The Final Countdown (of the first half)

The Fightin Phils finish the final week of the first half with game five of a five-game series at the New Hampshire Fisher Cats on Sunday afternoon. It is the fifth-of-17 matchups between the teams this season, and fifth-of-11 at New Hampshire. Reading goes back to New Hampshire from July 23-28, and the Fisher Cats come to Reading from Aug. 13-18. New Hampshire won the 2023 season series over Reading 17-7, and this season's series is tied at two.

Extra Extra Read All About It!

The Fightin Phils picked up a 4-3 win in 11 innings on Saturday night over the New Hampshire Fisher Cats. It was Reading;s second win in a row and tied this week's series at two games a piece. Baron Radcliff had two hits and two RBI, which included a home run in the fifth inning and a go-ahead single in the 11th. Ethan Wilson had two hits and also stole a season-high two bases. Max Castillo started and went three innings, allowing one run on three hits, with one strike-outs! Efrain Contreras was strong out of the bullpen, allowing one run on three hits over four innings, with six strikeouts. Cristian Hernandez went two-shutout frames, then Carlos Francisco earned the win with two innings and allowed just one-unearned run in the 11th.

Taylor Torments New Hampshire

Carson Taylor turned in another impressive game on Friday night in what has been a career-year for him. He set a new season-high with four hits, and also tied a career-high with that mark. The only other time Taylor had four hits in a game was June 22, 2021, when he was with Great Lake in the Dodgers' organization. It was also the second four-hit game for a Fightin Phil this season, as Marcus Lee Sang had four hits on June 8, against Harrisburg. Taylor currently ranks fifth in the Eastern League with his .296 average and leads all active Eastern League players with 48 RBI. This week, Taylor is slashing .357/.400/.429, with a .829 OPS.

Marcus Mashing

Marcus Lee Sang continued his red-hot stretch with three hits, one run, three RBI and a home run on Friday night. Lee Sang's ninth home run tied him with Carson Taylor for the team lead. So far in June, Lee Sang is slashing .313/.382/.537, with a .919 OPS. He's added 15 runs, four doubles, one triple, three home runs and 12 RBI. Lee Sang;s season started slowly, as he hit just .197 in April. Since May 1, Lee Sang is hitting .315, with an .841 OPS.

Bombs Away

After hitting another home run last night, Reading has set a season-high with home run in eight games in a row. This comes after also hitting home runs in seven-straight games from June 4-11. The only game since June 4 Reading has not hit a home run in was June 12, so they have homered in 15-of-16 games. The Fightin Phils now sit second in the Eastern League at 68 home runs on the season, trailing first-place Somerset by four long balls. Since starting this run on June 4, Reading has hit the second-most home runs in the Eastern League at 24, trailing only Binghamton, who has 25.

Old Cats

Trevor Schwecke has had a strong week at the plate for the Fightin Phils. This week, has three doubles, one home run and three RBI. He's appeared in five games since being transferred back to Reading from Triple-A Lehigh Valley on June 15, and had hits in the first four contests. Two of those have been multi-hit games. Schwecke is quite familiar with Delta Dental Stadium as he played parts of 2022 (39 games) and '23 (71 games) with the Fisher Cats. The Phillies selected Schwecke in the Minor League Phase of the Rule Five Draft from Toronto this past offseason. Additionally, first year coach, and acting manager, Karl Ellison is a former Fisher Cat. Ellison played part of 2022 (nine games) and '23 (11 games) with New Hampshire. After signing with the Phillies prior to the 2022 season, Ellison was traded to Toronto on Aug. 31, 2022. Following 2023, he retired from playing and is now the R-Phils Development Coach.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 23, 2012: At Bowie, the Phillies sweep a double-header from the Baysox, 3-1 and 4-2. In the opener, Jonathan Pettibone tosses the second and final complete game (7.0 IP, 3 H, 2 BB, ER, 7 K) of the season for Reading. Justin Friend saves his 13th game in 13 chances to nail down the nightcap.

Scouting the Fisher Cats

New Hampshire enters tonight tied for fifth place place, with Reading, in the Eastern League's Northeast Divison with a 30-37 record. New Hampshire most recently dropped four-of-six at home against the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Following this week, New Hampshire heads to Hartford to take on the Yard Goats. New Hampshire's roster features five players ranked amongst the Toronto Blue Jays' top-30 prospects: Adam Macko (9), Josh Kasevich (11), CJ Van Eyk (17), Alex De Jesus (23) and TJ Brock (29).

On the Mound for New Hampshire

Righty Michael Dominguez makes the start today for New Hampshire. This season, Domnguez is 2-2, with a 4.13 ERA over 13 starts. He last pitched June 16 against Richmond and took the loss, allowing one run over five innings, with six strikeouts. Dominguez split 2023 between High-A Vancouver and New Hampshire, combining to go 8-3, with a 3.87 ERA over 23 starts. The 23-year old was selected by the Toronto Bllue Jays in the 15th round of the 2019 draft out of Jefferson High School in Tampa, Florida.
