TODAY'S GAME: The Curve are in the midst of their 25th anniversary season, continuing a six-game set with Richmond.

LAST TIME OUT: Sean Sullivan fired five scoreless innings and Jackson Glenn rocked a three-run homer in Altoona's 6-0 win over Richmond on Thursday night at PNG Field. Lolo Sanchez added a double and a homer in the win.

PLAY THE SONG!: With Connor Scott's walk-off walk on August 1 against Richmond, he earned his third career walk-off RBI for Altoona in two seasons with the Curve. **Brock Holt** holds the franchise record for most walk-off RBI's with four across 2011 and 2012. Scott is the first Curve player with two walk-off RBI's in the same season since **Elvis Escobar** in 2017.

THE BIG LEFTY: Lefty Anthony Solometo is the youngest pitcher to reach the Eastern League this season, doing so at 20 years, 6 months and 15 days when he made his debut on June 17 at Somerset. <u>Solometo is the 13th player in franchise history to suit up</u> for the Curve under the age of 21 and slots in as the 5th-youngest player in the team's history between C **Ryan Doumit**, who was 20 years, 4 months, 0 days old when he debuted on August 3, 2001, and LHP **Sean Burnett**, who was 20 years, 6 months, 18 days old when he debuted on April 4, 2003.

Solometo leads all qualified Pirates minor leaguers with a 2.73 ERA and 104 strikeouts this season. He is one of 8 players to play in the EL at age 20 or younger, Harrisburg has two of them: Brady House and James Wood. Jackson Holliday (BOW), Jasson Dominguez (SOM), Yanquél Fernandez (HFD), Blaze Jordan (POR) and Marcelo Mayer (POR) are the other players in the league that are not permitted to drink alcohol.

IT"S OFFICIALLY GEN Z: Infielder Tsung-Che Cheng turned in one of his best stretches of play since joining the Curve during their series at Harrisburg from July 25-30. Cheng knocked his first Double-A homer on Sunday, July 30 and picked up a hit in each game of the series at FNB Field. Since July 19 he has a hit in 12-of-14 games, totaling a .333/.345/.444/.789 OPS line with 3 2B, 1 HR, 3 RBI. Cheng's 10 triples this season are the most in minor league baseball.

JULY 'PEN WORK: In the month of July, Altoona's pitching staff had the 7th-lowest WHIP by a Double-A team with a 1.30 mark, the 19th-best mark by an MiLB team. Several Curve relievers turned in an ERA lower than 2.00: Noe Toribio (0.00 ERA, 0 ER / 11.0 IP), Nick Dombkowski (1.13 ERA, 2 ER / 10.1 IP), and Oliver Garcia (1.23 ERA, 1 ER / 7.1 IP) and Justin Meis (1.88 ERA, 3 ER / 14.1 IP) paced the group.

SMASHYCRAFT: Limited to shorter outings in his return from Tommy John surgery, RHP Braxton Ashcraft turned in his best start with Altoona on Sunday, July 23 against Řeading when he retired all nine batters faced on a tidy 29 pitches, 25 strikes. Ashcraft has a 1.93 ERA (3 ER / 14.0 IP) in six starts with the Curve and features a 2.70 ERA (14 ER / 46.2 IP) this season with Bradenton, Greensboro and Altoona.

EXTRA RUNS: The Curve have allowed the most runs in extra innings this season in the Eastern League, allowing 19 runs in 10 extra innings. Altoona has scored 13 runs of their own and are 5-4 in games that have gone to extras.

STRIKEOUTS ARE ALL THE RAGE: Throughout the 2023 season, Altoona has been one of the league's most-difficult teams to strike out. Entering play on Friday, August 4, Altoona has struck out 770 times, still the fewest among Double-A teams and 3rd-fewest in minor league baseball. Altoona's franchise record for fewest strikeouts in a season is 811 achieved in 2003 when the Curve struck out an average of 5.75 times per game. The 2023 Curve are striking out an average of 8.11 times per game.

THE SQUIRRELS ARE IN FLIGHT: Dennis Pelfrey returns for a second season as Richmond skipper after leading the Flying Squirrels to a First Half Title and a playoff appearance in 2022. The Squirrels roster features several top Giants prospects according to MLB Pipeline including: No. 3 LHP Carson Whisenhunt, No. 5 OF Vaun Brown, No. 10 RHP Landen Roupp, No. 14 RHP Carson Seymour, No. 23 RHP Ryan Murphy, and No. 26 RHP Jose Cruz. Runs Scored 12th (415)

THE FIRST FLYER: John Michael Bertrand makes his first start of the season against Altoona tonight for Richmond. Born in Raleigh, NC, Bertrand greq up in Alpharetta, GA and was San Francisco's 10th round pick in 2022 out of the University of Notre Dame. Bertrand's start tonight will be his fourth with the Flying Squirrels since recording a 2.92 ERA in 11 games, 8 starts at High-A Eugene. Bertrand began his college career at Furman where he pitched for three seasons before finishing at Notre Dame, his father Jim rowed collegiately at the University of San Diego and his brother JD was a linebacker and team captain for Notre Dame's Football team.

CURVE CUTS: Braxton Blake Ashcraft... Signed with the Pirates for a bonus of \$1,825,000... Was committed to play collegiatelly at Baylor... Was a 2018 Rawlings-Perfect Game second-team All-American and a first-team all-region selection in Texas... Was also 2017 Underclass High Honorable Mention... Was ranked as the 58th best prospect in the draft by Baseball America... Attended Robinson HS in Waco, TX... Went 11-1 with 103 strikeouts in 70.1 innings as a senior in 2018 while also hitting .391 with three home runs and 26 RBI...
