Today's Game

The Reading Fightin Phils remain home and continue a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. It is the 2nd and 3rd-of-six matchups this season between the teams, with all 6 meetings coming at FirstEnergy Stadium. Erie traveled to Reading from Sept. 3-8, last season, and after Reading won the first two games, the SeaWolves won the last four contests. The Fightin Phils haven't traveled to Erie since July 26-21, of the 2022 season.

Game 44 Recap

The Fightin Phils rode five arms to a 1-0 win over Erie on Tuesday morning. All the offense Reading needed were doubles from Keaton Anthony and Leandro Pineda in the second inning. Wil Crowe started and bounced back in a big way, as he went three-hitless and scoreless inning, allowing one walks and striking out three. Mitch Neunborn followed with three-efficient frames, earning the win as he allowed no runs on one hit, while throwing just 23 pitches. After Neunborn, Andrew Walling, Nelson Alvarez and John McMillon all pitched scoreless innings of relief, with McMillon earning his first save in a Reading uniform.

Pitching Powers

Tuesday was Reading's first shutout win of the season, with the Fightin Phils last shutout coming on Sept. 14, 2024, at Harrisburg, on the penultimate day of the regular season. The R-Phils tied a season-low in hits allowed, with two, and the last instance was Apr. 9 at Somerset. Additionally, Reading has not allowed a run since the fifth inning of Sunday's game at Portland, and is currently riding a season-high 13 inning shutout streak. The excellent pitching on Tuesday led to the shortest game of the 2025 season, being played in just two hours and four minutes.

Relievers Rolling

The Fightin Phils bullpen was a big reason for Sunday's comeback and Tuesday's win. Counting Wil Crowe as a reliever, the bullpen has combined to go: 13.0 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 1 BB, 9 SO, over their last two games.

Putting the Fight in Fightins

Reading's come from behind win on Sunday marked the third time this season that the Fightin Phils won a game when trailing entering the ninth inning. The other two instances were April 8 and 13 at Somerset. This all comes after Reading won just once in 2024 when trailing entering the ninth inning.

Anthony Keeps Rolling

Keaton Anthony slugged his league-leading 17th double of the season on Tuesday, and scored the only run for the Fightin Phils in the 1-0 win. Entering play today, Anthony holds the following Eastern League ranks: 2nd AVG (.321), 8th OBP (.384), 7th SLG (.507), 6th OPS (.891), T-8th hits (43), T-1st 2B (17) and T-3rd in XBH (20). Anthony has been red-hot in the month of May, slashing .381/.451/.619 (1.070 OPS) over 18 games, along with 10 runs, 10 doubles, one triple, one home run and eight RBI.

Pineda's May

After a slow start to the season that saw Leandro Pineda hit just .104 in April, he has been red-hot in May. Over 22 games this month, Pineda is slashing .323/.380/.492 (.872 OPS), with 10 runs, eight doubles, one home run and five RBI. Pineda holds the following Eastern League ranks for the month of May: 7th AVG (.323), 10th OBP (.380), 10th OPS (.872) and T-3rd 2B (8).

New Crowe in the Nest

Wil Crowe was dominant in his first start with Reading on Tuesday. Crowe was signed by the Phillies and assigned to Reading last Tuesday, May 20. He struggled in his Reading debut on May 22, as he took the loss, allowing four runs (two earned) over one inning, with four walks issued. Crowe had not pitched in 2025 after spending all of 2024 with the Kia Tigers of the KBO. With Kia, Crowe went 5-1, with a 3.57 ERA over eight innings. Crowe pitched in the big leagues for the Pirates in 2021-23. He made 25 starts in 2021 with the Pirates and appeared in 60 games for them in 2022.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 29, 2011: At Erie, Michael Spidale homers in the 3rd inning to give him 440 career hits as a Reading Phillie, surpassing Aaron Royster as the team's all-time hits leader. He finishes the game 3-for-5 with 3 RBI but the SeaWolves win the game, 6-5, in 10 innings.

From One Corner of the State to the Other

Erie enters second to Akron for first place in the Southwest Division, and for the best record in the Eastern League. The SeaWolves took five-of-six from Hartford at home last week, winning the first five and losing on Sunday. After this week, Erie returns home and welcomes Richmond. Erie's roster features 10 of the Tigers' top-30 prospects: Tayron Liranzo (5), Jaden Hamm (7), Jake Miller (15), Joseph Montalvo (17), Roberto Campos (20), Max Anderson (21), Justice Bigbie (25), RJ Petit (28) and Yosber Sanchez (30).

SeaWolves Pitcher

Righties Joseph Montalvo and Troy Melton make the start today for Erie. Montalvo is 3-2, with a 5.18 ERA over nine games and eight starts this season. The 23-year old was a 20th round pick of the Rangers in the 2021 draft and traded to the Tigers last summer for Andrew Chafin. Troy Melton is 1-1, with a 3.55 ERA over nine starts this season, and has struck out 40 across 33 innings. He went 7-8, with a 5.10 ERA over 23 starts with Erie last season. The 24-year old was a fourth round pick by the Tigers in 2022 out of San Diego State.

King turned in one of the best starts of the season, and his career, last week at Portland. He went a season and career-high six innings, along with a career-best 88 pitches. He surrendered a run in the first and third, and posted zeroes in four-of-six innings he pitched in. The run he allowed in the third inning was unearned due to a fielding error from Trent Farquhar to start the game. So, after allowing the one-earned run in the first he did not allow an earned run over his final five innings of work. King was relieved by Wil Crowe in the bottom of the seventh inning.
