NOTES AND NUGGETS

VICTORY FIELD SCREECH

Omaha has won a pair of games this week at Victory Field, a stadium where Omaha has played exceptionally recently.

- Going back to 2023, the Storm Chasers have won 16 of their last 19 games at Victory Field, the most wins Omaha has at any opposing venue in the last 3 years.
- In 2023, Omaha won all 8 games it played in Indy, sweeping a 3-game series March 31 to April 2, then winning all 5 from June 6 to 10 ... in 2024, the Chasers lost to the Indians on May 27, before winning 6 straight between May 29 and June 2.
- Since 2021, Omaha has won 21 of 31 games in Indianapolis ... the Storm Chasers have won 3 of 5 prior series at Victory Field since joining the IL, with 1 series split.
- Since 2021, Omaha's 4.06 ERA (117 ER in 259.1 IP) is the club's best among the 7 ballparks where the Chasers have played 20+ games over the last 5 seasons ... that ERA ranks 12th among IL teams with 20+ games in a road venue (119 total).

WHAT A RELIEF

Omaha's bullpen has been one of the best at the Triple-A level this month and the relievers recently combined to not allow a run in a span of 10.1 innings.

- Over 23 games in the month of June, Omaha's bullpen has a 3.42 ERA (38 ER in 100.0 IP) that ranks as the BEST at the Triple-A level this month ... the relievers have a 2.62 strikeout-to-walk ratio that also ranks 2nd at the Triple-A level in June.
- Omaha's bullpen has 19 scoreless efforts this year, or once in every 4.1 games ... 10 of 19 scoreless games from the relievers have been 4.0 innings or more.
- 10.1 scoreless innings from the bullpen is the 4th-longest stretch of scoreless relief this year ... Chasers relievers combined for a season-high 18.0 scoreless innings, from the 8th inning on June 10 through the 6th inning on June 17.
- 2 members of Omaha's bullpen have not yet allowed an earned run in June ... RHP **Ryan Hendrix** (8.0 IP) and LHP **Evan Sisk** (6.0 IP) ... additionally, RHP **Andrew Hoffmann** has a 1.29 ERA (1 ER in 7.0 IP) in June.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

- Omaha has successfully stolen 110 bases this year, and only been caught 18 times ... 110 steals rank 4th in the International League and 5th in Triple-A.
- 110-for-128 in steal attempts is a 85.9% success rate, the BEST stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 3rd-best among the 120 full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 88.4%, 61-for-69).

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits near the top of the Triple-A level in strikeouts, with 741 strikeouts this season ... that is the 2nd-most of any Triple-A club and ranks 7th in Minor League Baseball (1st: Rancho Cucamonga Quakes, 786).

- Over 674.2 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 9.88 K/9, which ranks 3rd both in the International League and at the Triple-A level.
- With 741 strikeouts through 78 games, an average of 9.50 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,415 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

ALL QUIET ON THE OMAHA FRONT

Between June 10 and 15 in Toledo, Omaha led for 42 of 50 innings ... since June 17, the Storm Chasers have led for just 11 of 91 innings, with 9 of those innings coming Thursday night.

- Over 10 games, from June 17 to 27, Omaha trailed for 71 of 91 innings (78%) ... that's nearly as many trailing innings as when Omaha trailed 25 games from May 20 to June 15, where the Storm Chasers trailed for 73 of 214 innings played (34%).
- Omaha was outscored by Durham last week 49-23, a -26 run differential ... prior to the series with the Bulls, the Chasers' biggest negative run differential in a series was -14, when Norfolk outscored Omaha 44-30 April 15 to 20.

LET IT GO, LET IT GO ... CAN'T HOLD IT BACK ANYMORE

Tuesday marked the beginning of the 2nd half in the 2025 International League season, with records for all teams re-setting at 0-0 ... the winner of the IL's 2nd half will play a best-of-3 league championship series against the Jumbo Shrimp.

