**Today:** The Lugnuts and Dragons play the fourth game in a six-game series in Dayton, with Lansing sending right-hander **Reid Birlingmair** to the mound for his team-leading 19th start, opposed by Dayton right-hander **Bryce Bonnin** in his second High-A start. Lansing is 4-5 this season at Day Air Ballpark and 9-12 overall this year against the Dragons after dropping a tight one last night.

**Last Night: Dragons 3, Lugnuts 2.** A two-run ninth-inning home run by **Shane Selman** ruined a potential Dragons shutout bid, but Dayton still completed the slim victory, its second straight in the series over Lansing. Selman finished with a walk, a single, a double and a homer and shortstop **Drew Swift** added a walk, a single and a double, but the Lugnuts stranded 11 runners on the bases and finished 0-for-10 with runners in scoring position.

**On Deck:** Following this series in Dayton, the Lugnuts continue their 12-game, 13-day road trip with a six-game set at Fort Wayne before wrapping up 2021 at home vs. West Michigan.

**What's New in 2021:** Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

### LUG•NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

**Welcome Back:** Outfielder **Lazaro Armenteros** returns to the Lugnuts lineup tonight. Armenteros missed time from July 25-August 17, returned to play four games August 18-22, but has not seen action since August 22.

**Back and Better Than Ever:** After missing time from July 23-August 24 due to an injured foot, outfielder **Shane Selman** has returned to hit .400 in seven games off the Injured List, providing 10 hits in 25 at-bats. That includes four doubles and two home runs for the former McNeese State Cowboy.

**Patience is a Virtue:** Shortstop **Drew Swift** drew another walk yesterday, giving him six walks in three games of this series, nine walks in his last five games, and 15 walks in 18 games with the Lugnuts overall. Though Swift is hitting .250, his on-base percentage rests at .435 entering tonight.

**Late Drama With the Dragons:** Combining the Nuts' two walk-off wins against Dayton on August 13 and August 15 with last night's series opening victory, the last three Lansing victories against the Dragons have each come in the Lugnuts' final at-bat. The Nuts have 11 final at-bat victories overall this year.

**Winning Tight:** Each of the last five Lugs victories and seven of the last eight have come by one run. Lansing is 14-7 in one-run games this season.

**Closing the Door:** Reliever **Charles Hall** struck out the Dragons' 1-2-3 hitters, **Michael Siani**, **Matt McLain** and **Juan Martinez**, to close out Game 1 on Wednesday night with the potential game-tying run in scoring position. In the process, the man nicknamed Captain Hook notched his 10th save of the year, one behind Lake County's **Jerson Ramirez** and West Michigan's **Zack Hess** for the league lead. Hall has not allowed a run in his last 12 appearances (13 1/3 scoreless innings, 5 hits in 42 at-bats/.119 avg., 7 walks, 21 strikeouts), with his last run allowed coming on July 25.

**V is for Vance... and Versatility:** Super utilityman **Cobie Vance** has batted in every slot, 1 through 9, and has played five different defensive positions this year: shortstop, second base, third base, left field and right field. After playing right field and second base earlier in this series, Vance starts at third base tonight. Vance has also showed off supreme patience, drawing two walks last night after drawing two walks in the first game of this series. He also recorded a pair of outfield assists in yesterday's game, with **Matt McLain** tagged out at second and **Quin Cotton** tagged out at third base.

**Alumni Report:** 2011-2012 Lugnuts catcher **Carlos Pérez** has caught fire as of late for Oakland's Triple-A affiliate, the Las Vegas Aviators. Pérez knocked his team-leading 26th home run of the season yesterday and is now slugging .617 with a .960 OPS for the season, while striking out only 36 times in 315 plate appearances.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2011:** It was 96 degrees in Dayton as Dragons SS Billy Hamilton went 2-for-3 with a sacrifice, stealing three bases to reach the 100-steal mark. The Lugnuts lost, 4-2.

**2016:** All-Star first baseman Juan Kelly reached base in all five appearances to extend his on-base streak to 34 games: HBP in the 1st, BB in the 4th, 1B/R in the 6th, 1B/R in the 7th, and 2B in the 8th. Justin Maese combined with two relievers on a two-hit shutout in a 6-0 win at Lake County. Maese struck out seven in 5 2/3 innings, allowing two singles, and Kirby Sneed and Geno Encina combined for 3 1/3 perfect innings of relief. Secretly, both Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero, Jr., joined the Lugnuts on the road in Lake County, taking batting practice with the team in preparation of the Crosstown Showdown on September 6th.

**New Talent Infusion:** The Lugnuts have five 2021 Athletics acquisitions on their roster in infielders **Brett Harris** (drafted in the 7th round, Gonzaga) and **Drew Swift** (8th round, Arizona State), outfielder **Jonny Butler** (14th round, North Carolina State), and pitchers **Kyle Virbitsky** (17th round, Penn State) and **Jack Owen** (undrafted free agent, Auburn).

