

FRES-NOTES

THANK YOU GROWLIFORNIA: Thank you to all of the amazing fans who have supported the Fresno Grizzlies this season. We are so grateful to have the best fans in all of Minor League Baseba and we can't wait to bring home another championship to Fresno!

THREE OH' FIVE: The Fresno Grizzlies end their 2021 regular season today with a 3:05 pm first pitch. The last time the Grizzlies had a 3:05 pm first pitch was in 2011 against the New Orleans Zephyrs.

PLAYER AWARDS: Last night, the Grizzlies presented four players with end of the season awards. The four players were awarded plaques based off their 2021 seasons. Zac Veen was named Team MVP. Drew Romo was given Hitter of the Year. Robinson Hemandez was named the Pitcher of the Year. Finally, Austin Kitchen was given the Community Player of the Year. Congratulations to the four players on their adhevements.

POARING INTO THE POSTSEASON: On September 7th, the Fresno Grizziles clinched a playoff berth with an 11-5 win over the Modesto Nuts at John Thurman Field. Fresno punched the first of two tickets into the Low-A West playoffs and will take on the San Jose Giants, after they clinched on September 10th. The playoffs will be a best of five series starting Tuesday. September 21st n Fresno. The last time the Grizziles mode the postseason was 2018 when they were apart of the Houston Astros organization. The Grizziles exercise Memphis Redbirds in the PCL Championship. Prior to that, Fresno made the postseason was 2018 when they would go on to win the PCL and Triple-A National Championships, also with the Astros system.

GIANT AMOUINT OF HISTORY: Fresno and San Jose will meet 30 times in the regular season and up to another five possible times in the postseason (25% of the regular season schedule) in 2021. Of their 29 games against one another this year, Fresno holds a 15-14 season-lead with 20 of those contests being decided by one or two runs. The last time that these two teams were in the same league was in 1988. The critication work as the Fresno Suns and did not have an affiliate tie. Rockies top prospect Zac Veen is second with 36 steals in 53 attempts and Bladimir Restituyo is tied for fourth with 31 swipes in 36 tries, all with the Grizziles.

DIAZ SPRINTS INTO THE RECORD BOOKS: Eddy Diaz swiped one bag September 17th against the San Jose Giants, giving him 47 stolen bases with the Grizzlies on the season. Diaz is in sole possession of second place on the Grizzlies' franchise single-eason steals list. Up next on the list is Tyler Graham, who swiped 60 bases back in 2011. Diaz's 47 Fresno stolen bases are also more than three full season Minor League teams (Rochester, Las Vegas and Portland) and his 55 swipes between two levels are more than nine full season Minor League teams.

YEER RACES INTO THE RECORD BOOKS TOO: The Grizzlies stole eight bases on September 3rd against the Stockton Ports, tying a season-high (June 9 at Modesto). Four of the eight stolen ases came from Zac Veen. The Rockies top prospect has 36 overall stolen bases on the season, which now puts him in a tie for fifth place on the Grizzlies' franchise single-season steals list. (even's four stolen bases on the inght also ties him with Emmanuel Burriss (2011) for the most swipes in a single game in franchise history. Burriss is the current hitting coach for the Oklahoma City lodgers, the Triple-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers.

ROMOR AURS THE THE RECORD BOOKS AS WELL: Fresno stole seven bases on September 7th against the Modesto Nuts en route to clinching a playoff berth. Four of the seven stolen bases came from Drew Romo. His four stolen bases on the evening ties him with Zac Veen (four days apart) and Emmanuel Burriss (2011) for the most swipes in a single game in franchise history. The Rockies #8 overail and top catching prospect has 23 stolen bases on the season, which now places him fourth on the club. Romo's 23 stolen bases are the most ever by a Grizzine scatcher and sec ond all-time on the Fresno catcher leaderboard. The only player ahead of Romo is Roland LeBlanc, who stole 29 bases in 1955 for the Fresno Cardinals (California League). LeBlanc was converted from an outfielder to a catcher after gaining weight when he returned home from war. During the 1942 season, LeBlanc and the teams catcher Frank Zera joined the Marine Corps. LeBlanc verse ap lick with the Flying Tigers and flew the infamous Himalayan route known as "the hump." Zera was killed in the battle of Okinawa as he stood alongside General Simon Bolivar Buckner, who was the highest ranking American officer ever killed in a war. When LeBlanc returned from the War, he had gained a lot of weight. So much that the Cardinals decided his days in the outfield were over and converted him to catcher for the 1947 season at Omaha. From 1950-1957, LeBlanc made a couple stints with the Fresno Cardinals, spending time as both a player and manager.
