## "FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

**SAINTS ADD CHERRY ON TOP TO SERIES WIN IN COLUMBUS SUNDAY:** Already having clinched their first-ever series win at Huntington Park, the St. Paul Saints made it back-to-back wins to take four out of five on Sunday afternoon, a 3-2 come-from-behind victory in 10 innings. Zebby Matthews worked in and out of traffic through light rain over the first couple of innings, before the Clippers struck first in the third, taking a 2-0 lead. Parker Messick was sharp on the mound for the Clippers; the Guardians' No. 13 prospect according to MLB.com retired 14 of the first 17 he faced and fanned nine through the first four. In just his second game of the IL, Will Holland delivered with a two-out, solo homer to left field in the fifth off of Messick to cut the deficit to one. The Saints tied the game in the sixth. Royce Lewis's leadoff single eventually turned into the tying run when Mike Ford pulverized an RBI single off the right field wall for a long RBI single with the bases loaded. Rehabbing Michael Tonkin and Darren McCaughan threw up zeroes over innings 5-9 to take it to extras before Jefferson Morales plated the placed runner with a sac fly and Brady Feigl threw up his fourth scoreless appearance in as many tries to pin down the save.

**SAVE SOME FOR TOMORROW:** The ups and downs of the St. Paul offense have continued in the past couple weeks with the Saints scoring as many as 16 runs in the opener of their last homestand, while also being shutout for the fourth time this season in game one of a doubleheader. The Saints now rank 12th out of 20 International League teams in runs-per-game, averaging 4.5/game entering play on Tuesday. The Saints' low run-scoring rate is despite the team ranking 5th in team batting average (.261) and t-4th in OPS (.770). In their 15 wins, the Saints have scored 91 runs (an average of 6.1/game) while in their 14 losses, they've scored just 31 (2.2/game). One of the Saints inconsistencies in run-scoring has been due to hitting with runners in scoring position. They now rank 7th in the International League with a .279 average (76-272) w/ RISP. In their 15 wins, St. Paul are hitting .343 (60-175) situationally and just .165 (16-97) in their 14 losses.

**BUILT FORD TOUGH:** Mike Ford is coming off a road trip in Columbus in which he went yard three times in five games to help the Saints to their first-ever series victory at Huntington Park. He went 7-for-16 in the series and has now hit safely in seven straight dating back to April 26, a stretch where he is hitting .391 (9-23), 3 HR, 8 RBI, 3 BB. It mark's Ford's longest hit streak since he collected a knock in the first seven games to open the 2023 campaign with Triple-A Tacoma. The longest hit streak of his career was a 12-gamer from July 12-August 18, 2014 with the Charleston RiverDogs in A-ball.

**MCCUSKER MASHING HIS WAY INTO RECORD BOOKS:** Recently named the Twins minor league player of the month for March/April, Saints outfielder Carson McCusker is crushing the ball to open the season and currently ranks t-3rd in Triple-A in average exit velocity to start the year (see below). McCusker has two of the top-5 hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and four of the top-10, including a 114.2 mph single on April 2 in Columbus that ranks t-9th in exit velocity among the hardest-hit balls in Saints history. The 6-8 slugger is one of 23 hitters in the minors with at least 7 homers this year and has the most home runs by a St. Paul batter by the end of April in franchise history (no other batter the past five years for the Saints has had more than four by the close of the month). At the end of April, the Sparks, NV native had already collected 23 RBI, the most in Saints history for March/April (see below), 27 total hits, which tied a Saints record for by the end of April, and accrued a 1.049 OPS & .651 SLG%, both the highest in Saints history by that point in the season (min 40 PA).

**STRAIGHT GAS:** The Saints pitching staff rank as the third-hardest throwing staff in Triple-A to start the season with an average pitch velocity of 89.4 mph that ranks as a [harder throwing staff than 20 Major League teams](#). Despite the extra few ticks, the Saints rank just 10th in the IL in K-rate (24.9%) and 8th in whiff-rate (29.0%). By average velocity on fastballs only, St. Paul ranks t-7th in Triple-A (92.6) and 3rd in the IL. Ryan Jensen (96.8, 16th) and Alex Speas (96.5, 21st) are both top-25 in the Triple-A circuit in [average fastball velo among arms with at least 100 pitches thrown](#).

**FRESH FACES, NEW ENEMIES:** The Buffalo Bisons (TOR) are the first of three teams that are making their first-ever visit to CHS Field this season, with the Norfolk Tide (BAL) and Round Rock Express (TEX) also scheduled to roll through the Pig's Eye this year. While St. Paul have played the Bisons for three prior series in Buffalo before, the Saints are also playing three International League teams for the first time in franchise history (home or road) in 2025: Norfolk (BAL) for a home series late-May, Worcester (BOS) at home in late-July, and Memphis (STL) in a September road series. Also new to Triple-A this year, the Saints will take part in an International League vs Pacific Coast League crossover series as Round Rock (TEX) visits CHS Field for the first-time in August and the Saints will visit Coolray Field for their first road games ever vs Gwinnett (ATL).

