DAILY SPECIALS

RAFE RAKES: Rafe Perich entered the series at Greenville two weeks ago at Greenville with a batting average of .196. Perich did not have a HR and only recorded 1 RBI through his first 13 games of the season. In the last two weeks, Perich has blasted four HRs and driven in 16 runs. Perich's batting average has jumped to .277 on the season. The Lehigh product has scored 12 runs for Hub City in this stretch.

A SUNDAY TO FORGET: After taking a share of the series on Saturday against Wilmington, Hub City's pitching could not limit the home run on Sunday. For the second straight day, the Blue Rocks homered in the first inning. Wilmington would go on to hit 5 HRs, including three solo shots. Seven of the nine Wilmington runs came off the long ball.

DISLA + PENCE: Arturo Disla and Dalton Pence both received Rangers Minor League Awards for the month of April. Disla was dubbed Player of the Month for the Rangers and Pence earned Starting Pitcher of the Month honors. In the month of April, Disla hit .372 with 5 HRs, 7 doubles and 19 RBIs. Disla led the Spartanburgers in all of those categories and ranked top-five in the South Atlantic League in AVG, DBP, SLG, and OPS. Pence went 0-1 but had a 3.10 ERA over four starts in the month of April. Pence struck out 25 and only walked 2 in the month. Opponents hit just .187 against the southpaw who punched out 25 batters, top ten in the SAL.

FIRST VISIT TO THE TOURISTS: The Spartanburgers have not faced Asheville yet this season. In 2025, Hub City played two series against the Tourists and won both 4-2. The Spartanburgers went to Asheville at the end of August, holding the Tourists to just 2 runs per game in the four wins that week.

BOUNCE BACK BURGERS: After a season worst four-game skid for the 'Burgers, Hub City bounced back to win the final four games of the series at Greenville. The Spartanburgers matched their longest win-streak of the season with the finish to last week's series.

The Hub City Spartanburgers, High-A affiliate of the Texas Rangers, were first announced in 2023. Diamond Baseball Holdings purchased the

Down East Wood Ducks, the Single-A Rangers affiliate at the time, and announced they would move the team to a new ballpark in Spartanburg, SC for the 2025 season. In May 2024, the team was announced with the name of "Hub City Spartanburgers". Two months later, MiLB decided that the Spartanburgers would be a member of the High-A South Atlantic League and the Hickory Crawdads would move down to Single-A. Tyson Jeffers was announced in October 2023 as the team's first general manager. The Spartanburgers play in the south division of the South Atlantic League. Chad Comer served as the first manager in Spartanburg's history, leading Hub City to a SAL South Division Championship in 2025. The Spartanburgers lost in the SAL Championship to the Brooklyn Cyclones, finishing the year 67-68.

Fifth Third Park is the crown jewel of downtown Spartanburg. With Fifth Third Bank serving as the naming rights sponsor, the brand-new ballpark seats over 5,000 people.



The Johnson Group provided oversight on the project while Overland Partners served as the architect and Robins & Morton as the general contractor. The ballpark is a part of a \$425 million development in downtown Spartanburg, S.C. Groundbreaking took place with a ceremony on November 1, 2023. The ballpark officially opened for baseball on April 1, 2025 when Wofford College defeated USC Upstate 5-2 in the ballpark's first game. The next night, the Spartanburgers hosted the Hickory Crawdads for a preseason exhibition. The first official Spartanburgers game was a 5-3 win over Bowling Green on April 15, 2025. Cole Swindell headlined the first concert in June 2025. Fifth Third Park hosted a record 4,798 fans in 2025 on the 4th of July for a Spartanburgers game and the Red, White & Boom celebration.



Carlos Maldonado - Manager

Maldonado begins his 11th year coaching in the Rangers organization and first with Hub City in 2026. He joins Hub City after spending three years as the Single-A manager and three years managing in the ACL and DSL. In 2023, he led Down East to a championship appearance. Maldonado was born in Maracaibo, Venezuela and signed as a free agent with the Mariners at age 17 in 1995. After time in the Mariners, Astros, White Sox and Pirates orgs, the catcher made his MLB debut with Pittsburgh in 2006. He played in 21 MLB games for the Pirates in 2006 & 2007 and 8 games for the Nationals in 2010 & 2012.



Mason Milkey - Pitching Coach

Milkey begins his 4th year coaching in the Rangers organization and first with Hub City in 2026. Milkey served as the pitching coach for the Arizona Complex League Rangers in 2024 & 2025 after spending his first year in the organization as a pitching coach in the Dominican Summer League. Milkey spent this past offseason as a pitching coach for the Caimanes de Barranquilla in the Columbian Professional Baseball League. Milkey was born in Edmonds, Washington and played collegiately for Whitman College.



Brian Pozos - Hitting Coach

Pozos begins his 5th year coaching in the Rangers organization and first with Hub City. Pozos served as the hitting coach in Single-A for the past three seasons and spent one year in the ACL in 2022. Pozos was a member of the 2023 Down East coaching staff that reached to the Carolina League Championship Series. Pozos was born in Burbank, California. The former infielder spent his first three collegiate years playing for the University of Portland before transferring to Chico State for his final two seasons.



Jorge Cortes - Development Coach

Cortes begins his 3rd year in the Rangers organization and first with Hub City after 7 years coaching in the D-Backs org. Cortes played 10 seasons in the minor leagues and played in the 2004 Futures Game representing the Altoona Curve. The former outfielder was born in Barranquilla, Colombia. He served as Colombia's hitting coach in the 2023 World Baseball Classic.



Landon Lassiter - Development Coach

Lassiter joins the Rangers organization this year after three years in the Orioles org. He previously worked as a scout for the Rays and started his coaching career as an assistant at Boston College. Lassiter was born in Thomasville, North Carolina and played collegiately for North Carolina. He was drafted in 2015 by the White Sox and played three years in their system.
