RockHounds Spoil Star Wars Night

The Midland RockHounds (30-32) grabbed hold of an early 3-0 lead in the first inning and never looked back as they went on to score 10 runs on twelve hits against the San Antonio Missions (27-35) on Star Wars Night.

That's All, Folks

The San Antonio Missions conclude their home schedule today. They are 33-35 overall at home but 18-14 in the second half. They have won 7 walk-offs, had back-to-back-to-back homers, and recently overcame deficits of 3 in the ninth against NWA and 5 against Midland. The Missions have welcomed 238,366 fans to The Wolff and averaged 3,612, the 5th most in the Texas League.

Atta Boy Karp

Braedon Karpathios not only has a 7-game hit streak but also a 6-game multi-hit streak. This week, he is 12-19 (.631) with 2 homers and 13 RBIs. He recorded the first 5-hit game for a Mission on Wednesday since Brandon Valenzuela on May 16, 2025 in Midland. He also homered and drove in 4 runs, so he leads the team with 17 homers and 73 RBIs. His 17 homers are the most for a Mission since Keston Hiura has 19 in 2019 and the most for a Mission in the Texas League since Austin Allen had 22 in 2018.

Getting it Done

Romeo Sanabria, last year's Missions' hits leader, extended his hit streak to 5 games last night. Since returning to the Missions from Triple-A El Paso on August 7, Romeo Sanabria is 33-74 (.445) with 7 doubles and 10 RBIs.

No Slowing Down

Since getting promoted to San Antonio on August 14, Alex McCoy he is 25-79 (.316) with 3 homers, 3 doubles and 14 RBIs.

Always Wanting More

Tirso Ornelas is 2nd in the Texas League with 32 doubles and 7th with 49 extra base hits.

Hits a Plenty

Justin DeCriscio has hits in 10 of 14 games as a Mission. He is hitting .271 with 2 doubles, 6 walks, 4 runs and 3 stolen bases in San Antonio.

Producing Since the Break

Since the 2nd half started, Fabian leads the Missions (at least 100 ABs) with a .303 average. He also has 13 doubles, 8 homers and 33 RBIs.

As Automatic as R2-D2

Josh Mallitz picked up the win in 2 innings of work Friday. After he allowed 11 runs in his first 2 outings of the year off the Injured List, Josh Mallitz is 5-0 with a 2.22 ERA in 35 games since, walking 19 and striking out 59 in 56.2 innings. He also has 6 saves in 8 opportunities. Mallitz is in the organization's top 30 according to MLB Pipeline at No. 29.

Quite the Contrast

At home, Missions pitchers have a 3.86 ERA, the best in Double-A, and have allowed 40 home runs, the fewest in Double-A. On the road, their ERA is 6.37 the worst in Double-A and they have allowed 88 home runs (5th-most).

Struggle to Score

The Missions have scored the fewest runs (570) in all of Double-A and have the fewest home runs (107).

They're On There

The Missions have stranded 960 runners on base, the 4th-most in Double-A, and their .225 AVG with RISP is the worst at the level. Yesterday, they went 1-8 with RISP and stranded 7.

The Man for the Finale

24-year-old Jamie Hitt starts for the Missions. On Tuesday, he allowed 3 hits but no runs with 3 walks and 4 strikeouts. Hitt is 3-6 with a 5.60 ERA in 23 games (20 starts) with 39 walks and 87 strikeouts in 98 innings across 3 levels. Since joining the Missions, he is 2-1 with a 6.34 ERA in 9 games (7 starts) with 15 walks and 33 strikeouts in 38.1 innings. He made 1 appearance at Single-A Lake Elsinore, tossing 2 scoreless innings before going 1-5 with a 5.31 ERA at High-A Fort Wayne with 24 walks and 50 strikeouts in 57.2 innings. The San Diego Padres drafted Hitt in the 8th round of the 2025 MLB Draft out of the University of Oklahoma. This is his first professional season. Hitt began his career at Texas Tech for one season before becoming a Sooner. Hitt's Double-A debut came in Midland when he picked up the win in relief on July 12 with 2 runs (1 earned) on 3 hits with 1 walk and 1 strikeout in 2 innings.

