GOTTA BREAK OUT OF THIS: After dropping both halves of a doubleheader yesterday to open the series with the Shorebirds, the FredNats are currently enduring a season-long six game losing streak and have fallen back to a season-worst four games under .500. With the team's first half hopes dwindling, today they send RHP Alexander Meckley to the mound aiming to get the squad back on track. He faces Shorebird lefty Sebastain Gongora, who faces FXBG for the first time. In this stretch of six losses in a row, the FredNats have scored a league-low 13 runs, the team batting average is .195, and the team OPS is a league-low .526. Fredericksburg is the only team in the Carolina League to not have a home run in that time frame as well. In addition to that, the Fredericksburg team ERA on the mound is 5.81, which is the second highest in the league in that time frame by .01.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The FredNats dropped two one-run contests in both ends of the doubleheader, losing 2-1 in game one and 1-0 in game two. On the day, the FredNat offense combined for just a single run on seven total hits in 14 offensive innings on the day. Travis Sykora pitched three scoreless innings in his first FredNat start of the year, and Luke Dickerson had the day's only RBI. Bryan Polanco pitched five more innings of one-run ball in game two.

BIG PROSPECT NIGHT: Nationals No. 1 prospect Travis Sykora made his 2025 full-season debut after off-season hip surgery last night, firing three scoreless innings with four strikeouts. He allowed one hit and walked two. No. 6 prospect Luke Dickerson made his full-season debut in the twinbill and finished with two doubles (and the lone RBI of the day for FXBG) a walk and a single over the two games. Dickerson, 19, was Washington's 2nd round pick in 2024 out of Morris Knolls HS in New Jersey, and signed for a record \$3.8 million, which is the largest bonus ever for someone drafted outside the first round.

HE'S A SLUGGER: FredNat infielder Jackson Ross is now second in the Carolina League in slugging after his fifth and sixth homers in Wednesday's game, and he continues to be near the top of the league leadeboard in several other categories. Ross is slugging .586 on the season, and his .917 OPS ranks sixth in the league. Ross is also second on the FredNat team with seven doubles on the year, and his 13 extra-base hits is tied for 5th in the league with his teammate Jorgelys Mota.

DON'T EVEN TRY IT: The FredNat catching duo of Kevin Bazzell and Nate Rombach have been prolific at throwing out potential base stealers to start the season. Bazzell is throwing out 39.5% of base runners this year which is first in all of Single-A baseball among qualified catchers, and he ranks third in Single-A and four in all of MiLB with 15 caught stealings. Rombach has 11 caught stealings, which is 7th in the Carolina League and 10th in Single-A. Rombach is throwing out 33% of potential base stealers this year, which is Top-15 in Single-A percentage wise.

LET'S DO THIS AGAIN: The 2024 Carolina League Champion FredNat squad absolutely obliterated the Shorebirds all of last season. In 21 meetings between the two teams last year, Fredericksburg went a staggering 18-3 and outscored Delmarva 120-62. The FredNat pitching staff had a team ERA of 2.58 against the Shorebirds, and struck out a total of 199 Delmarva hitters. In 192 innings pitched against Delmarva, the Shorebirds only had 137 hits compared to Fredericksburg's 164. Fredericksburg also went 44/49 stealing bases against Delmarva last year.

2024 CHAMPIONS: The 2024 Fredericksburg Nationals won the franchise's sixth total Carolina League championship last September, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to capture the crown. It was the franchise's first since moving to Fredericksburg in 2020, and the first since the Potomac Nationals won the Carolina League in 2014. The FredNats broke the Charleston RiverDogs' run of three titles in a row, and became the first non-Charleston team to win the league since MiLB realigned to its current leagues in 2021.

NEW SKIPPER IN TOWN: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. Prior to joining the Nationals, he coached for over a decade in the Boston organization, managing at all four full-season levels and also spending three seasons (2016-18) as the organization's base running and outfield coordinator. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT: Meckley, the Nationals' 12th round pick (350th overall) in the 2024 MLB Draft, was flawless after being called up to Fredericksburg last year. He made five appearances for the FredNats between the regular season and postseason and did not give up a run. In total, he allowed just four hits in 9.1 IP and got a save in his lone opportunity with two shutout innings against LYN on 9/4.

START IT UP: Meckley's five appearances for the FredNats last year during his first year at the professional level were all out of the bullpen, making this his first year as a starter in his professional career.

LAST TIME OUT: Meckley got the loss in his start last week against Lynchburg. He gave up four runs in the first inning and made it through just four innings, allowing six total runs on four hits and two walks.

BACK IN SCHOOL: Meckley made 21 appearances at Coastal Carolina in 2024 with nine starts for the Chanticleers, posting a 7.52 ERA in 52.2 IP with 57 K's. He previously pitched two seasons at WVU Potomac State (NJCAA)...made 20 appearances (17 starts) and led the Catamounts with 73 K's and a 2.96 ERA in 2023

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
