### Final Road Trip

The Fightin Phils are on the road for their final trip of the 2026 season against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. It is the 21st-of-24 matchups between the teams this season and ninth-of-12 at Dunkin' Park in Hartford. The season-series is tied at 10 and if Reading clinches the second half division title, then it will match up against Hartford in the Eastern League Playoffs, beginning on Tuesday, September 15.

### Big Comeback Win

Four unanswered runs lifted the Reading Fightin Phils to a 5-3 comeback victory over the Hartford Yard Goats on Wednesday night at Dunkin' Park, evening the series at one game apiece. Reading jumped to an early 1-0 lead on a first-inning sacrifice fly from Raider Tello, but Hartford responded with three runs, taking a 3-1 lead in the sixth on an RBI single by Zach Kokoska and a bases-loaded walk to Cole Messina. The Fightins rallied back in the seventh when Bryson Ware hit a two-run homer off reliever Davis Palermo to tie the game at three. Reading completed the comeback in the eighth inning, taking the lead on a Carson DeMartini RBI double before Aaron Escobar singled him home for an insurance run. Relievers Mavis Graves earned the win, Wen-Hui Pan pitched a scoreless eighth, and Estibenzon Jimenez shut the door in the ninth for his seventh save. With the win, Reading maintains a 2.5-game lead over Somerset in the standings with 10 games remaining.

### Magic Number: 8

With 10 games remaining in the 2026 regular season, the Fightin Phils hold a 2.5-game lead for first place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division. Somerset (2.5 GB), Binghamton (3.5 GB) and Portland (5.5 GB) are chasing Reading in the standings. Reading is searching for its first division crown and postseason bid since the 2019 season.

### Binelas Moves Up

The Philadelphia Phillies announced on Tuesday that Alex Binelas was promoted to Lehigh Valley (AAA) after a stellar campaign with the Fightin Phils. Over 116 games, Binelas slashed .267/.382/.509 (.891 OPS), while adding 73 runs, 43 extra-base hits (15 2B, 2 3B, 26 HR) and 72 RBI. His 26 home runs set a new single-season career-high and led the Eastern League at the time of his promotion. Binelas' other Eastern League ranks are the time of his call-up to Triple-A were: 2nd RBI (78), 5th OBP (.382), 5th SLG (.509), 3rd OPS (.891), 10th hits (107), 4th BB (72), T-8th XBH (43), 4th total bases (204) and T-6th runs (73).

### Heredia Keeps Hitting

Entering play on Thursday, Raylin Heredia leads the R-Phils and is second in the Eastern League with 142 base hits this season. Heredia is the first Fightin Phil to surpass 140 hits in a season since Dylan Cozens had 144 base hits in 2016. Heredia also has a league-high 32 doubles on the season, which is tied for the 17th most in a single-season in Fightin Phils history. He is one-of-24 R-Phils to surpass 30 doubles in a season in franchise history.

### Rincon Rakes

Phillies No. 5 Prospect Bryan Rincon's 26-game on-base streak came to an end on Tuesday night. It was his second on-base streak to reach 26 games this season and it ranked as the longest active on-base streak in the Eastern League prior to its end. Over the streak, Rincon slashed .348/.500/.630 (1.130 OPS), along with 23 runs, eight doubles, six home runs and 11 RBI, while walking 26 times to 24 strikeouts. Rincon also has 22 home runs this season, which is tied for fourth in the Eastern League and he has lifted nine leadoff homers this season, which is the most in all of Minor League Baseball.

### Carson Crushing It

Over his last nine games (since Aug. 23), Carson DeMartini is slashing .407/.529/.778 (1.307 OPS), along with eight runs, five doubles, one triple, one home run and seven RBI. Since his return from the Injured List on Aug. 5, DeMartini is hitting .290 (18-62), with nine extra-base hits (6 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR) and 10 RBI, while stealing nine bases. He is currently riding an 19-game on-base streak, which dates back to Aug. 8.

### Best Season in a Bit

The Fightin Phils are currently vying for their first postseason birth since the 2019 season. In 2019, Reading finished with 80 wins and the R-Phils 64 wins so far this season are their most since the '19 season. It is also their best record under manager Al Pedrique, who had a previous high of 59 (2023 and '24) as the Fightin Phils skipper. The Fightin Phils are now eight wins over their win total from 2025 (55).

### This Day in Baseballtown History

September 3, 2015: At Reading, the Fightin Phils beat Binghamton and knuckleballer Mickey Jannis, 2-1, in the last home game of the regular season to clinch the Eastern Division crown. Reading rallies from a 1-0 deficit in the 7th, plating both runs on Harold Garcia's seeing-eye single through the left side of the infield - one of only 3 hits for the home team. Ethan Martin goes 5.0 hitless innings, allowing only one walk while striking out 5, but does not get a decision.

### Hey Hartford

Hartford enters play today with a 62-65 overall record and 23-36 mark in the second half. The Yard Goats won the first half Northeast Division Title with a 39-29 record and would be Reading's playoff opponent if the R-Phils clinch the second-half title. Hartford most recently took four-of-six games at New Hampshire last week and will head to Somerset next week to finish off the regular season. The Yard Goats' roster features four of the Rockies Top-30 prospects: Jackson Cox (8), Jared Thomas (10), Andy Perez (16) and Konner Eaton (18).

### Goats Pitcher

Righty, and Rockies' No. 8 prospect, Jackson Cox makes his eighth Double-A start tonight for Hartford. With the Yard Goats, Cox is 2-2, with a 3.89 ERA (16 ER, 37.0 IP), along with 44 strikeouts. Cox last pitched on July 19 at Chesapeake and tonight will be his first appearance off the 7-day IL. He began the season with Spokane (A+), going 4-1, with a 4.23 ERA over 11 appearances. Cox spent all of 2025 with Fresno (A), going 4-6, with a 3.39 ERA across 23 starts. He did not pitch in 2024 and began his pro career with Fresno in 2023. The 22-year old was drafted by the Rockies in the second round of the 2022 draft out of Toutle Lake High School in Toutle, Washington.
