SYKORA DAY: After scoring a season-high 21 runs last night to break a three-game skid and gain a game back in the standings, the FredNats continue to close in on a second half title in the finale of this 12-game road trip throughout the Carolinas. LHP Alex Clemmey makes his second start of the week against Kannapolis. Clemmey pitched better than his line indicated on Tuesday as he ended up allowing four earned runs in 4.2 IP. He struck out seven, which is the most in a start with Fredericksburg since the trade with Cleveland.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Fredericksburg put up a season-high 21 runs on 18 hits, blowing out Kannapolis 21-5 to break a three-game skid. Every single FredNat had multiple reaches, and eight out of the nine hitters had an RBI, with Sam Petersen somehow not picking up one despite going 4-for-6 with three extra base hits. Travis Sykora earned his fifth win of the year, pitching five scoreless innings with nine K's.

HE'S BACKKKK: After winning Carolina League Player of the Month for April, Brandon Pimentel got back to early-season form in August. He continues to lead the Carolina League in RBI with 81, and in August, Pimentel slashed .316/.386/.494 for an OPS of .880. He drove in 19 runs in August as well, his most in a month since he knocked in a whopping 33 runs in April.

INSANE DEBUT: Washington's 8th round draft pick out of lowa Sam Petersen had an incredible professional debut last night, going 4-for-6 with two doubles, finishing a home run short of the cycle in the big FredNat victory. Petersen had a career OPS of .964 in 133 games across three seasons in the Big Ten for the Hawkeyes.

STANDINGS WATCH: With seven games remaining in the regular season, the playoff race is officially on in the Carolina League North. Fredericksburg is now tied for the division lead with Carolina, but the Mudcats are a non-factor in the second half standings due to them winning the first half, so FXBG could theoretically finish second to Carolina and still make the playoffs. The FredNats lead Salem by 3.0 games heading into play today, and the lead is 6.5 games over Down East and 6.5 games over Lynchburg, the team Fredericksburg finishes the regular season against next week.

HE'S SOMETHING ELSE: Travis Sykora has proven to be one of the most dominant pitchers in the Carolina League since arriving in Fredericksburg on May 1. Since beginning his professional career that day, he ranks first in all of MiLB in strikeouts per nine (13.67), 1st in opponent average (.157), 3rd in WHIP (0.85), and is tied for 9th with 116 strikeouts. In his last seven starts, he's struck out at least 10 hitters in three of them, and has an ERA of 1.08 in that time frame. In MLB Pipeline's re-ranking of prospects, Sykora shot up the list to Washington's third overall prospect, and entered the Top 100 prospects in baseball as well.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 211-174 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals. He was the Pitching Coach for the High-A Wilmington Blue Rocks in 2021 and the Double-A Harrisburg Senators in 2022 before coming to FXBG in 2023 and spending the last two seasons here.

Habas, 33, is in his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh is also in his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Alex Clemmey makes his sixth start as a FredNat tonight, taking on the Kannapolis Cannonballers. It's the lefty's 25th start overall, having made his first 19 starts with Lynchburg.

Alex was acquired as a key piece in the Nationals' return for Lane Thomas from Cleveland. Coincidentally, the trade was made right before the FredNats and Hillcats were scheduled to start a series, so Clemmey simply had to switch dugouts.

WELCOME TO PRO BALL: Clemmey faced a rude introduction to the Carolina league, as the southpaw struggled mightily in his first month playing professionally. Alex sported a 12.60 ERA over five starts (15.0 IP), as opponents hit .306 against him. But from May through June, Clemmey posted a 2.48 ERA in 54.1 innings.

AS A FREDNAT: Clemmey has been solid for FXBG since the trade, working to a 4.74 ERA in 19.0 innings. The big lefty has struck out 21 men and walked 12 in his five starts.

LAST TIME OUT: Alex started the opener this week against Kannapolis, who tagged him for five runs (four earned) in 4.2 innings. Clemmey also faced the Ballers when he was still a Hillcat, and shut them down with four one-run innings.