On the Other Side

25-year-old Jackson Finley starts for Midland. The Savannah, Georgia native is 2-1 with a 3.02 ERA in 11 starts for Midland with 20 walks and 48 strikeouts in 44.2 innings. He went 2-1 with a 5.00 ERA in 4 games (3 starts) with 6 walks and 20 strikeouts with High-A Lansing. Last Friday, he allowed 1 run on 1 hit with 2 walks and 3 strikeouts in 2.2 inning in Tulsa. Finley missed all of 2025 with injury. On July 9, he allowed 2 runs on 5 hits with 3 walks and 8 strikeouts against San Antonio. The Athletics drafted Finley in the 8th round of the 2023 Draft out of Georgia Tech.

About Last Night

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San Antonio Missions Coaches

Manager - Chris Tremie

Chris Tremie begins his first season in the San Diego Padres organization and as manager of the San Antonio Missions. He spent 13 seasons as a manager in the Cleveland Guardians organization and the last seven seasons as the minor league field coordinator for the Cincinnati Reds.

“Fans should expect to come out and see a team that’s going to compete on a daily basis,” Tremie said. “It will be a good brand of baseball. We’re going to play the game the right way.”

Tremie debuted as a catcher for the Chicago White Sox in 1995. He later played for the Texas Rangers, Pittsburgh Pirates and Houston Astros across a total of 22 Major League Baseball games. Tremie retired in 2005 as a member of the Round Rock Express, the Astros’ Triple-A affiliate at the time, and began his managing career in 2006 with the Cleveland organization. His time with Cleveland included two years of managing Double-A Akron and six years leading Triple-A Columbus.

The Houston native attended the University of Houston, where he helped lead the Cougars to two 40-win seasons before being drafted by the White Sox in the 39th round of the 1992 MLB Draft. As a minor leaguer in the White Sox organization, Tremie played with NBA legend Michael Jordan on the Double-A Birmingham Barons as Jordan attempted to play professional baseball.

Hitting Coach Eric Del Prado

Eric Del Prado returns for his second season as hitting coach in San Antonio. He previously worked as a hitting coach at the Arizona Complex League (ACL) in 2023 before taking on the hitting coach role with Single-A Lake Elsinore during the 2024 season.

A native of El Segundo, California, Del Prado attended Willamette University and coached for four years at Lewis & Clark College in Oregon.

Pitching Coach Erick Abreu

Erick Abreu, a native of Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic, pitched for nine years in the minor leagues with the New York Yankees and Houston Astros, even making a stop with the Texas League’s Corpus Christi Hooks. Abreu then became a pitching coach in the Astros’ system for nine seasons, spending time in six different levels.

Over the last two seasons, Abreu served as the major league bullpen coach for the Atlanta Braves.

Bench Coach Brian Burres

Brian Burres brings recent leadership acumen from within the Padres organization, working as the manager for Single-A Lake Elsinore in 2025, as a pitching coach at the Arizona Complex League in 2024 and as an assistant coach with High-A Fort Wayne in 2023.

Burres also boasts the most extensive major league playing career on the staff, pitching in over 100 games for the Baltimore Orioles, Toronto Blue Jays and Pittsburgh Pirates across six big-league seasons.

Strength Coach Chandler Craig

Chandler Craig continues for a second season with the Missions after two seasons as strength and conditioning coach with High-A Fort Wayne. This will be his fourth season in the Padres organization.

Craig previously spent two seasons with the Red Sox organization, including time with Single-A Salem. Craig is a native of Lubbock, Texas and graduated from Texas Tech University.

Athletic Trainer Juan Peña

Juan Peña embarks on his second season with the Missions and second with the Padres organization. In 2024, Peña won one of only 14 Minor League Baseball Athletic Trainer of the Year awards for his work with Single-A Lake Elsinore.

Peña worked in the Detroit Tigers organization from 2018-2023, with most of his time spent at the Florida Complex League. He is from Lakeland, Florida, and graduated from East Central University.
