> ON THE RUN: While the Saints' 153 steals are the ninth-most in the International League, they have picked their spots well. The club's 86% success rate on stolen bases is the best in Triple-A and the third-best among full-season minor league teams. The Saints have not been thrown out since August 30 at Omaha, a span of 10 games in which they have stolen nine bases.

Extra Innings......2-6 PRATO POWER UP: Over his last eight games, Anthony Prato has been locked in, doubles and two RBI. Prato has struck out eight times in his last 26 plate Saints Out-Hit Opponents ...............39-8 appearances, but has also drawn just three walks. Prato has drawn 66 walks this season, tied for the 11th-most in the International League.

> ELECTRIC EELES: Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .406 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in 47 of the 53 games he's played in, drawing 23 walks and been hit by a pitch 11 times, the most in the International League in that span. He is fifth among fullseason minor league players in on-base percentage at .430 across three levels.

SUMMERTIME SEVERINO: In Yunior Severino's 77 games since May 21, he has hit .311 (94-for-302), with 14 home runs, drawing 47 walks, owning a .909 OPS. In that time, Severino ranks fourth in the league with 58 RBI, fifth in batting average and hits, sixth in on-base percentage at .399, OPS and total bases with 154.

S Severino has now tied the franchise single-season RBI record with 75 collected 115 hits on the season, ranking fifth on the single-season hit charts. He also ranks second in the single-season home run charts, trailing the 21 long balls that Jair Camargo and Chris Williams hit last season.

TWINS UPDATE: The Minnesota Twins rebounded with a 10-5 victory over the striking out 10. Louie Varland pitched 2.0 innings out of the bullpen to close out the Days In Ninth Place.....45 an infield single.

WORLD SERIES RUNNER-UP: Caleb spent his college years not far from home at the University of Wisconsin-La Crosse. As a freshman, he got to experience something that not many players get the opportunity to experience: a trip to the College World Series. His DIII squad reached the championship after beating Salisbury, 7-3, Emory, 3-2 in 12, losing the first game of the semifinals to Trinity(TX), 16-7, but bouncing back to win the second game, 10-7. Unfortunately, they met their match in the championship dropping the best-of-three to Cortland, getting swept 11-3 and 6-2. He would get back to the DIII World Series in 2016, but this was less successful losing 8-0 to Trinity, beating Emory, 12-3 before being eliminated by the team they lost to in the 2015 DIII Championship Game, Cortland, 8-3.

SOMETHINGS BREWING: One can't help where they grow up which can determine who you root for growing up. Caleb was born in Neenah, WI and resides in Madison, WI, so naturally he rooted for the Milwaukee Brewers. His hometown team came calling in the Minor League phase of the Rule 5 Draft in 2021, taking Caleb with the 22nd pick overall from the San Diego Padres. The storybook had an incredible ending when he was called up to the Brewers on September 29, 2023. He pitched 2.1 innings of relief vs. Chicago Cubs and allowed one run on one hit while walking two and striking out five. He earned the win in his lone Major League appearance.

GIVE BACK: Each of the Major League teams usually choose a player or players within their organization for the hard work they put towards the community. In 2023, the Brewers selected Caleb as the Nashville Sounds Community Player of the Year.
