CARDS MAKE QUICK WORK OF HOOKS IN SERIES OPENER: It took just an hour and 47 minutes on Tuesday night at Hammons Field as the Cardinals hit three homers in a 5-1 defeat of the Corpus Christi Hooks in the opener of a six-game series. Jimmy Crooks (solo), Mike Antico (2-run) and Jacob Buchberger (solo) each homered for the Birds, who tallied four extra base hits of their six total knocks. Brandon Komar got the win with 3 innings of one-run ball in relief of starter Trent Baker who did not allow a hit over 4.0 shutout innings. The 1:47 game time is the 2nd-fastest 9-inning game in

Springfield history; the Cardinals played a 1:46 game in 2008 at Arkansas.



OPPOSING STARTER: Lefty **Luis Angel Rodriguez** makes his 8th start (13th appearance) of the season for the Hooks...Last start came on on Sunday, July 14 at Tulsa when he surrendered 3 ER on 3 H with a season-high 9 K over 4.2 IP...Did not factor in the decision, a 5-3 Corpus Christi win...Had lost his previous two starts, and is 0-2 with a 10.64 ERA in 3 starts in July...Last 4 apperances have all been starts...Got the win when he breezed through 4.0 scoreless innings in a relief appearance against the Cardinals on June 21 at Whataburger Field allowing just 1 H with 8 K...In June went 1-0 with a 0.73 ERA in 4 appearances (1 start)...Split the 2023 season between Low-A Fayetteville and High-A Asheville going 1-1 with a 2.42 ERA over 16 apperances (8 starts)...Claimed by the Astros off waivers from the Cubs in December 2022... Spent hte 2022 season at Low-A Myrtle Beach with the Cubs going 6-1 with a 4.43 ERA...First reached full-season ball in 2021 with Chicago, making 3 appearances with Myrtle Beach and 1 with Triple-A lowa... Originally signed by the Cubs as an International Free Agent out of Mexico in 2017...24 years old

CARDS HOST HOOKS IN FINAL REGULAR-SEASON MATCHUP: The Cardinals return to Hammons Field for a six-game series and their final regular season matchup with the Corpus Christi Hooks (Double-A, Houston Astros). Springfield won four of six against the Hooks at Whataburger Field in June, including a postseason-clinching win in the series finale on the final day of the first half on June 23.

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

HOME SWEET HOME: After struggling at home for a stretch, the Cardinals have turned things around at Hammons Field of late. Springfield has won 9 of its last 11 games at home, lifting its home record to 23-24 (.489). The recent home hot stretch follows a down period over which the Birds dropped 11 of 12 had saw their home record drop to 14-22, at that point the worst home record in the Texas League.

Away from home, the Birds are 28-16 (.636) away from Hammons Field this season, the best road winning percentage in the Texas League. Springfield's road ERA sits at 3.72 which is good for 3rd-best in the Texas League behind Frisco and Midland. The Cards' ERA at Hammons Field this season is 5.61.

HITS, HITS: The Cardinals have been the top-hitting team in the Texas League for the whole season, but the Birds have been especially base hit-happy of late. Over their last 19 games, the Cardinals are batting .295 and have less than 8 hits in just 3 games during that stretch while reaching double-digits 10 times. For the season, Springfield leads all of Double-A in batting average (.269) and total hits (813) and is tied with the Portland Sea Dogs of the Eastern League for the top OBP at .351.

POWER SURGE: While the Cardinals have hovered near the bottom of the Texas League in home runs this season, the Birds have flexed their power muscles of late. Over its last 17 games since June 30 Springfield has clubbed 19 homers, 2nd in the circuit during that time behind only Midland (24). The Cardinals sport a SLG of .447 and .807 OPS during that time and have homered in 10 of their last 12 games. For the season the Cardinals are tied for 8th in the Texas League with San Antonio with 61 homers.

CROOKS CATCHING FIRE: Over his last 19 games dating back to June 23, Cardinals catcher **Jimmy Crooks** has been swinging one of the hottest bats in the Texas League. The former Oklahoma Sooner is 3rd in the league among qualified hitters with a .358 average while adding 5 HR and 16 RBIs with 3 doubles and a triple. **Crooks** during that stretch is slugging .657 and has a 1.076 OPS. Among active, qualifited Texas League hitters in 2024, **Crooks'** .876 OPS and .408 OBP tops in the circuit.

ANTICO NEARING MILESTONES: Cardinals OF **Mike Antico** is inching toward a pair of career milestones. **Antico's** next steal will give him 150 for his career, and with his 2-run shot on Tuesday is just 3 homers shy of 50 career bombs. Over his last 10 games, **Antico** is batting .351 with 2 HR, 7 RBIs and is 3-for-3 in SB.

SPRINGFIELD'S HOME RUN KING...: With his 3-run homer in the bottom of the 5th inning on Friday night, Chandler Redmond etched his name atop yet another Springfield Cardinal career category. Redmond's 60th home run in a Springfield uniform moved him past Xavier Scruggs (2010-13) on the all-time franchise list, giving him the most homers in franchise history. Redmond's historic blast came off Wichita right-hander John Stankoweicz. For good measure, Redmond added another three-run shot on Saturday night off Cory Lewis, giving him home runs in back-to-back games after not leaving the yard in his past 47 contests.

Redmond also holds the Springfield franchise record for RBIs with 225.

...IS HEATING UP: After breaking the record, Redmond has continued swinging a hot bat. During a current 6-game hitting streak, the Cardinals slugger is 12-for-23 with 2 2B, 2 HR and 8 RBI In 11 games in July, he is batting .395 (15-for-41) with a team-high 1.044 OPS.

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer **Matt Svanson** has been lights-out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. **Svanson** is a perfect 15-for-15 and his 15 saves lead the Texas League and is tied for the most in all of Double-A with Austin Roberts of Pensacola (MIA).

So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer has allowed just one earned run in 11.0 IP (0.82 ERA) and is 5-for-5 in save opportunities.


