FIVE-RUN 2ND SPELLS DOOM, CARDS DROP OPENER: The NW Arkanss Naturals scored five unearned runs in the top of the 2nd inning with the help of 3 Springfield errors as the Cardinals dropped game one of six this week 7-4 at Hammons Field. Mike Antico and Noah Mendlinger each had two hits for Springfield, and Edwin Nuñez struck out 5 while allowing 2 runs over 4.0 innings. Steven Matz made his 4th rehab start and surrendered 5 unearned runs in 1.2 innings. The Cardinals drew 7 walks while also striking out 12 Naturals hitters. Springfield has dropped 5 of 7 against NW Arkansas



DPPOSING STARTER: Left-hander **Noah Cameron** makes his 9th start of the season for the Naturals... CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

FIRST HALF PENNANT RACE: With 11 games to play, the Cardinals are in a tight race for the 1st half title with the Arkansas Travelers. Springfield leads the division by just a half game, and the two teams will not square off head-to-head again until the 2nd half. The Cards' last 1st half title came in 2016 when they went 41-29 and won the division by 3.5 games over Tulsa. Springfield won the 2nd half title last season and lost in the Division Series to the Travelers.

IN A FUNK AT HAMMONS: After winning their first 8 games of the season at home, the Cardinals have struggled of late at Hammons Field. The Cards have dropped 13 of their last 18 games at Hammons Field, evening their record at home to 13-13. Home games will play a big role in the first half pennant with their six-game series against the Naturals. The Cards will play playing 4 of their last 6 series away from Hammons Field, the Cardinals begin a stretch of 21 of their next 30 at home heading into the All-Star Break.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats. The Cards have struck out the 2nd-fewest times in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 410 whiffs in 58 games. The only team with fewer strikeouts than Springfield is the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (385 K in 57 games). The Cards are averaging just 7.07 K's per game.

WE HAVE LIFTOFF: While the Cardinals have been piling up base hits, not many recently have gone over the wall. Jacob Buchberger's 3-run blast in the 5th inning on Saturday night snapped a homerless streak for the Cards of 11 straight games. Buchberger's homer was the Cardinals' first since Saturday, May 25 when Mike Antico hit a two-run homer off Orlando Ortiz-Mayr of the Tulsa Drillers at Hammons Field. The Cards, however, have not homered in back-to-back games and Springfield has just one homer over its last 14 games and 2 HR over the last 17 games.

MOUND TURNAROUND: While the 2024 season has been up and down for the Cardinals pitching staff, Springfield is on a good run of late. Over their last 15 games the Cards have a team ERA of 2.99, 2nd in the Texas League during that time. During their 12-game road trip, Springfield had an ERA of 2.67. The Cards, however, have a 5.65 ERA this season at home.

FUR STARTERS: Over their last 13 games, the Cardinal starting staff gave the club a chance to win every time out. Since last Tuesday, Springfield starters are 4-1 with a 2.38 ERA (17 ER in 64.1 IP), and only once has a Cards starter allowed more than 2 ER (**Tink Hence** at Wichita, 4 ER). Cardinal starters are averaging 5.0 IP during that stretch, and if **Edwin Nuñez** and **Hence's** start last Wednesday (injury) and rehabber Steven Matz's starts are taken out of the equation, that number raises to 6.2 IP per start.

BIRDS MINIMIZING BIG INNINGS, LONGBALL: For a period of time this season, home runs and the big inning hurt the Cardinals, but Springfield has done well to minimize both of late. Springfield has surrendered 37 innings in which the opponent has scored 3 or more runs, but has allowed just two such innings in their last 12 games. In those 37 innings, the Cardinals have allowed 145 of the 291 total runs scored by the opposition, 49.8% of the runs the Birds have allowed this season. In the other 458.1 IP Springfield has allowed 142 runs, which comes out to 2.79 runs per 9 innings. The Cardinals are 24-6 in games in which they have not allowed a "big inning".

The Cardinals have allowed a league-high 62 HR in 58 games this season, but just 3 over their last 7 games and 7 over their last 13.

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 213.

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 30 straight games without a home run.