**Root, Root, Root for the Home Team:** July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Miami Marlins and Oakland Athletics. Only nine of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a large crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Salt Lake, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

**Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting:** **Blake McFarland**, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor who competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode.

**Major League Lugnuts:** Six former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season - pitcher **Ty Tice** '18 (Toronto, now with Arizona), outfielder **Josh Palacios** '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher **Taylor Saucedo** '16-'17 (Toronto), pitcher **Conner Greene** '15 (Baltimore), pitcher **Kirby Sneed** '16-'17 (Toronto) and infielder **Otto Lopez** '19 (Toronto). Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: **Carlos Febles** and **Carlos Beltrán** for the Kansas City Royals. Sneed most recently debuted, appearing in relief for the Blue Jays on July 28.

**Star of Stars:** The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut **Bo Bichette** came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

**Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases:** On June 15, **Max Schuemann** broke **Samad Taylor's** franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

**Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed:** On June 20, **Stevie Emanuels** broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

**Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs:** On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

**Representing His Country:** 1B/3B **Jordan Diaz** played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

**Front Office Connections:** Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

**International Appeal:** Seven nations are represented on the Lugnuts' roster: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (**Anthony Phillips**) and Venezuela (**Javier Godard**).

**Welcome to the Pros:** Pitchers **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels**, **Jack Owen**, **Kyle Virbitsky** and **Shohei Tomioka**, catchers **Jared McDonald**, **Drew Millas** and **William Simoneit**, infielder **Patrick McColl**, and outfielder **Michael Guldberg** have all made their professional debut with the Lugnuts this season.

**So Many Starters:** The Lugnuts have used 19 different starting pitchers this season, namely **Brady Basso**, **Osvaldo Berrios**, **Reid Birlingmair**, **Charlie Cerny**, **Jeff Criswell**, **Jack Cushing**, **David Leal**, **Stevie Emanuels**, **Richard Guasch**, **Jorge Juan**, **Rafael Kelly**, **Bryce Nightengale**, **Jack Owen**, **Colin Peluse**, **Leudeny Pineda**, **Seth Shuman**, **Shohei Tomioka**, **Kyle Virbitsky** and **Brock Whitlesey**.

**Three Nuts Go to Washington:** On July 30, catcher **Drew Millas** and pitchers **Richard Guasch** and **Seth Shuman** were traded by the Athletics to the Washington Nationals in exchange for catcher **Yan Gomes** and utilityman **Josh Harrison**.

**Personal:** Reid's last name is pronounced "BIR-ling-MY-er"... instructor at the K's Training Academy in the offseason, located in Normal, as is college/Lugnugs teammate and best friend Charlie Cerny (pronounced "Cher-nee").

**Facing Dayton:** May 14 at Dayton: charged with loss, 4 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 4 BB, 3 K; only run scored on Brian Rey sac fly off reliever Charles Hall... July 3 vs. Dayton: earned win with brilliant 6 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 5 K; Lugnuts tossed combined one-hitter, with Quin Cotton's double preventing a no-hitter... August 11 vs. Dayton: suffered loss, 5 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 0 BB, 5 K, allowing homers to Matt McLain and Michael Siani, both two-run shots, supplying Dragons' four runs; McLain debuted with a single, double and homer against Birlingmair amid a four-hit, five-RBI game.

**Last Outing: August 28 vs. West Michigan...** notched fourth quality start of the year with six innings, three hits, three runs, two walks, four strikeouts in no-decision... allowed two run HR to Austin Murr and solo HR to Parker Meadows... 90 pitches, 55 strikes.

**Notable Splits:** At home: 5.80 ERA, 9 GS, 40 1/3 IP, .245 avg. ... on the road: 3.55 ERA, 9 GS, 45 2/3 IP, .218 avg. ... vs. left-handed hitters: .244/.354/.466, 8 HR... vs. right-handed hitters: .214/.319/.329, 3 HR.

