First pitch at Dell Diamond is scheduled for 7:15 p.m.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT

The E-Train dropped the season opener by a final score of 4-2 on Friday night at Dell Diamond. Sugar Land took an early 2-0 lead when CF Joey Loperfido hit a two-run home run in the top of the first inning and scored RF Quincy Hamilton, who had reached on a leadoff walk. The Space Cowboys plated another run in the second inning when C Cesar Salazar scored on Hamilton's RBI double to make it 3-0. 2B Jesus Bastidas scored the fourth and final Sugar Land run of the night on Lopertido's RBI flyout in the top of the fifth. Round Rock's offense got the bats going in the bottom of the ninth, plating two runs when RF Sandro Fabian doubled home 3B Davis Wendzel and DH Matt Duffy 2B Justin Foscue came to the plate as the go-ahead run with two outs but lined out to end the game. Round Rock starter RHP Owen White (0-1, 9.00) got the loss after his 4.0-inning outing saw four earned runs, four hits and six strikeouts. The win went to Sugar Land RHP Logan VanWey (1-0, 0.00), who threw 1.2 shutout innings in relief.

MICHAEL'S MOUND

Express RHP Michael Lorenzen is set to take the mound on Saturday night in a Major League rehab assignment. He signed with the Texas Rangers on March 22 and did not appear in a single Spring Training game. The nine-year MLB veteran holds a career record of 40-38 with a 4.11 ERA in 342 games (69 starts) for four teams: Cincinnati Reds (2015-21), Los Angeles Angels (2022), Detroit Tigers (2023) and Philadelphia Phillies (2023). Last season in 29 games (25 starts) between Detroit and Philadelphia, the 32-year-old recorded a 9-9 record with a 4.18 ERA. The 2023 season saw Lorenzen strike out 111 hitters in 153.0 innings pitched.

NEW FACES IN NEW PLACES

Express DH Matt Duffy, CF Derek Hill, LHP Chasen Shreve and LHP Blake Taylor all saw their first action in a Round Rock uniform on Friday. Duffy went 1-for-3 with a double, a walk and a run scored, while Hill went 0-3 and was hit by a pitch. Shreve and Taylor each threw one shutout inning in relief.

FRIDAY NIGHT FANS

Friday night's season opener saw 10,193 fans pack Dell Diamond. The Express recorded the night's highest attendance in the Pacific Coast League and played in front of over 6,000 more fans than the Oakland A's did on Friday, as the Coliseum hosted 3,837 fans.

SHUTDOWN 'PEN

Express RHP Grant Anderson, RHP Cole Winn, LHP Chasen Shreve and LHP Blake Taylor combined for five innings of shutout baseball in relief of starter RHP Owen White. The four relievers only allowed four hits across their five frames.

START A NEW STREAK

The Express were riding a 10-game winning streak against the Space Cowboys dating back to July 6, 2023 before Friday night's loss. Round Rock will look to start a new winning streak over Sugar Land on Saturday night.

Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win

campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.

Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
