STARTING NINE- NEWS AND NOTES

- Last Time Out: The Great Lakes Loons scored three times in the bottom of the eighth inning on Tuesday to rally past the Chiefs 8-7 at Dow Diamond. **Darlin Saladin** allowed just one hit through three innings in relief before the Loons touched him up for three runs to score a victory.
- First-Half Finish: The Midwest League's first half comes to an end following tonight's game at Great Lakes. Though it necessarily hasn't translated into the win column, the Peoria offense has enjoyed its best start to a season in quite some time. The Chiefs have scored 308 runs in the first half, their most in a season's first half since 2018. Additionally, Peoria's .244 batting average is also their best first-half number since 2018.
- ▼ Tale of Two Weeks: Peoria has played two full series in the month of June. Over the course of their six-gamer against Quad Cities, the Chiefs averaged 6.0 runs/game and hit .303 as a team on the way to a 5-1 record. Last week, the Chiefs struggled against Cedar Rapids. Peoria dropped five of seven games and hit .202 while averaging 2.4 runs/game.
- Table Setter: Lead-off man Jon Jon Gazdar put together a fine stretch against Cedar Rapids last week. Gazdar went 12-for-25 (.480) in the series with four multi-hit performances. Gazdar is hitting .308 on the year and ranks tied for eighth in the Midwest League in hits (62). The 2024 draftee is back at the top of the order on Wednesday.
- Joltin' Josh: Josh Kross provided the thump for the Peoria lineup last night. Kross homered and collected three hits on the night, driving in four runs. Kross has been a run producer since his promotion from Single-A Palm Beach on June 3. The switch hitter leads the team in RBIs this month (9) and has recorded three mutli-RBI games in his first 12 High-A contests.
- Heating Up?: Perhaps catcher Ryan Campos is in line for a second-half surge. Campos has reached base six times over his last two games and drove in a pair of Peoria runs last night. The team leader in walks, Campos will look to drive the baseball with more regularity in the second half.
- Road Woes: Cade Winquest heads to the mound for Peoria on Wednesday. The hard thrower has shown signs of brillance in 2025, but has really struggled away from the friendly confines of Dozer Park. At home this season, Winquest is 1-0 with a sparkling 1.37 ERA. On the road, however, Winquest's struggles have continued. He is 0-4 over five road starts with an 8.80 ERA.
- Long Time Coming: The Chiefs played their first game at Dow Diamond since 2022 when they kicked off their six-game series with Great Lakes on Tuesday. Now, the Chiefs will look for their first win at Dow Diamond in their last six tries, dating back to August 9, 2022.
- Looking Ahead: When the Chiefs wrap up their 13-game, 13-day road trip on Sunday, they will be rewarded with some serious home cooking. Following this week's series in Midland, the Chiefs will play 21 of their next 27 games at Dozer Park in Peoria.

TOP STORIES OF 2025

- April 6- Infielder Johnfrank Salazar faced eight Quad Cities batters and took the loss for Peoria on April 6. The first baseman topped out at 88 MPH on the bump. It was the first time since September 4, 2017 that a Chiefs position player factored into a decision for the club. Sunday's game also marked the first time since 2015 that Peoria had two position players throw in the same game. Graysen Tarlow also recorded an out on the mound.
- May 11- After beginning the year on the IL, Cardinals No. 13 prospect Chen-Wei Lin made his High-A debut on Mother's Day. The hard-throwing Lin topped out at 101 MPH on the radar gun and recorded eight outs in his season debut.
- May 13- The Chiefs plated eight runs in the top of the eighth inning to score a wild 13-10 win over the Cedar Rapids Kernels. In the process, the offense did something that hadn't been accomplished by a Chiefs team in more than 20 years. All nine batters drove in a run in the victory. No player drove in more than two runs for Peoria. The Chiefs logged 18 hits in the ballgame.
- May 18- In Peoria's 7-1 win over Cedar Rapids, skipper Roberto Espinoza logged his 200th managerial win. Espinoza, who is in his first season with the Chiefs, previously managed the Johnson City Cardinals (2017-19) and the FCL Cardinals (2021-24). The 36-year-old led Johnson City to a league title in 2019.
- May 20- The Chiefs wore their hitting shoes in a rain-shortened 12-5 win over Dayton, mashing a single-game franchise record seven home runs. Joshua Baez and Zach Levenson each connected on a pair of homers. Ian Petrutz, Brayden Jobert and Tre Richardson also chipped in. The previous record was six home runs, a feat most recently accomplished in 2022 at Cedar Rapids.
- June 8- Peoria pushed its winning streak to five games after sweeping a doubleheader from Quad Cities at Dozer Park. The Chiefs scored 18 runs over just 12 innings of at-bats. The Chiefs swept a pair of doubleheaders from the Bandits, the first time since 2018 that Peoria took two twin bills from the same team in the same series.