- 33 of Omaha's 74 games (45%) in the 1st half were against teams with a winning record, and the Storm Chasers went 12-21 (.363) in such contests ... 42 of 74 games (54%) were at home, and Omaha went 17-25 (.404) at Werner Park.
- 36 of Omaha's 75 games in the 2nd half are against teams with winning records in the 1st half ... in the 2nd half, Omaha plays 33 of 75 games (44%) at Werner Park ... the Chasers make 2 trips to Indianapolis and Columbus, 12 games in each city, while playing 9 games in Des Moines, plus a 9-game trip to Buffalo and Syracuse out of the All-Star Break.

TODAY'S START

- Gant is making his **7th start with Omaha** this season ... in May, the Royals purchased his contract from the independent Atlantic League's Long Island Ducks, where he began the season.
- Playing his **13th professional season this year** ... Royals are Gant's 5th MLB organization, has previously spent time with the Mets, Braves, Cardinals and Twins, as well as in Japan and Indy Ball ... has appeared in 173 Major League games from 2016 to 2021, debuting with Atlanta but pitching for St. Louis and Minnesota too.
- Originally drafted by the New York Mets out of high school in 2011, was traded twice over the span of 17 months to the Braves and then Cardinals ... has spent more time with the Cardinals than any other franchise.
- Prior to signing with Omaha in May, Gant last pitched in the Minor Leagues on June 15, 2018, making a quality start for the Memphis Redbirds on the road against the Albuquerque Isotopes ... last pitched in the Majors on October 1, 2021 for the Minnesota Twins.

Making his 2nd start of the week, snapped a streak of 3 straight starts of at least 5.0 innings ... allowed a walk and RBI single in the 1st inning ... allowed a single, RBI double and RBI single in the 2nd inning ... 3 singles loaded the bases in the 3rd inning, then a wild pitch and RBI groundout scored 2 more ... did not come out for the 4th inning.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Signed with the Long Island Ducks (independent Atlantic League) in March 2025 ... over 4 starts with the Ducks, pitched to a 1.71 ERA (4 ER in 21.0 IP) with 27 strikeouts, to just 5 walks ... last 2 starts were quality starts.
- On May 17, the Long Island Ducks announced his contract has been purchased by the Royals organization ... joined the Storm Chasers this week for the road trip in Salt Lake City.
- Earned his first win with Omaha and threw a quality start on June 11 @ Toledo, allowed a run on two hits to open his start and retired 11 of his last 12 batters, allowing just the 1 run.

CAREER NOTES

- SINCE 2022
 - Was outrighted off of the Twins' 40-man roster following the 2021 season and elected free agency ... signed with the Hokkaido Nippon-Ham Fighters of Nippon Professional Baseball in Japan on December 10, 2021.
 - Dealt with injuries and did not pitch with the Fighters in 2022, but re-signed a one-year contract extension in November 2022 ... only made 3 appearances for the farm team in 2023, with 11 strikeouts in 9.2 innings.
 - Released by the Japanese team on July 1, 2023 and did not pitch in a professional game again until April 2025 with the Long Island Ducks.

MAJOR LEAGUE CAREER

- After being traded from the Braves to the Mets in the summer of 2015, Made Atlanta's 2016 Opening Day roster, despite never having pitched above Double-A ... threw a scoreless inning in his MLB debut on April 6, 2016 against the Washington Nationals, in the second game of the 2016 season.
- After making his MLB debut in 2016, made just 39 Minor League appearances (36 starts) between 2016 and 2018 ... exclusively pitched in the big leagues from June 2018 through the end of the 2021 season (139 games).
- Led all MLB relief pitchers with 11 wins in 2019 ... was the most wins by a relief pitcher in the National League since Tyler Clippard had 11 for the Nationals in 2010.
- A starting pitcher coming up through the Minors, opened the 2019 season in the Cardinals' bullpen and made 81 consecutive relief appearances between 2019 and 2020, before moving back to the rotation to open 2021.
- Has 2 hits in the Major Leagues ... both were home runs and came in a 4-start span, the only pitcher in MLB to hit multiple home runs in the month of August 2018.

- July 30, 2021:** Acquired by the Minnesota Twins with LHP Evan Sisk from the St. Louis Cardinals in exchange for LHP J.A. Happ ... Sisk was traded to Kansas City in January 2023 and has pitched 129 games for Omaha.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
