K'S ON K'S The Sea Dogs are averaging 11.05 strikeouts per nine innings, with nine or more strikeouts in 11 of their first 14 games, including five of six games vs. Altoona last week. Ten individual Portland pitchers are averaging more than nine strikeouts per nine innings.

HOLY HOLOBETZ Despite being tagged with the loss in Saturday's shutout, Holobetz had a career day on the mound, earning **Eastern League Pitcher of the Week**, Portland's first individual accolade of the season. He threw just 74 pitches (54 strikes) through 7.0 innings of work, allowing one run and one walk with a career-high 11 strikeouts, dealing a perfect game through the first 4.1 innings of play.

ROSARIO'S RESURGENCE After starting the season hitless through his first four games with seven strikeouts, Ronald Rosario is on a five game hit streak with nine total hits and zero strikeouts. His streak includes two doubles, a home run and four RBI, with three multi-hit games. Rosario led the Sea Dogs in RBI (56) and ranked second in home runs (11) in 2025.

WALKIN' WILL TURNER Will Turner's 15 walks this season leads the Eastern League and is tied for second most in AA baseball. Turner did not reach base in Sunday's finale at Altoona, breaking an on-base streak of ten straight games to start the season. Turner had walked in six straight games before Sunday, and recorded a season high four walks in a game on April 9th against New Hampshire.

DIDN'T SKIP A BEAT Max Ferguson was on the Injured List from 4/8 to 4/16. In his first game back, he blasted the Sea Dogs' first grand slam of the season. Ferguson is on a six game hit streak with at least one hit in every game he's played this season, including a double and two home runs. Ferguson recorded his first multi-hit game of the season in Sunday's finale, with two singles and an RBI.

HARTFORD RUNDOWN Hartford won just one of five games against the Richmond Flying Squirrels (12-2) in last week's series, with Sunday's finale canceled due to weather. Hartford scored more than six runs per game across that stretch, but allowed more than eight runs per game to Richmond. Their lone win broke up a ten game win streak for Richmond, who currently boasts the best record in the Eastern League. Extra bases have come often for the Yard Goats. Their offense is led by Bryant Betancourt, one of eight Eastern League players with four home runs this season. Both Andy Perez and Aidan Longwell are tied for the Eastern League lead with seven doubles apiece.

THIS DAY IN SEA DOGS HISTORY April 21, 2005 – Cla Meredith converted his 25th straight professional save as the Sea Dogs beat Harrisburg 5-4 at Hadlock Field.

ON THE MOUND RHP Gage Ziehl (1-1, 6.14 ERA) returns to the mound for his third start of the season. Ziehl earned his first win last Wednesday against Altoona, pitching 5.0 shutout innings with four hits, two walks, and six strikeouts. Ziehl, originally drafted by the Yankees in 2024, was acquired through a trade with the White Sox in February.

Leading the Sea Dogs

Manager - Chad Epperson

Manager Chad Epperson will lead the team in his fourth season in Portland. In 2024, he led the Sea Dogs to a 78-60 record, the best record in the Northeast Division of the Eastern League, and third best in the league. In his fourth season with the team, he is tied for the longest serving manager in Sea Dogs history with Arnie Beyeler who managed Portland for four seasons from 2007 to 2010. Before managing the Sea Dogs, Epperson spent 12 seasons as the Red Sox Catching Coordinator.

Pitching Coach - Juan Rivera

Juan Rivera also returns to the Sea Dogs coaching staff as a pitching coach for his second season. In 2025, Rivera helped guide a Portland pitching staff that recorded 1,435 strikeouts, the second-most in the Eastern League, while posting a 3.65 team ERA, the fourth-best mark in the league. Rivera spent the previous three seasons as the Salem Red Sox' pitching coach, where he led the staff to a 3.61 ERA, the fourth-best in Single-A. A graduate of Eastern Nazarene College, Rivera has been part of the Boston Red Sox organization since 2022, serving as a Development Coach with Salem before joining the Sea Dogs coaching staff.

Hitting Coach - Trevor Burmeister

Trevor Burmeister joins the Sea Dogs coaching staff as hitting coach after spending the previous five seasons in the Colorado Rockies organization. A Wisconsin native from Verona, Burmeister began his coaching career immediately following his collegiate playing career at the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse, where he spent two seasons on the coaching staff. He then served one season at the University of Minnesota Duluth, where the offense ranked third nationally in NCAA Division II with a .352 team batting average and second in the nation with 102 home runs. Burmeister later returned to his alma mater, Madison College (NJCAA), spending three seasons under head coach Mike Davenport. During his time there, he was named the 2019 NJCAA Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Baseball Coaches Association and Baseball America. During the offseason, Burmeister resides in Black Earth, Wisconsin.

Defensive Coach - Kyle Sasala

Kyle Sasala enters his third season on the Portland staff after a highly successful tenure at Grove City College, where he served as Associate Head Coach from 2016 to 2023. During his time with the Wolverines, Sasala played a key role in the program's rise, highlighted by a school-record 30-win season in 2023 and a 16-4 conference mark. He also helped guide Grove City to a then-record 28 victories in 2019 alongside head coach Matt Royer. Sasala later stepped in as interim head coach for the Eastern College Athletic Conference Division III Championship Tournament, leading the Wolverines to a runner-up finish.

Athletic Trainer - Kelsey Branstetter

Kelsey Branstetter joins the staff as Portland's Athletic Trainer, her first year with the Sea Dogs and second season in the Red Sox organization. She spent last season as the Athletic Trainer for the Greenville Drive (High-A) and served in the same role for Triple-A Louisville (Cincinnati Reds) from 2023-2024. Branstetter graduated from Middle Tennessee State University, where she played four years of soccer. Following her undergraduate studies, Branstetter obtained a master's degree from Wichita State University.

Strength and Conditioning Coach - Jonah Mondloch

Strength and Conditioning Coach Jonah Mondloch returns to the staff for his second season in Portland and his third year in the Red Sox organization. He previously served as an Assistant Rehab Strength and Conditioning Coach, where he supported the strength and conditioning programs for players returning to the field. In that role, he collaborated closely with Major League sports performance and on-field staff to ensure the highest level of care for injured athletes.
