TODAY'S GAME

The Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Houston Astros Affiliate) and Round Rock Express wrap up the six game series this afternoon at Dell Diamond. Sugar Land secured the series with a 3-1 victory in last night's game. Sugar Land struck first with a solo home run from 1B Trenton Brooks before SS Keyber Rodriguez responded with a solo shot of his own to tie the game at one. The Space Cowboys scored a run in the seventh and eighth inning to take a 3-1 lead. Round Rock was retired in order in the eighth and ninth, as they drop Saturday's contest 3-1.

WHERE WE STAND

Round Rock lost its 4th consecutive game on Saturday night and lost the series to Sugar Land...are now 6-8 against the Space Cowboys and cannot win the season series...are 8-10-3 in series play this season and 2-4-3 in series play at home...own a 4-6 record in their last 10, 8-7 in their last 15 and 12-8 in their last 20 games.

HOME RUN RODRIGUEZ

INF Keyber Rodriguez now leads Round Rock with 11 HR on the season after launching a solo home run in the 6th inning last night... the homer was recorded at 88.8 mph off the bat, which is the 3rd softest home run by an E-Train hitter this season and the 2nd softest at Dell Diamond... the round-tripper was also Rodriguez's second solo homer of the season... both of Round Rock's 2 runs in the past 3 games have come off home runs from the infielder... 3 of his 8 hits this month have been home runs.

CAN'T GET THEM IN

The Express are batting a PCL-low .156 this week with runners in scoring position. Round Rock has driven in just 5 runs with runners in scoring position. Last week at Sutter Health Park against Sacramento, the E-Train were hitting .310 with 33 RBI and 3 HR in the same situation. Entering the series against Sugar Land, the Express owned a .315/.402/.478 slash line with runners in scoring position.

CAM RETURNS

INF Cam Cauley returns to the Express lineup for the first time since June 27 in Tacoma. Cauley was optioned on Thursday by the Rangers. In 27 games he slashed .207/.281/.345/.626 with three doubles, a triple, a homer, an RBI, nine runs scored, five walks and 15 strikeouts. The 23-year-old is still fourth in the PCL in stolen bases (29) despite not appearing in a game in almost two months... his career-high in stolen bases for his career is 38 (2022... Low-A Down East).

STEADY STARTERS

RHP Aidan Curry tossed 5.0 innings of one-run baseball with two hits, one walk and three strikeouts in his Triple-A debut yesterday. Express starting pitchers have the second-lowest ERA (4.24) this month and the best strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.83)... this comes after Round Rock starters held a 6.65 ERA from March-June to start the season.

THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 16, 1974

It did not feature the same level of intrigue as the June 14, 1974 showdown between Nolan Ryan and Luis Tiant, but on this date in 1978, 31-year-old Nolan Ryan was three outs away from a win when the Boston Red Sox stormed back thanks to three consecutive errors in the ninth inning on bunt attempts. The Red Sox won, 4-2, at Anaheim Stadium in front of 37,535 fans. With two on in the ninth, Ryan caught a pop-up on a bunt attempt. He threw back to first to double off Butch Hobson, but the throw got away from Bobby Grich and the Sox took a 3-2 lead. Jerry Remy then put down a sacrifice bunt, and an error on first baseman Don Baylor allowed another run to score to make it 4-2. Ryan earned the loss as he and Tiant both tossed complete games. Ryan walked eight and struck out 13. Tiant won his 200th game as he allowed two earned runs on six hits with two walks and five strikeouts. Lyman Bostock doubled home two runs in the third to give the Angels an early lead, but Jim Rice hit a two-run homer in the fourth to tie the game. Remy waxed poetic about his former teammate, "He doesn't choke. He just never seems to get a lot of runs from the team," Remy said. "When games are close like that something always happens to break it open. And he sometimes gets burned like that. This time everything went our way. That was the craziest inning I've seen in a long time. But that is also as good as I've seen Ryan pitch in three years."

MANAGER KYLE MOORE

The 2026 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kyle Moore's first season with the E-Train. In 2025, Moore served as the bench coach for Triple-A Iowa of the Chicago Cubs organization. He previously served as the skipper in the Baltimore chain with Short-Season Aberdeen (2018), Low-A Delmarva (2019), High-A Aberdeen (2021) and Double-A Bowie (2022-23) - combining for a 321-286 (.529) record over five seasons. The 2019 Delmarva Shorebirds were named the 2019 MiLB Team of the Year, finishing with a 90-48 record, the most wins across all of MiLB that season.

