## RIDERS SHUTOUT IN LOSS TO SNAP FOUR-GAME WINNING STREAK

The Frisco RoughRiders were held to four hits in a 2-0 loss to the Corpus Christi Hooks on Saturday at Whataburger Field, the third shutout of the week and the first by the Hooks. Frisco $(22-16,53-53)$ has still not allowed more than two runs in any game this week. Now at 4-1 on the series, Frisco still has a chance to win five games in a series for the first time this year. The Riders did not allow a walk on Saturday to the Hooks (20-18, 53-54). Seth Nordlin (1-4) allowed two runs over five innings with six strikeouts, suffering the loss. Aaron Brown (5-1) garnered the win, pitching the final four innings with one hit allowed. Robby Ahlstrom struck out a pair in a scoreless sixth inning and Grant Wolfram pitched the final two innings with four strikeouts, one hit allowed and no runs. Corpus Christi put two runs on the board in the second inning and did not score the rest of the way. With four scoreless innings from the bullpen, Frisco's relievers have now covered 19.2 innings this week with one run allowed and five hits. Frisco has allowed just five runs over the first five games of the series and has a league-best batting average against of . 143 this week. Frainyer Chavez and Scott Kapers both had doubles for Frisco and Evan Carter recorded a hit and a walk. However, the Riders were unable to come up with a hit with runners in scoring position. Frisco went 0 -for-6 in those situations on Saturday and 0 -for- 7 the day before. Frisco snapped a four-game winning streak, which was tied for the longest streak of the year. Frisco has still won seven of the last 10 games and has not lost back-to-back games since July 16th. Friso has won three of the last four series, including this week in Corpus Christi.

## NEW MONTH, NEW ME:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the mound this season, but in the month of August, they have been fantastic. In the 11 games in August, (7-4 record) the RoughRiders lead the Texas League with a 2.12 ERA while allowing a league-low five home runs and . 169 BAA. The August ERA is the second-lowest in MiLB while the .169 BAA is the second-lowest in the minors. The bullpen has allowed just six earned runs over 54.1 innings, a 0.99 ERA with 77 strikeouts to 14 walks. Ryan Garcia was brilliant on Tuesday, allowing just two base runners on walks over six no-hit innings with six strikeouts. Nick Krauth then followed up with a second quality start on Wednesday, giving the RoughRiders their first back-to-back quality starts since May 31st and June 1st when Owen White and Jack Leiter completed the feat.

## THE ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on the road this season. In the second half, Frisco is a league-best 12-8 on the road and they are tied with San Antonio for the best road record overall in the Texas League at 30-26. Away from Riders Field, Frisco is averaging a league-best 5.7 runs per game and they have a league-high 103 doubles on the road as well.

## HAUV YOURSELF A YEAR:

Trevor Hauver has been fantastic recently for the RoughRiders on the offensive side. On June 16th, he was hitting
.218/.337/.368/.705, but in the 40 games since, he is batting $.309 / .425 / .517 / .942$ with 11 doubles, six home runs, 26 RBIs and 31 walks. In those games, he has raised his average 42 points and his OPS 111 points.

## CARTER WALKS SO THE ROUGHRIDERS CAN RUN:

Evan Carter has been fantastic at drawing walks and getting on base this season. Carter's 63 walks are second in the Texas League despite only playing in 77 percent of the RoughRiders games this year. His 15.8 percent walk rate this year is fourth-highest in the league as well. He has walked 13 times in his last 13 games. His . 405 OBP on the season is 11 th in all of Double-A and among all 13 players in Double-A with a .400 OBP or better, Carter is the youngest at 20 years old.

## HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 22 games, Hicks is batting .338 ( 26 -for77)/.433/.468/.901 with five doubles, a home run, 13 RBIs, 13 walks and 12 runs scored.

K'S BY KELLY:
RoughRiders reliever Antoine Kelly has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He has not allowed an earned run over his last 20 outings. During that stretch, he has 25 strikeouts to three walks over 21.2 innings while recording four saves. He has converted on all eight save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

## ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with Evan Carter hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (Liam Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese (3) and Evan Carter). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

## ROUGHRIDERS STARTING PITCHER

 striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games ( 13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batter while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went $20-2$ with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history
-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011
-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.
-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

## 2023 SEASON

In his Double-A debut on April llth at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying career-best five innings.
-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on $5 / 10$ during a day game
Went a career-high seven innings at Corpus Christi, finishing with just 83 pitches.

## 2022 SEASON

Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries
His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and nex season, I will be able to fortify the house."
-Averaged $11.8 \mathrm{~K} / 9$ over his 14 games ( 13 starts).

## 2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

## 2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.
-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology
