 8 runs scored, 3 doubles, 2 triples, an RBI, 8 walks to 3 strikeouts, 2 stolen bases, and 2 hit-by-pitches in 6 games at Jersey Shore from May 20-25.

EWING-ING IT: IF/OF A.J. Ewing has had a marvelous start to his 2025 season...Entering play on Tuesday, the Springboro, Ohio native is tied for the Minor League lead in triples (7)...He is also 3rd in stolen bases (41), and 5th in batting average (.347)...Since debuting with Brooklyn on April 29, Ewing leads the league in steals (27), is 2nd in hits (42), tied for 2nd in triples (3), 4th in batting average (.321), 5th in runs scored (24), and 8th in on-base percentage (.400)... Overall, Ewing is 2nd in the SAL in stolen bags (27)...The 2023 4th-round pick was recognized as the South Atlantic League Player of the Week for May 13-18 vs. Winston-Salem...In 5 games, the 20-year-old went 9-for-18 (.500) at the plate with 5 runs scored, 2 doubles, a triple, 3 RBI, 5 walks, and 6 stolen bases...Ewing led the SAL in steals (6) and on-base percentage (.609) for the week...He was the first Cyclone to receive a league weekly honor since INF Nick Lorusso and LHP Felipe De La Cruz took home Player and Pitcher of the Week, respectively, for May 20-26, 2024.

SWIPER KEEP SWIPING: Brooklyn is off to a historic start on the basepaths in 2025...The Cyclones' 7-6 win vs. Wilmington on April 29 saw them nab a franchise record 9 stolen bases, courtesy of 7 players...The mark topped a previous high of 8 on August 2, 2017, vs. Tri-City...Brooklyn enters play on Tuesday with 132 steals, good for the 2nd most in the South Atlantic League behind only Aberdeen (137)...The 132 steals are 9th in Minor League Baseball...Cleveland's Single-A Lynchburg leads Mil.B (161)...Brooklyn already has 5 players with 10-or-more steals on the season...The 132 swiped bags are the most by the Cyclones through the team's first 57 games in Minor League Baseball's Digital era (2005-present) by 50 swipes...The 2024 club is 2nd with 82 steals through 57 games...The Cyclones are 49 steals shy of breaking their single-season franchise record of 181 steals set in 2024.

NOAH'S ARC: After being limited to just 13.0 innings in his first professional season in 2024, RHP Noah Hall has found a new gear in 2025...The 24-year-old registered his 1st pro save on Thursday night at Wilmington, tossing 4.0 innings of 1-hit shutout ball...The save was Hall's first since April 30, 2021, vs. the University of Louisiana at Monroe, while pitching for Appalachian State University...Entering play on Tuesday, the Charlotte, N.C. native is 3rd in the South Atlantic League in ERA (2.42), tied for 4th in batting average against (.194), and tied for 8th in innings pitched (52.0).

IT'S A WALK-OFF: C Chris Suero provided Brooklyn's 2nd walk-off win in as many days in Sunday's 4-3 victory vs. Aberdeen...With 2nd and 3rd and 2 out, the 21-year-old reached on a run-scoring infield single, while a throwing error from 3B Anderson De Los Santos enabled the winning run to cross...On Saturday, C Ronald Hernandez helped Brooklyn complete another come-from-behind win, clobbering a walk-off solo home run with 1 out in the 9th in a 5-4 Cyclones win...The walk-off homer was Brooklyn's 1st since 3B Jefrey De Los Santos hit a game-tying 2-run blast and LF Omar De Los Santos smashed the game-ending solo shot on July 28, 2024, vs. Rome...Hernandez also delivered a walk-off winner with a run-producing fielder's choice in the bottom of the 10th on May 18 vs. Winston-Salem...2B Marco Vargas collected Brooklyn's 1st walk-off win of the year, slapping a game-ending RBI single in the bottom of the 10th on April 29 vs. Wilmington.

MAGIC 8 BALL: Brooklyn erupted for a season-high 8 runs in the 3rd inning in Tuesday's 12-3 win at Wilmington...The Cyclones scored 8 runs on 8 hits and sent 12 batters to the plate...The 8-run frame was Brooklyn's biggest offensive outburst this year...The previous high had been 6 runs on 3 occasions, most recently on May 14 vs. Winston-Salem in the bottom of the 4th...The 8-run inning was the 'Clones largest frame since scoring 9 runs in the bottom of the 2nd inning in an 11-7 win vs. Wilmington on July 27, 2023...Brooklyn scored 9 runs on 6 hits in that inning, sending 12 to the dish...It was the Cyclones' biggest offensive inning on the road since tallying 10 runs in the top of the 6th in a 20-6 rout on May 27, 2022, at Bowling Green.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On June 10, 2012, the original "Voice of the Cyclones," Warner Fusselle, passed away from a heart attack...In honor of Fusselle, his legendary "Catbird Seat" was left vacant during the season with broadcasters using alternate locations...Additionally, the Cyclones wore commemorative patches on their home uniforms with his initials and trademark multi-colored umbrella...On Opening Day, the Cyclones radio broadcast went silent in the top of the 6th to mark the first official game without Warner behind the mic.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Brooklyn's roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast 12 of the Mets' Top 30 prospects...Those include OF Carson Benge (3), INF Jesús Báez (7), LHP Jonathan Santucci (12), INF Boston Baro (13), INF Marco Vargas (14), RHP Nate Dohm (18), INF Jacob Reimer (20), C Fürs Suero (21), OF Eli Serrano III (22) and CR Ronald Hernández (26), OF A.J. Ewing (27), and RHP Will Watson (29)...The Cyclones also possess 11 of the Mets' Top 30 farmhands per Baseball America...The list features Béaz (6), Benge (7), Ewing (8), Reimer (10), Vargas (11), Baro (17), Santucci (18), Suero (19), Serrano III (20), RHP Raimon Gómez (21), and Dohm (24)...Brooklyn also hosts 11 of SNY's Top 30 from Joe DeMayo... Benge (5), Báez (6), Baro (13), Santucci (15), Vargas (17), Dohm (20), Reimer (21), Serrano (22), Suero (25), Hernández (26), and Gómez (28).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Suffered the loss in his first Major League rehab start last Friday night at Wilmington...Surrendered 4 runs (3 earned) on 4 hits in 1.2 innings...Plunked a batter, did not issue a walk, and struck out a pair...Threw 36 pitches and 26 strikes (72.22%)...Relieved by RHP **Brian Metoyer** with a runner at 1st and 2 out in the bottom of the 2nd and Brooklyn behind 4-0...Bequeathed runner did not score...Wilmington would tally 17 hits, the most Brooklyn has allowed in a game this year, en route to an 8-2 win over the Cyclones.