## Notable 2021 moments with Lansing:

- Started fourth game of the season, May 7th vs. Lake County: allowed solo home run to Austen Wade... picked Joe Naranjo off first base in the 4th inning... departed with Nuts trailing 3-0... Lugnuts lost, 6-2.
- May 21 at Fort Wayne: pitched brilliantly, shutting out the TinCaps through six innings, allowing only one hit.
- June 4 vs. South Bend: pitched two scoreless innings before allowing a leadoff single in the 3rd, walking three consecutive Cubs, giving up an RBI single, inducing a double-play ball, and then departing after hitting Caleb Knight... the Nuts erased the 3-0 South Bend lead with 17 unanswered runs (!).
- June 18 vs. Great Lakes: gave up three-run homers to Ryan Ward in both the 1st and 2nd innings... had only allowed one home run in 122 batters faced before Ward took him deep in the first inning.
- July 3 vs. Dayton: for the second time, tossed six one-hit scoreless innings... Lugnuts won with a combined one-hitter, with only Quin Cotton's third-inning double denying the Lugnuts a no-hitter.
- July 10 at Great Lakes: shut out Loons for five innings before allowing two runs in the 6th.
- July 17 vs. Lake County: allowed one unearned run in five innings... bullpen collapsed, blowing a 7-1 lead going to the 7th inning and an 8-7 lead heading into the 8th... pen allowed 12 runs in the final three innings in a 13-9 Lugnuts loss.
- July 30 vs. Fort Wayne, knocked out in the third inning, walking five and allowing three hits... Lugnuts then knocked out TinCaps starter Connor Lehmann in the bottom of the 3rd inning with a six-run rally, going on to win 9-6... the 3rd inning lasted 57 minutes.
- August 5 at Lake County, gave up a double to Julian Escobedo and a two-run homer to Jose Tena immediately... settled in to limit the Captains to only one further hit and one walk over the next 18 outs... gave up three hits, one walk and three runs in the 7th inning before departing... Lugnuts lost, 5-1.
- August 11 vs. Dayton, suffered the loss, allowing four runs in five innings on two big swings: a two-run homer in the 3rd inning by Matt McLain and a two-run homer in the 4th by Michael Siani... both home runs came with two outs... after the 5th, there was a 92-minute rain delay with the Lugnuts trailing 4-0... after the rain delay, bullpen was shelled in a 12-4 loss.
- August 17 at Great Lakes, gave up first-pitch home run to Ryan Ward in the 1st, and then a solo home run to Brandon Lewis leading off the 2nd... allowed only one other hit in five innings, but suffered the loss in Lansing's 2-1 defeat.

**Professional Career:** Made his professional debut in the AZL in 2018 (1.45 ERA, 18 2/3 IP, 5 R, 6 BB, 25 K) before moving up to Vermont on August 8 (2.25 ERA, 5 G, 3 GS, 16.0 IP, 10 BB, 8 K)... spent full 2019 in Beloit (4.02 ERA, 123 IP, 108 H, 50 BB, 120 K), pitching at least six innings in nine games, topping out at 7-IP, 1-R, 8-K on July 24th... faced the Lugnuts once (3 IP, 0 R) on May 4th... had overall numbers skewed by one bad month: 1.46 ERA in 24.2 IP in May, 10.72 ERA in 22.2 IP in June, 2.78 in 35.2 IP in July, 2.36 in 34.1 IP in August.

**Draft Day:** Selected 833rd overall in the 28th round from the University of Illinois at Chicago (the "Flames") in 2018... signed by Derek Lee... drafted 21 rounds after Charlie Cerny... the 2018 draft was fruitful for the Lugnuts roster, also producing Bryce Nightengale (16th round), Cobie Vance (18th round), Max Schuemann (20th round), Aiden McIntyre (22nd round).

**Life as a Flame:** Reid struggled as a freshman at the University of Illinois, Chicago (8.81 ERA, 17 G, 3 GS, 31 2/3 IP, 33 R, 24 BB, 27 K, 11 HBP) but bounced back to have a strong sophomore season (3.10, 15 GS, 1 ShO, 93.0 IP, 34 R, 25 BB, 81 K, 5 HBP) and better junior season (2.12, 10 G, 8 GS, 51.0 IP, 12 R, 21 BB, 57 K, 5 HBP), though he missed time from March 23-April 24 with an injury.

**Baseball Over Nursing:** In an interview with White Cleat Beat, Reid shared that nursing had been his first pursuit, starting with volunteering at OSF St. Joseph Medical Center, Carle BroMenn Medical Center, and Camp Quality (serving children with cancer and their families). He applied to the nursing school at UIC as a sophomore before turning his attention fully toward baseball, majoring in liberal arts with a minor in psychology.

**Major League Standouts:** Only three UIC Flames have ever made the Majors, but each one is notable: Pete Mackanin (1973-1981), who managed the Pirates in 2005, the Reds in 2007 and the Phillies in 2015-2017; Ken Holtzman (1965-1979), who threw no-hitters for the Chicago Cubs in 1969 (despite not striking out a batter) and 1971 and was an American League All-Star with the Oakland Athletics' World Series champions in 1972 and 1973; and three-time All-Star Curtis Granderson (2004-2019), who was taken by Detroit in the third round in 2002 and collected exactly 1800 hits in his 16-year MLB career.

**High School Success, On and Off the Field:** Pitched and played shortstop at Normal West High School, where he was named 3x 1st Team All-Big 12 and the Big 12 Conference Pitcher of the year as a senior... played second base in the 2015 Illinois Coaches Association (ICA) All-Star Game... member of the National Honor Society and Spanish Honor Society.

**A Normal Background Check:** Birlingmair's hometown, Normal, was originally named North Bloomington in 1854. The name changed in 1865 to reflect its place as the home of Illinois State Normal University, a teaching school, now called simply Illinois State University. (Teaching schools were known as "normal schools" because their purpose was to instruct the students, future teachers, in properly understanding and instilling the societal norms at the time. Many state schools began as normal schools, like UCLA, which was originally named the Los Angeles California State Normal School.) Normal is the home of the Normal Cornbelters, a member of the Frontier League from 2010-2018 and now a member of the Prospect League, playing their home games at The Corn Crib.