A catcher in his playing days, Moore signed with the Orioles as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He played collegiately at University of Alabama after winning three high school state titles with Edgewood (Ala.) Academy. Moore transitioned to coaching in 2012 as a strength and conditioning coach with Delmarva.

PITCHING COACH DAVE BORKOWSKI

Former MLB pitcher Dave Borkowski (Boar-COW-ski) enters his fourth season on Round Rock's staff and 17th year in coaching. He will serve as the Express' pitching coach in 2026, reprising the role he held from 2023-24 after spending the 2025 campaign as the club's bullpen coach. Borkowski spent five seasons as a minor league instructor in the Los Angeles Dodgers' farm system.

His tenure also includes an 11-year stint as a minor league coach for the Houston Astros. Prior to joining the coaching ranks, Borkowski enjoyed a 15-year professional playing career that saw him post a 13-20 record and 5.87 ERA across seven MLB seasons with the Detroit Tigers (1999-2001), Baltimore Orioles (2004), and Houston (2006-08). He was originally selected by Detroit in the 11th round of the 1995 MLB Draft out of Sterling Heights (Mich.) High School.

BENCH COACH CHASE LAMBIN

Lambin enters his sixth year on the Express staff and will reprise his role as bench coach for the fifth straight year (beg. 2022). The 2026 campaign will mark Lambin's 12th in the Texas organization. He has previous stops as a hitting coach for High-A Down East (2019), Low-A Hickory (2018), Short-A Spokane (2017), and the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers (2016). He first joined the Rangers as a member of the Spokane coaching staff in 2015.

Lambin was selected by the New York Mets in the 34th round of the 2002 June draft out of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette and played in the Mets, Marlins, Nationals, Twins, and Royals organizations. He also has international experience, spending the 2009 season with Chiba Lotte in Japan. The versatile defender appeared at every position except catcher over the course of his career.

BULLPEN COACH JULIO VALDEZ

Valdez enters his seventh year in the organization and first as the Rangers' Triple-A pitching coach after serving in the same role with Double-A Frisco (2025), High-A Hickory (2024), Low-A Down East (2023), Rookie-level ACL Rangers (2022), and DSL Rangers (2020-21). During the canceled 2020 campaign, Valdez worked with pitchers at the Dominican Republic complex and Fall Developmental League in Arizona.

The Florida native played baseball at Alabama State University from 2012-16. He attended Lake Howell (Fla.) High School, where he posted a career 15-4 record and 2.20 ERA, and earned all-conference honors as a junior and senior. Valdez transitioned to an assistant coach role at Alabama State in 2017 before becoming Director of Pitching at the Texas Pitching Institute in El Paso, Texas. He spent two years at TPI before taking the same role at Baseball Rebellion in Durham, N.C., before joining the Rangers.

HITTING COACH MATT LAWSON

Former Rangers farmhand Matt Lawson returns for a fifth straight season as Round Rock's hitting coach. Lawson previously served as an assistant coach, hitting instructor, and recruiting coordinator at his alma mater, Missouri State University, from 2014-21. The Missouri native was selected by the Rangers in the 14th round of the 2007 MLB Draft and played seven professional seasons as an infielder in the Texas (2007-10), Seattle (2010), and Cleveland (2011-13) organizations. With Texas, he was named Short-A Spokane's team MVP as a rookie in 2007 and a league All-Star for High-A Bakersfield (2009) and Double-A Frisco (2010) before he was involved in the 2010 trade that brought Cliff Lee to the Rangers.

He holds a degree in psychology and a graduate degree in sports management.

DEVELOPMENT COACH KAWIKA EMSLEY-PAI

Emsley-Pai enters his sixth year in the Texas organization and returns to the Express as a development coach, this after beginning his Rangers tenure in the same role during the 2021 season. He has also served as Double-A Frisco's bench coach (2025) and was a development coach with Frisco (2023-24) and High-A Hickory (2022). He served as the Centralia (Wash.) College head coach and education advocate from 2019-21. Prior to his stint at Centralia, Emsley-Pai had a three-year stint as an education advocate at a maximum-security juvenile rehabilitation facility.

A former catcher in the minor leagues, Emsley-Pai spent six seasons with the Diamondbacks (2010) and Pirates (2011-15) organizations, topping out at Double-A Altoona in 2014. He was originally selected by Arizona in the 10th round of the 2010 June draft out of Lewis-Clark State College in Lewiston, Idaho after spending his freshman year at the University of Texas in 2008.