**COMEBACK REPORT:** Manaea will make his 2nd Major League rehab start on Tuesday night...The 33-year-old did not pitch in Spring Training and was placed on New York's 15-day injured list on 3/27 (retro 3/24) with a right oblique strain...He was transferred to the Mets' 60-day injured list on 4/29...Manaea signed a 3-year, \$75 million deal with New York on 12/27/24...This came after Manaea opted out of his 2-year contract with the Mets on 11/4/24.

2024: Spent the entire season with the Mets...Collected a 12-6 record with a 3.47 ERA (70 ER in 181.2 IP), 134 hits allowed, 63 walks, and 184 strikeouts...Set a career-high in innings pitched (181.2 IP) and tied a career-high in wins (12) and starts (32)...Manaea's 184 strikeouts were the 2nd-most in his career and 9th most in the National League...Registered the lowest full-season ERA of his career (3.47)...1 of 8 pitchers who made 32 or more starts and accrued an ERA below 3.50...Held opponents to a .190 average, the 4th-lowest in MLB...From 7/1 until the end of the season, Manaea was 1st in the majors in innings (105.1), 2nd in quality starts (12), and 6th in strikeouts (108) and WHIP (0.93)...Composed a 2-1 record with a 4.74 ERA (10 ER in 19.0 IP), 8 walks, and 19 strikeouts in 4 postseason starts...1st Mets pitcher to throw 7.0 or more innings and record 10 or more strikeouts in back-to-back starts since RHP Max Scherzer (4/19 (2)-25/22)...Joined RHP Dwight Gooden (2x) and RHP Tom Seaver (3x) as the only pitchers in franchise history to post consecutive starts of 7.0 or more scoreless frames and double-digit strikeouts...7th left-handed pitcher in franchise history with 4 or more double-digit strikeout games in a season, joining LHP Sid Fernandez, LHP Jerry Koosman, LHP Johan Santana, and LHP Jon Matlack...His 11 K's vs. Minnesota on 7/30 were the most in a game by a Mets' left-hander since Steven Matz struck out 11 on 9/1/18 at San Francisco and the most by a Met at Citi Field since Johan Santana vs. Miami (4/24/12)...Became the first Met since RHP Jacob deGrom (9/30/22 at Atlanta) to record 11 or more strikeouts without issuing a walk...Did not allow a hit over first 5.2 innings in his Mets debut on 4/1 vs. Detroit...Longest no-hit bid by a Mets pitcher in their team debut...Joined LHP Kenny Rogers (7/28/99) as the only Mets pitchers to allow 1 hit and throw 6.0 or more innings in their team debut...His 8 K's were tied with Johan Santana (3/31/08) for most punch outs by a Mets' left-hander in their tea

**MAGNIFICENT MANAEA:** On April 21, 2018, Manaea threw the 12th no-hitter in Athletics franchise history when he no-hit the Boston Red Sox...He struck out 10 and walked 2 in the 3-0 victory...The no-hitter was the earliest by date (RHP **Catfish Hunter**, 5/8/68 vs. Minnesota) and 2nd earliest by game number (RHP **Chief Bender**, 5/12/10 vs. Cleveland, game 18)...It was the 10th no-hitter in Coliseum history...It was the A's first no-hitter since LHP **Dallas Braden**'s perfect game on 5/9/10 vs. Tampa Bay...3rd Oakland pitcher to strike out 10 or more in a no-hitter (RHP **Dave Stewart**, 12, and RHP **Catfish Hunter**, 11).

**BACK WHERE IT ALL BEGAN:** Manaea returned to the site of his professional debut last Friday...Originally a first-round pick of the Kansas City Royals in 2013, the 33-year-old started his first career game as a member of the Wilmington Blue Rocks in 2014...In 29 starts with the club between 2014 and 2015, Manaea accumulated an 8-8 record with a 3.18 ERA (50 ER in 141.1 IP), walking 58, and striking out 168...During the 2014 Carolina League season with Wilmington, the southpaw led the circuit in strikeouts (146) and ranked 3rd in batting average against (.228), 4th in ERA (3.11), tied for 5th in games started (25), and 7th in WHIP (1.28)...Friday will mark Manaea's first start at Frawley Stadium since his final outing as a member of the Blue Rocks on 7/15/15 vs. Frederick (5.0 IP, 2 H, R, 2 BB, 5 K)...On 7/28/15, he was dealt with RHP **Aaron Brooks** to the Oakland Athletics in exchange for UTL **Ben Zobrist** and cash considerations...Zobrist would go 6-for-23 (.261) at the plate against the New York Mets in Kansas City's World Series victory that October.
