Tonight the Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Athletics, and Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers, play the third in a six-game series; Great Lakes has won each of the first two games in the 24-game season series and is 170-166 against the Lugnuts all-time.

Last Night: Loons 6, Lugnuts 4. Emil Morales and Samuel Muñoz homered in the first two innings, helping Great Lakes build a quick 3-0 lead, only to see Lansing score four unanswered, keyed by a Rodney Green, Jr. two-run homer. But the Loons responded, taking the lead for good on a Chuck Davalan RBI single in the sixth inning off Griffin Kirn. The 19-year-old Morales led the winning effort, going 3-for-5 to raise his batting average to .208

On Deck: The Lugnuts and Loons play one another at 7:05 p.m. each of the next two nights before wrapping up the series with a Sunday matinee. The Nuts then return to Michigan's state capital for a six-game homestand against the Cedar Rapids Kernels.

LUG-NOTES

Prospecting: The Nuts' roster has four players on MLB Pipeline's Top 30 rankings of Athletics prospects: No. 8 (**Devin Taylor**), No. 16 (**Steven Echavarría**), No. 19 (**Zane Taylor**) and No. 24 (**Nate Nankil**). Baseball America's recent re-ranking of A's prospects puts Devin Taylor at No. 10, Echavarría at No. 16, Zane Taylor at No. 18 and **Nathan Dettmer** at No. 21.

The Next Big League Nut: The A's promoted right-hander **Kade Morris** (2024 Lugnut) to the Major Leagues on Tuesday with the intention of either using him out of the bullpen or starting him tomorrow. When Morris makes his debut, he will become the 205th all-time Lugnut to reach the Majors and the fifth this season (**Daniel Susac**, **Eduardo Rivera**, **Henry Bolte**, **Gage Jump**).

Depth Perception: Lugnuts starting pitchers have worked 258 1/3 innings this season, which ranks 1st in the Midwest League and 5th among all Minor League Baseball teams, while the Nuts' 4.87 average innings pitched is the highest in MiLB. (The Mariners lead the Majors, averaging 5 2/3 innings per start, while the Loons' parent club, the Dodgers, are in 2nd.) Lansing starters have worked at least six innings in a game on 13 different occasions: **Steven Echavarría** 3, **Nathan Dettmer** 3, **Tzu-Chen Sha** 2, **Zane Taylor** 2, **Samuel Dutton** 2, **Jackson Finley** 1.

Lugnut League Leaders:

- **Steven Echavarría** is 2nd in innings (48) and 3rd in average (.217).
- **Zane Taylor** is 5th in innings (44 2/3) and 3rd in ERA (3.22).
- **Samuel Dutton** is 1st in innings (50 1/3).
- **Devin Taylor** is 3rd in hits (52) and 4th in RBI (38).

Roll Call: Lansing has used 38 different players this season, including 21 pitchers (excluding position player pitching **Gunner Gouldsmith's** scoreless inning) and 17 position players. Only **Devin Taylor** has taken part in all 53 games, a mark that leads all of High-A.

Speaking of Devin Taylor: The Indiana Hoosier leads the Midwest League with six outfield assists and leads all of Minor League Baseball in seeing pitches outside the zone (464 in 235 PAs, an average of 1.97 balls per plate appearance). Taylor has received 1032 pitches overall (4.39/PA), leading all of Single-A, High-A and Double-A.

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts have turned 65 double plays (in 53 games), which leads Minor League Baseball (2nd - OKC Comets - 61 in 58 games) and Major League Baseball (1st - SF Giants, 63 in 62 games).

Great Times vs. Great Lakes: Outfielder **Rodney Green, Jr.** doubled and homered yesterday, giving him five homers in 12 games all-time vs. Loons pitching. In 2025, Green slashed .233/.346/.558 with 10 hits (1 double, 4 HR), nine runs, 10 RBIs and seven walks in 11 games against the Loons.

Cooperstown Bound: An original 1996 Lugnut as a member of the very first Lugnuts lineup on April 5, 1996, **Carlos Beltrán** went to be voted 1999 American League Rookie of the Year, was named a nine-time All-Star, and won three Gold Gloves, two Silver Sluggers, the Roberto Clemente Humanitarian Award, and the 2017 World Series during a 20-year MLB career. On July 27, Beltrán will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown.

JUNE 4 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2011: Drew Hutchison's last three innings entering this start were scoreless. On this day, he began a stretch of four consecutive starts with six shutout innings (24 IP, 3 BB, 35 K), allowing two hits and striking out nine Burlington Bees in a 6-0 Lugnuts win at Cooley Law School Stadium.

2017: No one had found a way to score against West Michigan ace closer Jason Foley – until the Lugnuts scored three in the top of the ninth inning, including a tie-breaking Rodrigo Orozco squeeze (in Orozco's Lugnuts debut, no less!), to beat the Whitecaps, 8-6. It was the fireballing Foley's first blown save of the year. The game had seen the Nuts score five runs in the top of the first inning to knock out Eudis Idrogo, followed by four Whitecaps runs in the home half against Lansing starter Denis Diaz.

Stats Dive: Ranks 3rd in the Midwest League in ERA (3.22), tied for 5th in innings (44 2/3), 6th in WHIP (1.32), and 8th in batting average (.251)... limiting left-handers to .208 avg. (16-77) compared to right-handers' .289 (26-90), but 11 of 17 walks have gone to LHH... 1.91 ERA at home, 5.51 on the road... 1.96 ERA in April, 4.10 in May.

Scouting Report: Pipeline's grades - 55 fastball, 50 curveball, 50 slider, 55 changeup, 50 cutter, 55 control... "A mainstay in UNC Wilmington's rotation over his four years there, Taylor produced one of the best seasons in school history as a senior in 2025 by leading NCAA Division I in K/BB ratio (9.6) and WHIP (0.76), while also ranking second in walk rate (1.0 per nine innings) and fourth in ERA (1.98). Entering the 2025 Draft as one of the top senior arms in the class, he was selected in the fifth round by the A's and signed at a full-slot bonus of \$513,900, becoming the highest-drafted pitcher out of UNCW since supplemental first-rounder Bradley Holt in 2008. With Triple-A Las Vegas in need of a starter at the end of the season, Taylor was called upon for his pro debut with a start for a playoff-bound Aviators squad."