**THE STARS OF TOMORROW, TODAY:** The Saints' current roster features eight of Minnesota's Top-30 prospects according to MLB.com and nine according to Baseball America while also touting four of Minnesota's top-10 prospects on the MLB Pipeline list. The Twins prospects in the rankings include OF Emmanuel Rodriguez (No. 2, MLB.com, No. 2 BA), RHP Zebby Matthews (-/4), RHP Marco Raya (6/8), RHP Andrew Morris (9/10), RHP Cory Lewis (11/20), INF Payton Eeles (23/17-currently on 7-day IL), RHP Travis Adams (22/22), C Diego Cartaya (24/21), & C Jair Camargo (-/23). Rodriguez checks in at the No. 19 on the MLB Pipeline's top-100 prospects and No. 37 on Baseball America's Top-100 list.

**TWINS REPORT:** The Minnesota Twins (15-20) took two out of three games in Boston to close their road trip before an off day yesterday. They face the Orioles Tuesday-Thursday and the Giants Friday-Sunday this week at Target Field. Royce Lewis will make his season debut back with the Twins as Pablo Lopez (2-2, 2.25) takes the hill in Tuesday's homestand opener. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (15-12) have lost three straight entering the week as they travel to Northwest Arkansas. High-A Cedar Rapids (17-9) have won 6 of their last 7. Twins No. 14 prospect Billy Amick ranks top-5 in the Midwest League in hitting (.342) and OPS (.922). Low-A Fort Myers are 14-13 to start this season. 22-year-old right-hander Alejandro Hidalgo ranks second in the organization in strikeouts, having fanned 29 of 88 batters faced (33%) despite a 6.00 ERA.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Started Wednesday night in Columbus in game one of a scheduled doubleheader. After allowing a two-run homer on a slider to Johnathan Rodriguez in the opening inning, settled in for an outing of utter dominance. Retired 16 of the last 17 hitters he faced after the homer, including 11 in-a-row to finish his night. Recorded 18 swings-and-misses, tied for the 5th-most in Saints history in the pitch-tracking era (2023-pres) and trailing only the 23 whiffs he induced in a start for the Saints on April 11, 2024 vs Iowa (the Saints record in that span). 11 of his whiffs and 5-of-7 strikeouts came on the changeup on 14 swings, a 79% whiff-rate on the pitch. Overall, threw 17 changeups, 12 four-seamers, 11 sinkers, and 9 sliders.

**LATE-BLOOMER:** A late-adopter to pitching, Festa did not start toeing the slab until his senior year of high school at Seton Hall Prep. He was initially committed as a shortstop to a Division 3 school entering his final prep season, but when his high school ran out of pitchers during a tournament, Festa was handed the ball for the first time and never looked back. He continued to play shortstop for the rest of the year, but also went 4-0 with a 1.50 ERA while striking out 44 over 30 innings on the mound. He chose to walk-on to nearby Seton Hall University as a pitcher instead, getting a good recommendation from his high school head coach Mike Sheppard Jr, who's brother was the head coach of the nearby Big East program. Festa was mostly a fastball-changeup pitcher in college, mixing in an occasional slurve, and credits the Twins development program for helping him develop a slider, which as become his bread-and-butter out pitch, accounting for 65 of his 166 (39%) strikeouts between the Majors and Triple-A last year.

**A PERFORMANCE FOR THE AGES:** In just his ninth professional pitching appearance, Festa was a major part of a no-hitter. On May 10, 2022 with Fort Myers, he threw 6.0 no-hit innings, striking out a career-high 11 batters in a combined no-hitter for the Mighty Mussels. Jaylen Nowlin followed with the 2.0 perfect innings and struck out three. Hunter McMahon tossed 1.0 hitless inning to finish it off, a 3-0 win.

**ONE, TWO, THREE, YOU'RE OUT!** On July 24, 2022 with Single-A Cedar Rapids, Festa allowed three consecutive singles between the third and fourth innings. The final two batters of the third inning reached, as did the first of the fourth. Festa got three outs, but did not retire a batter because promptly picked off each of the three batters, one after the other.

**THE SLIM REAPER IDOLIZING THE deGROMINATOR:** While he's worn the No. 58 jersey for both the Twins and Saints so far in his career, Festa came up through baseball wearing number 48, a tribute to his favorite player growing up, Jacob deGrom. The two-time Cy Young award winner had his most dominant seasons in 2018-19, the summers before Festa's first two years of college ball at Seton Hall University, located about 35 miles West of Citi Field in Flushing.

**你好:** While attending Seton Hall Prep in New Jersey, Festa was a member of the National Chinese Honor Society...The National Chinese Honor Society (NCHS) was established in 1993 to recognize those accomplished high school students who study Chinese as a world language. The National Chinese Honor Society is a scholastic organization that promotes and recognizes students who demonstrate citizenship, leadership, and community service. A member must be a full time high school student (grades 9 – 12) who has studied Chinese for four semesters in high school with an average of B or higher.

**BIGGER, FASTER, STRONGER:** Festa's goal in the offseason leading up to 2024 was to add some muscle, so he can be prepared to go an entire season. He said it's sort of tough for him to do certain exercises given his height and narrowness. Last season he was listed at 185 pounds and came into Spring Training in 2024 10 pounds heavier at 195.
