#### FRES-NOTES

TOUGH THURSDAY FOR FRESNO: The Fresno Grizzlies (12-4) stumbled to the San Jose Giants (6-11) 7-0 Thursday evening from Chukchansi Park. The Grizzlies saw both their six-game overall winning streak and five-game winning streak against the Giants snapped. With the San Jose shutout, the first three contests of the series have ended with a goose egg for the losing team. Fresno has been shutout in two of their four losses overall (both have come at home). Jake Snider led the offensive charge, reaching base successfully four times. Snider was beaned by two pitches, walked once and roped a single. Andy Perez lengthened his hit streak to 16 games, the longest active hit streak in all of professional baseball. Relievers Welinton Herrera and Jake Madden were bright spots, combining for three hitless and scoreless frames, striking out five. Herrera fanned the side in his lone inning.

GIANT AMOUNT OF MATCHUPS: The Fresno Grizzlies and San Jose Giants (San Francisco Giants Single-A affiliate) continue their sixgame series tonight at Chukchansi Park. This is the second of six series between the clubs in 2024 and the first of three sets in Fresno. In the first series between the clubs, the Grizzlies enjoyed their first series sweep of the Giants since the California League Playoffs in 2022. Fresno also swept their first series at Excite Ballpark since joining the league in 2021. The Grizzlies are now 52-41 overall in the regular season (2-3 in playoffs) against the Giants since joining the California League.

FROM FRIEND TO FOE: The San Jose Giants have a few names on their coaching staff that the Central Valley may recognize. Giants pitching coach Dan Runzler was selected by the San Francisco Giants in the 9th round of the 2007 MLB Draft. He played for the Grizzlies from 2009-14, appearing in 144 games. Runzler pitched in the majors for parts of five seasons (Giants 2009-12, Pirates 2017) before playing overseas and independent ball. Over 97 big league games, he logged a 4-2 record with a 3.89 ERA over 76.1 innings. Another staff member frans may remember is Giants hitting coach Travis Ishikawa. The Giants selected Ishikawa in the 12st round of the 2002 MLB Draft out of Federal Way HS in Washington. Ishikawa played eight MLB seasons starting in 2006 and ending in 2015 with time spent in San Francisco (2006, 2008-10, 2014-15), Milwaukee (2012), Baltimore (2013), New York AL (2013) and Pittsburgh (2014-15). Ishikawa wore a Grizzlies uniform in 2008, 2011 and 2014, playing in 175 games. The final coach frans may remember is Giants Manager Ydwin Villegas. The always smilling infielder played for the Grizzlies from 2011-14, appearing in 95 games. Villegas batted .208 and had a .962 fielding percentage.

JACK OF ALL TRADES: Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to RHP Jack Mahoney. Mahoney is ranked as the Rockies #20 overall prospect on MLB.com, the highest rated prospect on the team. Mahoney was drafted by the Rockies in the 3rd round (Pick 77) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of South Carolina. The righty was a two-way player for multiple years with the Gamecocks, but was more effective on the mound. Mahoney went to high school in Illinois where he was teammates with Chicago Bears tight end Cole Kmet.

MAHONEY IS MONEY: Grizzlies RHP Jack Mahoney was selected by Minor League Baseball as the California League Pitcher of the Week for April 15-21. Mahoney's dominant start in Stockton helped the Grizzlies earn a series victory against the Ports. On Friday, April 19, Mahoney and a trio of relievers combined on a three-hit shutout, the first one thrown by the Grizzlies in 2024. Mahoney relished the victory after six sensational innings of work. He allowed two hits and one walk while fanning five. Mahoney did not allow a hit until one out into the sixth frame. At one point, Mahoney retired 12 botters in a row (2nd-6th innings). In three starts this season, the South Carolina product is 2-1 with a 165 ERA. Over 16.1 innings, Mahoney has permitted three runs (earned) on 11 hits and four walks while punching out 16 (0.92 WHIP, 193 batting average against him). The Rockies #20 overall prospect on MLB.com gives the 2024 Grizzlies their first California League award this season. Fresno won 10 California League honors (Weekly and Monthly) in 2023 and 14 California League honors (Weekly and Monthly) in 2022, a franchise record.

JAKE IS DEFINITELY NOT ON THE "SNIDE"R: Grizzlies OF Jake Snider has had an unbelievable month of April, going 15-for-38 (.395 AVG/.636 OBP/.737 SLG/.1373 OPS) with one homer, two triples, six doubles, 11 RBI, 18 runs, 22 walks, five hit-by-pitches and three stolen bases. The Louisville product is ranked first in ALL of professional baseball with a 1.373 OPS and .636 OBP. Snider's triple on April 24th (Wednesday) against San Jose was his 12th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him one triple shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

A+ FROM ANDY PEREZ: Crizzlies INF Andy Perez has hit safely in all 16 games to start this season, his longest hit streak while in a Fresno uniform. It is the longest Grizzlies hit streak since Benny Montgomery in 2022 (17 games, August 25-September 18, playoffs) and longest current active streak in Minor League Baseball. Perez is 24-for-67 (358 AVG/403 OBP/627 SLG/1030 OPS) with three homers (one grand slam), three triples, three doubles, 18 RBI, 12 runs, five walks and one stolen base. Perez's triple on April 24th (Wednesday) against San Jose was his 10th in a Grizzlies uniform, putting him three triples shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Career Records. Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick are tied for ninth all-time with 13 triples.

WIMMER IS A WINNER: Grizzlies INF Braylen Wimmer has also had a spectacular start to the season, going 15-for-47 (319 AVG/.439 OBP/.596 SLG/1.035 OPS) with a California League-leading four homers, one double, 10 RBI, 18 runs, nine walks and two stolen bases.

**EJ AND THE SB:** Dating back to last season, Grizzlies' OF EJ Andrews Jr. has stolen 14 bases (three this year), one in 14 different games. Fresno is 14-0 when Andrews Jr. swipes a base, with 12 of the 14 games ending within five runs.
